WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Sai Baba National College of Education, Opp, Zilla Panchayat Office, Hospital Road, Ananthpur District-515001, Andhra Pradesh run by Anantapur District National Education Trust, Ananthpur District Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2008-2009/4115 dt. 22.08.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008-2009.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 07.10.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, a Corrigendum order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO9351/B.Ed/AP/2015/76974 dated 27.10.2015 issued to the institution for one basic unit.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 368th meeting held on 08 -09 January, 2019. The Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued on 18.01.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the SCN.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per its decision taken in 380th meeting. The Sub-Committee of the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the Institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 15-10-2019. The institutions vide letter date 28.12.2019 submitted a written representation stating as under:-

"...With reference to the above we wish to bring to you kind notice that the courses (B.Ed and D.E.Ed) have not been in operation since 2016-18 academic year for want of student strength.

So, we request you to windup the B.Ed. and D.El.Ed Courses as they are not viable for continuation. We also request you to permit us to withdraw Endowment Fund and Reserve Funds. This is for your kind information and necessary action".

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Committee decided that to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sri Sai Baba National College of Education, Opp, Zilla Panchayat Office, Hospital Road, Ananthpur District-515001, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed** course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 28.12.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) **NOC from the affiliating body.**
- (b) **NOC from the staff/faculty.**
- (c) **Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course**

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
