ORDER

WHEREAS, Mahavir NTT School, Sector-4, Kiran Path, Mansarover, Jaipur-302020, Rajasthan had applied for grant of recognition for additional intake in existing NTT course of two years duration under section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 of the NRC, NCTE.

- AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution and the visiting team had since submitted its report.
- 3. AND WHEREAS in its 120th meeting held on 12th 13th August, 2007 the Northern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, is satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the following requirements and decided that a show cause Notice may be issued to the institution under prevision to section 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.
 - The institution is also running the other institution i.e. Saraswati B.Ed. College on the same land. The institution is required to submit the demarcated area for all the courses being run in the premises.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution had submitted representation dated 24.09.2007 to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE. The said representation of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR and Videography were again duly considered by the Northern Regional Committee on 16th -17th September, 2007 which came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reason.
- (a) The committee noted that in the same building two different colleges of education are being run. The committee decided to refuse recognition of the institution on the ground that in the same building other college is being run.
- NOW, THEREFORE grant of recognition to Mahavir NTT School, Sector-4, Kiran Path, Mansarover, Jaipur-302020, Rajasthan for additional intake in existing NTT course in terms of section 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, is hereby refused on the grounds mention above
