

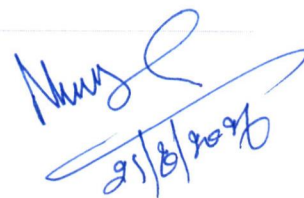

The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of 405th Meeting.

1.	R.S. Teachers Training College, Plot No.-332, 333, 334, 338, 339, Street No.-239 Vill./P.O.-Katras Bazar, Tehsil/Taluka-Baghmara, Town/City-Katras, District-Dhanbad, Jharkhand-828114. File No. ERCAPP1178 Course: B.Ed. The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, Appeal Order passed by the NCTE-HQ, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: - 1. The Revised recognition order was issued for B.Ed programme for two units of the 100 students vide order dated 31.05.2015. 2. The show cause notice was issued to the institution on 24.11.2022 after consideration of the complaint against the institution in 313th meeting of ERC. Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 21.02.2025 as per decision of the 358th meeting of the ERC held on 06th

	Feb, 2025. 3. The Withdrawal order No F.No.ER-367.23/NCTE/ERCAPP1178/B.Ed./JH/2025 dated 03.07.2025 was issued to the institution on the ground of only non-submission of the “fire safety certificate” as per decision of the 367th meeting of ERC held on 04th June 2025. 4. The institution accordingly preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ against the order dated 03.07.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ, passed an order <i>vide</i> Order No. File No. No. 89-355/E-376986/2025 Appeal/12th (Emergent) Meeting, 2026 APPLERC202515282 Dated 05.08.2026 which is as under: “After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the records available on file, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, sets aside the impugned order dated 03.07.2025 and remands the matter to the Eastern Regional Committee for fresh consideration and re-examination in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), subject to the directions contained herein. The appellant institution shall submit the requisite documents within fifteen (15) days, whereupon the Regional Committee shall proceed in accordance with law and pass a reasoned and speaking order within the stipulated timeframe.” 5. The institution has submitted its reply vide representation dated 06.08.2026 along with a copy of the Fire Safety Certificate dated 28.05.2026 which is valid up to 27.05.2027 issued by the Prabhari Upar Rajya Agnishaman Padh adhikari, Ranchi, Jharkhand. 6. The Committee considered the same and found fit the case for continuation of recognition of the institution for B.Ed. Programme. In view of the above, the Committee has decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. F.ERC/NCTE/ERCAPP1178/B.Ed. (Revised Order)/2015/32601 dated 31.05.2015 be restored for B.Ed. programme with annual intake of 100 seats. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly.
2.	N.N. Ghosh Sanatan Teacher Training College, Plot No. 165, Vill-Jamuary, P.O-Kokodro, Tehsil/Taluka-Kanke, Town/City-Ranchi, Dist-Ranchi, Jharkhand-834006. File No. ERCAPP1221 Course: B.Ed. The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the ERC after careful consideration made the following observations: - 1. First SCN was issued to the institution on 18.09.2025 on certain grounds. The institution has submitted the reply dated 09.10.2025. 2. Thereafter, the final SCN was issued to the institution on 02.01.2026 as per decision of the 384th meeting of ERC held on 09th -10th December, 2025. However, the institution has not submitted reply to Final SCN which was issued on 02.01.2026. 3. The institution was withdrawn on dated 20.02.2026. Hence, the institution has preferred appeal dated 20.02.2026 the appeal committee of the council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, sets aside the impugned order dated

	20.02.2026 and remands the matter to the Eastern Regional Committee for fresh consideration and re-examination in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and the NCTE Regulation, 2014 (as amended), subject to the directions contained herein. The appellant institution shall submit the requisite documents within fifteen (15) days. 4. The institution has submitted the reply dated 24.07.2026 & 12.08.2026 received in ERC office on 28.07.2026 & 12.08.2026, as per appeal direction. After careful examination of the reply submitted by the institution vide representation date 28.07.2026 & 12.08.2026, it is found that some faculty members have been appointed after FSCN dated 02.01.2026 & Withdrawal order dated 20.02.2026. The institution is still deficient on the following grounds: 1. The institution has not submitted a copy of Advertisement letter for Appointing Teaching Faculties, appointment letters and joining letters of the recently appointed teaching faculties. 2. The institution has not submitted nomination letter of expert from the Affiliating body as a member of the selection committee. 3. The institution has not submitted the Report of Selection committee indicating the name of the selected faculty members. 4. The institution has not submitted the educational/qualification certificates including copies of the NET/P.h.D certificate of all newly appointed faculty members as per NCTE Regulations. 5. Mrs. Archana Kumari at Sr. No. 7 is not qualified as she does not possess the required NET/P.h.D. certificate. 6. The Salary Statement does not have the names of all appointed faculty members. 7. Latest Bank statement showing disbursement of salary through online transaction mode to all 1+15 faculty members from 1st February 2026 to 31 July 2026. In view of the above, the ERC has decided that a Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit its compliance along with above documents within 15 days from the issue of this notice.
