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Recognition Order

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 JAIN INSTITUTE, PLOT NUMBER: 109, STREET NUMBER: SALUPURA, VILLAGE: SHIVPURI LINK ROAD, POST OFFICE: ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA: LASHKAR, GWALIOR, TOWN/CITY: GWALIOR, DISTRICT: GWALIOR 474001, MADHYA PRADESH (WRCAPP1502) had submitted an application on 21/09/2011 to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition for starting the new D.El.Ed. course for an annual intake of 50 (fifty) seats.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfils such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.El.Ed. course as determined by regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to JAIN INSTITUTE, PLOT NUMBER: 109, STREET NUMBER: SALUPURA, VILLAGE: SHIVPURI LINK ROAD, POST OFFICE: ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA: LASHKAR, GWALIOR, TOWN/CITY: GWALIOR, DISTRICT: GWALIOR 474001, MADHYA PRADESH for starting the new D.El.Ed. Course of 2 (Two) Year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty seats) from the academic session 2014-2015.

Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

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If, at any time, either on *sue-moto* inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the rules, regulations, orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition/permission was granted, the recognition/permission may be withdrawn under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.

RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **SPARSH EDUCATION AND WELFARE SOCIETY, PLOT NO.109, SHIVPURI LINK ROAD, VILLAGE - SALUPURA, POST OFFICE - ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA/ TOWN/CITY/DISTRICT - GWALIOR, PIN CODE - 474001, MADHYA PRADESH (WRCAPP3222)** had submitted on **30.06.2015** the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of permission to **JAIN INSTITUTE, RUN BY SPARSH EDUCATION AND WELFARE SOCIETY, KHASRA/PLOT NO.109, STREET NO./VILLAGE - SALUPURA, POST OFFICE - ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA/ TOWN/CITY/ DISTRICT - GWALIOR, PIN CODE - 474001, MADHYA PRADESH** for increase in intake in existing D.El.Ed. AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution, **JAIN INSTITUTE, RUN BY SPARSH EDUCATION AND WELFARE SOCIETY, KHASRA/PLOT NO.109, STREET NO./VILLAGE - SALUPURA, POST OFFICE - ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA/ TOWN/CITY/ DISTRICT - GWALIOR, PIN CODE - 474001, MADHYA PRADESH (WRCAPP3222)** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee in its **245th meeting held on March 1-3, 2016** was satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **D.El.Ed.** programme, such as infrastructural and instructional facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Western Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to **JAIN INSTITUTE, RUN BY SPARSH EDUCATION AND WELFARE SOCIETY, KHASRA/PLOT NO.109, STREET NO./VILLAGE - SALUPURA, POST OFFICE - ITM POST OFFICE, TEHSIL/TALUKA/ TOWN/CITY/ DISTRICT - GWALIOR, PIN CODE - 474001, MADHYA PRADESH** for conducting **D.El.Ed.** programme of 2 (Two) years duration with an annual intake of **50 (fifty) students (one additional unit)** thereby totaling to **50+50=100 (One hundred)** students from the academic session **2016-2017**.

The institution shall gradually move towards becoming a composite institution as per clause 8(1) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.

The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in term of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

The recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, State Government etc. as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with annual statement of accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.



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The institution shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

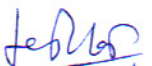
