RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely **Colonel Fateh Jang College, Run By-Colonels Education and Cultural Society, 51, Silver Oaks Estate, C/O. Colonels Academy, Bercha Road, Mhow-453442, Madhya Pradesh** under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course (100 Intake) vide order No. WRC/5-6/104th/2008/37911 dated 29.07.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS, the letter for Affidavit Regarding Acceptance and Compliance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued to the institution the reply was received on 13.02.2015.

3. AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to Colonel Fateh Jang College Run By-Colonels Education and Cultural Society, 51, Silver Oaks Estate, C/O. Colonels Academy, Bercha Road, Mhow-453442, Madhya Pradesh, vide order No. WRC/APW02122/223429/2015/143622,32,41,42,45,48,49,50,52 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of (50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, Compliance was not Submitted as per regulations 2014.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

6. AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 20.07.2016 for not submitting the following documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order:

- 1) Staff Profile for the session 2015-2016 duly approved by the affiliating body.
- 2) Originally notarized CLU, NEC, Building Plan & Building Completion Certificate.

7. AND WHEREAS, the reply of show cause notice was submitted by the institution on 16.08.2016.

8. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 276th Meeting held on May 30th-31st, 2017 of WRC and the Committee decided that." Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice dated 19.09.2016 was issued.

The case file was seen. The issue refers to the PIL filed Pawan Dubey and inspection conducted under Section 13 by the NCTE Hqrs. Deficiency letter was issued on 11/05/2015 and reply not received till date.

Hence, Show Cause Notice be issued as to why the Recognition should not be refused.

9. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 285th Meeting held on 19th- 21th December, 2017 of WRC and the Committee decided that." Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice dated 06.06.2017 was issued.

The case file was seen. Deficiency letter was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 and reply was not received. Thereafter Show Cause Notice was issued on 06.06.2017. The institution replied on 28.06.2017. It has submitted a list of 1+9 faculty members approved by the University. Subsequently, it has submitted another unapproved list of 1+15. The institution is now required to send a final list of faculty members in original approved by the University.

Secondly, the institution should submit bank statements as proof that salary is paid through the bank for the past six months.

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The institution should submit the latest premium receipt for CLU/diversion and Building Completion Certificate countersigned by a Government Engineer.

Compliance be submitted within one month.

10. AND WHEREAS, the Clarification letter was issued to the institution on 29.12.2017. Accordingly, the institution has submitted reply of Clarification dt. 02.02.2018

11. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed in 290th Meeting held on 21st -23rd, 2017 of WRC and the Committee decided that " The case file was seen. Deficiency letter dated 11.05.2015. The institution did not reply till May 2017. Subsequently, Show Cause Notice was issued on 06.06.2017, followed by a compliance letter dated 29.12.2017. The institution replied on 02.02.2018 in which they had said that the final list is under process for selection of five new lecturers as also for the sports teacher.

The institution submitted a photocopy of list of the 1+9 faculty members. The institution at the same time has informed that the appointment of five new lecturers and sports teacher is under process.

WRC decided to reduce the intake to one unit and it should submit the list of 1+9 faculty members approved by the Registrar in original.WRC will issue the continuation letter for reduced intake as soon as the institution submits the original list of staff approved by the Registrar.

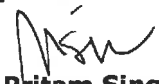
12. AND WHEREAS, the Clarification letter was issued to the institution on 27.03.2018. Accordingly, the institution has submitted reply of Clarification dt. 05.04.2018

13. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed 316th Meeting of WRC held on 27th to 28 August & 04th September 2020.

The WRC examined the documents submitted by the institution in response to the order of the Appellate Authority and observed that the institution has complied with the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations and decided that the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed course with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Units) be restored from the date of issue of order.

11. NOW THEREFORE, the recognition is restored to **Colonel Fateh Jang College Run By-Colonels Education and Cultural Society, 51, Silver Oaks Estate, C/O. Colonels Academy, Bercha Road, Mhow-453442, Madhya Pradesh** from the date of this order for conducting B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).
