ORDER

WHEREAS, WRC, NCTE had granted recognition/permission to **PICKTHALL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, 8, EIDGAH HILLS, BHOPAL- 462001, MADHYA PRADESH** vide order dated 26.09.2005 to start the **B.ED. (CO-ED)** course with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the letter for submission of AFFIDAVIT REGARDING ACCEPTANCE AND COMPLIANCE OF NCTE REGULATIONS, 2014 was issued to the institution on 17.01.2015. The institution submitted affidavit vide letter dated 05.02.2015.

AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued for two basic units (each 50 students) to the institution on 31.05.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255<sup>th</sup> Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...issue Show Cause Notices to the institution of the condition maintained in revised order."

AND, WHEREAS, a Show cause notice was issued to institution on 30.08.2016 for not submitting compliance of Regulation 2014 required faculty staff list for two units and infrastructure.

AND WHEREAS reply of Show cause notice was submitted by the institution on 20.09.2016 with a request & affidavit for closure of one unit of B.Ed. course from the academic session 2016-17.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 259<sup>th</sup> Meeting of WRC held on September 21-23, 2016 and the Committee decided that "... Institutions which have requested for reducing intake may be permitted."

If institution contravenes any of the conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.

Now, therefore, the intake of the institution for conduct of B.Ed. course is hereby permitted to reduce the intake of 100 students (2 basic units) to 50 students (one unit).
