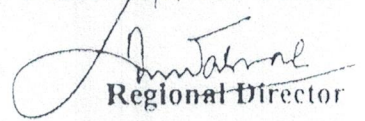

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WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS recognition of permission was granted to MATUSHRI AHILYA DEVI TEACHERS EDUCATION INSTITUTE, 23, PRESS COMPLEX, A.B. ROAD, INDORE-452010, Madhya Pradesh under section 14(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting 150 seats for D.ED, 100 seats for B.ED & 25 seats for M.ED courses.

2. AND WHEREAS the recognition of B.ED course of the said institution was withdrawal by WRC and the institution had preferred an appeal before Council (NCTE) u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, against the withdrawal order of B.ED course.

3. AND WHEREAS the Council had passed order No.F.No.89-717/2009-Appeal/A-10925 dated 22.02.2010 in the appeal file by the institution and WRC order dated 9.07.2009 was set aside by the Council with the direction to the WRC to restore the recognition to the institution immediately for conducting two units of D.ED, one unit of B.ED & one unit of M.ED course with only basic unit and withdrawn the additional unit of D.ED course.

4. AND WHEREAS appeal order No.F.No.89-717/2009-Appeal/A-10925 dated 22.02.2010 was placed in 132nd meeting of WRC held on 19-20, March, 2010 and committee decided that "restore the recognition of 2 unit of D.Ed., one unit of B.Ed. and one Unit of M.Ed. and withdraw the recognition one additional unit of D.Ed..

5. AND WHEREAS in compliance of appeal order dated 22.02.2010 passed by the Council the order for restoration the recognition of B.ED course has already been issued.

6. NOW therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the permission granted to MATUSHRI AHILYA DEVI TEACHERS EDUCATION INSTITUTE, 23, PRESS COMPLEX, A.B. ROAD, INDORE-452010, Madhya Pradesh for additional 50 seats in D.ED course vide Order No.WRC/5-6A/PW/0046/222019/114/2008/52809 dtd. 12.03.2009 and subsequent corrigendum No.WRC/2-32/222019/114/2009/52809 dtd. 27.03.2009 is hereby withdrawn from the end of the academic session next following the date of this withdrawal order.

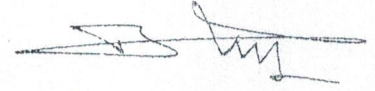
7. Affiliating Body is advised not to admit/ allot any student in D.ED. Course in the said institution for the session specified in a para.

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1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking the following reliefs:-

"(a) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order directing the Respondents to issue an order or corrigendum or clarification letter mentioning therein the status of petitioner institution as an already recognized institution for running the D.Ed. course with approved intake of 100 seats and to upload the said corrigendum or clarification letter on their website with further communication of the same to Madhya Pradesh Board of Secondary Education and the State Council for Educational Research & Training; and/or

(b) pass any such other or further order(s) or direction(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit & proper in the facts & circumstances of the instant case and also in the interest of justice & equity"

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though it is an admitted position that the petitioner is a recognised institution for the

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purpose of running D.Ed course with an intake of 100 students due to some confusion in the information provided on the respondents' website, the students are finding it very difficult to comprehend that the petitioner continues to be a duly recognised institute for 100 seats in D.Ed.

3. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice and while submitting that the information available on the website is clear, fairly submits that the respondent has no objection in issuing a further clarification to the effect that the petitioner is a recognised college for running D.Ed course with an intake of 100 students.
4. In light of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel for the respondent, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to publish on its website, a clarificatory notice that the petitioner is, as on date, a recognized institute for 100 seats in D.Ed and forward the same to the affiliating board within a period of two weeks from today.
