RESTORATION ORDER 222013 Date: 9 1 2023 F.No.NCTE/WRC/APW04073/125054/M.ED/375th/MH/2022

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, PANDIT RAJPATI MISHRA ADHYAPAK VIDYALAYA, RUN BY PANDIT RAJPATI MISHRA MASTER OF EDUCATION & RESEARCH (M.ED.), JANATA SHIKSHAN PRASARAK SAMITI, GATA NO.05, CHIKALSAR MAN PADA, CITY & DIST.THANE, MAHARASHTRA was granted recognition by WRC, NCTE for M.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students vide order No.WRC/5-6/106TH/2008/39945-39950 dated 27.08.2008.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, NCTE, New Delhi vide its letter No.F.No.49-4/2010/PT/NCTE (N&S) dated 30.07.2010 had communicated to intimate the institution having approved M.Ed. programme to enhance the existing intake to 35 students from the current session 2010-2011 as notified vide National Council for Teacher Education Amendment Regulation, 2010 in the Gazette of India on 26th July, 2010.
- AND WHEREAS, permission was granted to the institution vide order dated 18.02.2011 enhancing M.Ed. intake from 25 to 35 from the academic session 2010-2011, remaining other conditions the same as mentioned in the order dated 27.08.2008.
- AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No.WRC/APW4073/125054/2015/156688-94 dated 07.12.2015 for conducting M.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-16.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed in the 255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution dated 08.11.2016.
- AND WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, reply not submitted by the institution.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 287th meeting held on January 30-31, 2018 and the Committee has decided the following:-

"The case file was seen. Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.11.2016. The Institution has not replied so far.

Hence, Recognition is withdrawn from the session 2018-19. FDRs, if any, be returned."

- 8. AND WHEREAS, withdrawal order was issued to the institution dated 06.02.2018.
- AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal against the aforesaid withdrawal order and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 13.09.2022 remanded back the case to WRC with the direction to consider all the relevant documents submitted by the appellant institution and take further appropriate action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.

10. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 371st meeting held on September 21-22, 2022 and the Committee has decided the following:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- NCTE Appellate Authority remanded back the matter vide order dated 13.09.2022.
- The institution has not submitted the documents in compliance to appeal remand back order.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for M.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website failing which the WRC will take decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations."

- 11. AND WHEREAS, show cause notice was issued to the institution dated 07.10.2022.
- 12. AND WHEREAS, the institution had approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi in W.P.(C) 14651/2022 & CM APPL. 44869/2022 and the Hon'ble Court had passed an order dated 17.10.2022, which is as follows:-
 - "...4. In order to give effect to above directions, restoration order ought to have been issued by Respondents within a period of 15 days from the date of remand order (i.e., 13th September, 2022) in terms of directions issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Arihant College & Anr. v. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr.
 - 5. For the foregoing reason, the petition is allowed. Respondents are directed to issue a restoration order in terms of directions of the Appellate Authority within a period of two weeks from today. Respondents are also directed to display the name of Petitioner-college in the list/category of recognised institutions for conducting M.Ed. course, on their website. The same shall also be communicated to the affiliating university as well as the Department of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra to enable the Petitioner-college to participate in counselling and admission process for academic year-2022-23 and for subsequent years, unless a withdrawal order is passed.
 - 6. The present petition is disposed of, along with all other pending application(s)".
- 13. AND WHEREAS, in compliance of direction of Hon'ble Court, permission letter to participate in the counselling for the academic session 2022-2023 was issued to the institution dated 03.11.2022.
- 14. AND WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice dated 07.10.2022, reply not submitted by the institution.
- 15. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 375th meeting held on November 18-19, 2022 and the Committee has decided the following:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, Order dated 17.10.2022 in W.P.(C) 14651/2022 & CM APPL. 44869/2022 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided that in compliance of direction of Hon'ble Court, recognition to M.Ed. course be restored until fresh withdrawal order is passed by WRC, NCTE. The institution has already been permitted to participate in the counselling for admission to M.Ed. course for the academic session 2022-23 vide order dated 03.11.2022, being conducted by the Affiliating Body/ concerned State Govt. The concerned State authorities be intimated accordingly. A copy of restoration order be also uploaded on the WRC web portal on NCTE website.

Further, the Committee observed as under:

- NCTE Appellate Authority remanded back the matter vide order dated 13.09.2022.
- Show cause notice u/s 17 was issued dated 07.10.2022.
- No reply received in response show cause notice dated 07.10.2022 issued after the appeal remanded back to WRC.
- The institution has not submitted the documents in compliance of appeal remand back order. In view of the above, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for M.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice failing which the WRC will take decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations."
- 16. NOW THEREFORE, Recognition of the institution viz. PANDIT RAJPATI MISHRA ADHYAPAK VIDYALAYA, RUN BY PANDIT RAJPATI MISHRA MASTER OF EDUCATION & RESEARCH (M.ED.), JANATA SHIKSHAN PRASARAK SAMITI, GATA NO.05, CHIKALSAR MAN PADA, CITY & DIST.THANE, MAHARASHTRA for conducting M.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit of 50 students) is hereby restored until a fresh withdrawal order is issued by WRC, NCTE.
- 17. The terms and conditions shall remain same mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 07.12.2015.
