PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body established under Section 3 of the NCTE Act, 1993, with the mandate to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system across the country and to determine and maintain standards for teacher education.

2. In exercise of its statutory functions under Sections 12(j) and 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE issued a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 directing all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit their Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) for the academic sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The last date for submission was initially notified as 10.11.2024 (11:59 PM) which was subsequently extended on two occasions vide Public Notice(s) dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 with the final timeline being 31.12.2024 (11:59 PM).

3. Despite extensive awareness and outreach initiatives undertaken by the NCTE, several TEIs did not participate effectively in the PAR exercise. Consequently, Show Cause Notices were also issued to such institutions by the respective Regional Committee(s) of NCTE.

4. Thereafter, the respective Regional Committee(s), in exercise of their powers under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, proceeded to withdraw the recognition of various TEIs vide orders citing non-compliance with the requirement concerning submission of PAR.

5. In W.P.(C) 9414/2025 & CM APPL. 11613/2026, CM APPL. 11614/2026, CM APPL. 22407/2026, CM APPL. 22408/2026, CM APPL. 32536/2026, titled RAMKRISHAN INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION vs. NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION & ANR., the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed order dated 07.07.2026, directing the NCTE as under:

"...Mr. Kapoor, learned standing counsel for the respondents, states that the respondents will issue necessary public notice and upload the name of the petitioners on its website thereby intimating all concerned, including State Authority, Affiliating Body and Counselling Authority that the operation of the impugned withdrawal order/its decisions in respect of petitioner institutes, have been stayed and the institutes have been permitted to participate in the counselling and to admit students for the academic session 2026-27.

7. The same shall be done on or before Friday, i.e. 10.07.2026.
