RECOGNITION ORDER

Whereas, in terms of Section 14/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the **G.R. BARASIA CHERITABLE TRUST, STATION ROAD, SURAJGARH, DISTRICT-JHUNJHUNU, RAJASTHAN-333029** submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee (now Western Regional Committee) of the NCTE for grant of recognition/permission to **RAMAKISHAN JUGALKISHORE BARASIA TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE, SHIRAWA ROAD, SURAJGARH, JHUNJHUNU, RAJASTHAN-333029** for B.Ed. (For two units of 50 students) **course.**

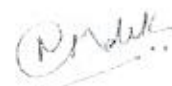
2. And whereas, the case was placed in 295th NRC meeting held on 06th – 11th February 2019 and the Committee decided that the recommendation of the State Govt of Rajasthan be obtained before further processing of the application.

3. And whereas, the matter was placed in 295th meeting of NRC held on 06th to 11th Feb 2019 and the Committee decided that as per provisions of Regulation 7(4) of NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014, a letter be sent to the State Government to obtain its recommendation/comments on the proposal made by the institution. NRC further decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to institution. Accordingly, letter dated issued seeking recommendation from State Govt. Further, Show Cause Notice dated 28.02.2019 issued to the institution to comply fulfilment of deficiencies mentioned therein. The institution submitted reply vide letter dated 15.03.2019.

4. And whereas, matter was placed in 310th meeting of WRC held on 20th – 22nd November 2020 and Committee decided that the application is rejected orders be issued accordingly, on case-to-case basis. Accordingly, refusal order was issued vide order no. **NRC/NCTE/RJ-1302/310th MEETING/2019/207598-604 dt. 04.02.2020.**

5. And whereas, the institution preferred appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act 1993. The operative part of the order dt. 30.06.2021 passed by the Appellate Authority NCTE Hqrs is produced below: -

Appeal Committee noted that appellant institution by its letter dt. 14.03.2019 submitted required clarification with supporting evidence. The impugned refusal order dt. 04.02.2020 issued by WRC is seen issued on deficiencies which were not mentioned in the S.C.N date 28.02.2019 thus depriving the appellant institution to submit written representation on the deficiencies which have been cited in the refusal order dt. 04.02.2020. Appeal Committee, decided to remand back the case to WRC for revisiting the matter.



Now Therefore, the council hereby remands back the case of Ramakishan Jugalkishore Barasia Teacher Training College, Surajgarh, Chirawa Road, Surajgarh, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan to the WRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above...

6. **And whereas**, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the WRC in its **366th meeting held on 12th and 14th July 2022** is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the B.Ed. programme, such as, infrastructural and instructional facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

7. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14/15 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, **The Western Regional Committee, (NCTE) hereby grants permission for conducting B.ED. (INTAKE 2 UNITS) course, with an annual intake of 50 students each from the academic session 2023-2024 RAMAKISHAN JUGALKISHORE BARASIA TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE, SHIRAWA ROAD, SURAJGARH, JHUNJHUNU, RAJASTHAN-333029.** The institution is required to ensure about the availability of the regular staff for teaching B.ED. (INTAKE 2 UNITS) course.

8. The institution is required to ensure about the availability of the regular staff for teaching B.Ed. Course.

9. The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

10. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in term of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

11. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

12. The recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, State Government etc. as applicable.

13. The Norms of staff qualification administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations 2014.

14. Further, the recognition is subject to compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognized institution:

- i. The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building document submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the

- NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time before grant of affiliation to the institution.
- ii. The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulations, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions shall gradually move towards becoming composite institutions.
 - iii. The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.
15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with annual statement of accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 16. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following as mandatory disclosure: -
 - a. Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter.
 - d. Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
 17. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, as per Clause 8(4)(iii) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the land and building is to be transferred in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of issue of formal recognition order under sub-regulation (16) of regulation 7, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the within the stipulated time.
 18. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by Ministry of Education.
 19. The institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month of issue of this order.

20. If the institution contravenes the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

21. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

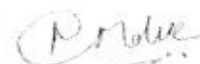
