## RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely, SUNRISE COLLEGE RUN BY KANHA EDUCATION SOCITY, PLOT NO 75,76, VILLAGE – SATANWADA KHURD, P.O.-SATABWADA, TEHSIL +DIST.- SHIVPURI- 473638, MADHYA PRADESH under section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.ED.(CO.ED)course for 100 students vide order No. WRC/5-6/APP2413/223/203<sup>rd</sup>/M.P./2013 dated 03.03.2014.

2.AND WHEREAS, the revised recognition order was issued to SUNRISE COLLEGE RUN BY KANHA EDUCATION SOCITY, PLOT NO 75,76, VILLAGE – SATANWADA KHURD, P.O.- SATABWADA, TEHSIL +DIST.- SHIVPURI- 473638, MADHYA PRADESH vide order no. WRC/APP2413/223/203/2015/136981-989 dt. 26.05.2015 for B.ED.(CO.ED) Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (One unit) from the academic session 2015-16 with certain conditions.

- 3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."
- 4. AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.02.2017 for not submitting the following documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order:
  - 1) Staff Profile for the session 2015-16 duly approved by the affiliating body.
  - 2) Originally notarized CLU/NEC/BP and Building Completion Certificate.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the reply of Show Cause Notice was submitted by the institution on 11.01.2018.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 288nd Meeting of WRC held on February 15th-18th, 2018 and the Committee decided that:- "....The case file was seen. Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice was issued on 28.02.2017.

Institution in its reply has submitted a staff list of 1+15 faculty members, who are qualified and approved by the competent authority except lecture at S.No.10. However, the institution needs to submit the latest staff profile approved by the Registrar in accordance with the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Building Completion Certificate countersigned by the Government Engineer in original and additional FDR for Rs.4.00 lakhs needs to be submitted.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which Recognition will be withdrawn."

- 6. AND WHEREAS, the Clarification letter was issued to the institution on 19.02.2018
- 7. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dt. 24.07.2018 received in WRO on 13.08.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 310<sup>th</sup> Meeting of WRC held on 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, August 2019 and the Committee decided that:-".... *The Clarification letter was issued to the institution vide letter dated* 19/02/2018 and reply received on 13/08/2018.

The summary of the case reveals that the reply was not submitted within the stipulated time of 30 days as per the Show Cause Notice.

Moreover, Building Completion Certificate & CLU in original are also not submitted.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order

- 8. AND WHEREAS, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 05.09.2019.
- 9. AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, and the institution has file W.P. 10420/2019 Court order dated 05.09.2019 and Date of Decision  $25^{th}$  September 2019.
- 11. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 312<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on February 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> January 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-

"The Committee studied the decision of the Hon'ble High Court in the W.P. No. 10420/2019. & CM No. 43201/2019. The Committee decided that the representative of the institution be given personal hearing in the next meeting of WRC. The date of the personal hearing will be intimated later.

The representative along with the requisite documents be remain present."

- 12. AND WHEREAS, the Clarification order was issued to the institution on 18.02.2020.
- 13. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 313<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on February 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> February 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-
- "As per the decision of WRC in its 312<sup>th</sup> meeting in compliance of the Court directions, the representatives of the institution appeared before WRC for personal hearing on 26/02/2020. It is decided after the discussion that the representative of the institution will submit the required documents on or before 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2020."
- 14. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dt. 07.03.2020 received in WRO on 09.03.2020.
- 15. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 315<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> and14<sup>th</sup> August 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-

This is a RPRO case and same was remanded back through Court with a direction to call the petitioner for personal hearing.

The personal hearing of the institution was held on  $26^{th}$  February 2020, wherein the petitioner wherein the petitioner informed that it had submitted certain documents to WRC Office

The WRC examined the documents submitted by the institution and observed that the institution has complied with the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations and

decided that the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed course with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Units) be restored.
