PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body established under Section 3 of the NCTE Act, 1993, with the mandate to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system across the country and to determine and maintain standards for teacher education.

2. In exercise of its statutory functions under Sections 12(j) and 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE issued a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 directing all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit their Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) for the academic sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The last date for submission was initially notified as 10.11.2024 (11:59 PM) which was subsequently extended on two occasions vide Public Notice(s) dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 with the final timeline being 31.12.2024 (11:59 PM).

3. Despite extensive awareness and outreach initiatives undertaken by the NCTE, several TEIs did not participate effectively in the PAR exercise. Consequently, Show Cause Notices were also issued to such institutions by the respective Regional Committee(s) of NCTE.

4. Thereafter, the respective Regional Committee(s), in exercise of their powers under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, proceeded to withdraw the recognition of various TEIs vide orders citing non-compliance with the requirement concerning submission of PAR.

5. Some of these withdrawal orders have been challenged by various TEIs before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court vide **an interim order dated 11.11.2025 in W.P.(C) No. 16287 of 2025**, titled **Bhagwan Singh BTC Prashikshan Sansthan vs. NCTE & anr.** stayed the operation of the impugned withdrawal order till the next date of hearing. The operative portion of the order is as under:

"6. Having heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and on perusal of Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 as also interim orders passed by the Coordinate Bench in similar writ petitions, I am of the view that Petitioner has made out a prima facie case in its favour for grant of interim relief. Accordingly, it is directed that operation of the impugned withdrawal order dated 28.05.2025 shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing and Petitioner will be entitled to participate in the counselling and admit students for academic session 2025-2026. It is further directed that NCTE will issue necessary Public Notice and upload the name of the Petitioner College on the website intimating all concerned, including the State Authority,

affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order dated 28.05.2025 has been stayed by the Court and Petitioner has been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students. The needful shall be done on or before 14.11.2025.”

6. Several similarly placed TEIs also filed writ petitions before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. In all these matters, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi while staying the operation of the impugned withdrawal orders, till the next date of hearing, has also permitted the Petitioner institutions to participate in counselling and admit students for the academic session 2025-2026.

7. In compliance with the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the details of the following TEI whose withdrawal order has been stayed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi till the next date of hearing, and who has been permitted to participate in the counselling process and admit students for the academic session 2025-2026 is hereby uploaded on the website of the Regional Committee for information of all concerned.
