<p><u>Decision of ERC :</u></p> <p>The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, High Court of Delhi order dated 16.05.2019, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The institution had applied through online dated 26.06.2015 for grant of recognition/permission for D.El.Ed course and the hardcopy of the application was received on 04.07.2015 in the office of ERC. • The matter was placed before ERC in its 208th meeting held on 17th and 18th March, 2016 and the Committee considered and decided to refuse the application for recognition under section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act 1993. • Accordingly, refusal order was issued to the institution on 14.04.2016 for non-submission of NOC for D.El.Ed course. • Aggrieved by the refusal order, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs., and the Appellate Authority in its order dated 04.08.2016 decided to confirm the refusal order dated 14.04.2016 issued by ERC. • The office of ERC has received on 31.12.2025 a written representation of the institution addressed to the Chairperson, NCTE, New Delhi along with Hon'ble High Court order in W.P.(c)No. 3691 of 2019 after a lapse of approx. 6 years. • In the said order, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has passed an order that " <i>The ERC is directed to process the application of the petitioner within six weeks. Needless to say, the present order has been passed without prejudice to the rights and contentions of both parties.</i> • The matter of processing of the applications was considered by NCTE in its 55th General Body meeting held on 14th July, 2022, wherein it was decided as under :- <p><i>Agenda No [2]: Status of applications for Diploma level courses pending in RCs at various stages:</i></p> <p><i>The Council, after consideration of Agenda placed before the Council and detailed discussion and deliberation, as below, observed the following :-</i></p>

- *The NEP, 2020 recommends introduction of 4 Year integrated B.Ed. as a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree in Education which will be offered in multidisciplinary Institutions/Universities. By 2030 this will be the minimal qualification for a person to become a teacher.*
- *The Diploma Level Teacher Education Courses are not in line with the recommendations of NEP 2020 as per Para 15.4 & 15.5 of NEP 2020.*

"15.4. As teacher education requires multidisciplinary inputs, and education in high- quality content as well as pedagogy, all teacher education programmes must be conducted within composite multidisciplinary institutions. To this end, all multidisciplinary universities and colleges - will aim to establish, education departments which, besides carrying out cutting-edge research in various aspects of education, will also run B.Ed. programmes, in collaboration with other departments such as psychology, philosophy, sociology, neuroscience, Indian languages, arts, music, history, literature, physical education, science and mathematics. Moreover, all stand-alone TEIs will be required to convert to multidisciplinary institutions by 2030, since they will have to offer the 4-year integrated teacher preparation programme.

15.5. The 4-year integrated B.Ed. offered by such multidisciplinary HEIs will, by 2030, become the minimal degree qualification for school teachers. The 4-year integrated B.Ed. will be a dual-major holistic Bachelor's degree, in Education as well as a specialized subject such as a language, history, music, mathematics, computer science, chemistry, economics, art, physical education, etc. Beyond the teaching of cutting-edge pedagogy, the teacher education will include grounding in sociology, history, science, psychology, early childhood care and education, foundational literacy and numeracy, knowledge of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, and more. The HEI offering the 4-year integrated B.Ed. may also run a 2-year B.Ed. for students who have already received a Bachelor's degree in a specialized subject. A 1- year B.Ed. may also be offered for candidates who have received a 4-year undergraduate degree in a specialized subject. Scholarships for meritorious students will be established for the purpose of attracting outstanding candidates to the 4-year, 2-year, and 1-year B.Ed. programmes."

- *As per provision of Section 12 of NCTE Act, 1993 it shall be the duty of the Council to take all such steps as it may think fit for ensuring planned and co-ordinated development of Teacher Education.*
- *There are approximately 286 applications for various Diploma level courses pending at different stages in various Regional Committees in NCTE.*

In light of the above, the Council decided the following:-

- I. *At present, there are several institutions which have been recognized by the Regional Committees of NCTE wherein Diploma level courses/ programmes are running. An Expert Committee be constituted to devise the modalities for conversion of these recognized institutions into multidisciplinary institutions in line*

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Appeal Order passed by the NCTE-HQ, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The institution had submitted an application for seeking recognition on 31.05.2025.
- The Rejection Order was issued to the institution on 09.09.2025 on certain grounds.
- The institution preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ against the order dated 09.09.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ, passed an order *vide* Order No. 89-474/E-389053/2025 Appeal /15th Meeting, 2025 APPLERC202515423/E-89067/134948 dated 23.01.2026 which is as under:




