Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is required to upload legible Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- ii. The institution has NOT uploaded Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by govt. competent authority instead of that they uploaded Lease deed. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- iii. Uploaded lease deed by the institution is not legible. The institution is required to upload certified copy of the lease deed issued by the competent Government Authority.
- iv. The institution has NOT uploaded Society Registration Certificate instead of that they uploaded copy of Byelaws of the Trust/Society/ Company. The institution is required to upload the same.
- v. The institution has NOT uploaded mutation certificate of land, obtained from Revenue Records of the State instead of that they uploaded Registered Lease Deed. The institution is required to upload requisite document.
- vi. TEI has uploaded BCC prepared by registered Principal Architect (signed on different dates i.e.04-02-2015 and 04-02-2026) and certified by Assistant Engineer, PWD (without date). Location of land: WARD No. 63 BASANT VIHAR, KOTA 324009. As per address, Plot No.1 is not mentioned in BCC. Date of registration of land as per BCC is 07-04-2003, whereas 08-04-2003 as per land affidavit and land details mentioned on the portal. As per BCC, for B.Ed. course, the building is being used /proposed to be used whereas applied for transition of B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP course. As per BCC, details of Land Use Certificate for Educational purposes from the concerned Govt. authorities date 13-03-1990, whereas in land affidavit, letter No.604 dated 29.03.2003 is mentioned. As per BCC Total land area 73708 Sq. Ft. and total built up area of institution 3684.12 Sq. Mtr. Total land area and total built up area earmarked for all Teacher Education programmes with name of the course is not reflected on the BCC. Floor-wise area mentioned in BCC could not be verified as TEI has uploaded illegible information in building plan.

- vii. The institution is required to upload the 'Fresh certificate of merger' issued by the Registrar of Societies as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- viii. The MoU for merger has been signed between Aklank College of Education, 1 Basant Vihar Kota, Raj Asst. Registrar, Raj Aklank College, 1 Basant Vihar, Kota, Raj. However, the proposal for 'merger' between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
- ix. Affidavit regarding address correction dated 30-01-2026 and 03-02-2026 by the management is uploaded along with land deed issued by Nagar Vikas Nyas. In its explanation, TEI submits "The variation in the address of the Institution mentioned on the online portal and the address reflected in the earlier NCTE recognition order is due to difference in description of the same premises. Both addresses pertain to the same physical location of the Institution at Basant Vihar, Kota.
- x. The institution website is not operational at the time of scrutiny, hence not verified whether the institution has uploaded additional information on their website "aklankcollegeofeducation.in" in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the same.
- xi. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. The institution required to upload the same.
- xii. As per explanation of TEI, the revised and approved Building Plan has been duly uploaded showing G.F.+F.F.+S.F. plan of institution certified by Assistant Engineer, PWD. Address mentioned in plan does not match. Complete address of TEI as per portal is not reflected in the uploaded plan. Total land area and total built up area is not readable. Earmarked total land area and total built up area for all running courses and demarcated land area and built-up area for teacher education programme including multidisciplinary programmes is not reflected in the uploaded building plan.
- xiii. A copy of Bhumi Bhavan Pramanpatra dated 17-06-2022 signed by Tahasildar mentioning Total area 6850 sq.mts. 3127 (Madhya) without khasra no. is uploaded.
- xiv. College Khasra Numbers/plot numbers and other things are not mentioned in the Uploaded building safety certificate no. 2700 issued on dated 29/01/2025. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xv. Institution uploaded a letter regarding the same. the institution is required to upload the geotag photograph related to availability of having availability of lift and electricity connection as a part of criteria of institution's campus, building, furniture etc. barrier free/Accessible not mentioned on the portal.
- xvi. In the column 16 of BCC total land area earmarked for particular teacher training programme along with name of the courses, the name of the course is blank.
- xvii. The institution uploaded teaching staff list but it has not in the prescribed format of NCTE and as per NCTE norms.
- xviii. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.

- xix. NCTE, WRC, Committee noted that, Geographic location google map webpage screenshot is uploaded and in explanation, TEI submits that "The name of the institution reflected on Google Maps has now been corrected and updated to clearly indicate "Akank College of Education" at the given geographic location. The clarification has been made as both institutions operate within the same campus."
- xx. A board with the name of the college is seen to be put up temporarily. This board can be removed at any time.
- xxi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xxii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- xxiii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xxiv. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- ii. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx.
- iii. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.

- iv. The website of the institution has not been in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to maintain and update the website as per NCTE regulations.
- v. The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- vi. The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- vii. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- viii. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.
- ix. The institution is required to provide proof that all khasara number i.e. 145/1 (NEW-1186/145), 476/1157, 1888/1465 are a single plot, upload a proof issued by government competent authority. The institution is required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government showing that the building is situated on a single plot.
- x. The name of applicant institution Prakash Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya, Dholpur, Ondela Road, Dholpur, Dholpur, Dholpur, Rajasthan-328001 and the name of ANIMAL HUSBANDRY institution is Prakash Institute of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Ondela Road, Dholpur, name of both institutions are mismatched. The institution has uploaded affiliation order for offering course in Animal Husbandry issued by Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner. NCTE, WRC Committee noted that institution is not running any Multidisciplinary courses.
- xi. The uploaded certificate is not proper. The institution is required to upload the Land related affidavit as per details filled in the online application portal. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xii. The institution has not uploaded university approved teaching staff list in the prescribed format of NCTE and as per NCTE norms.
- xiii. Since the institution has not uploaded the bank statement, it cannot be ascertained whether the institution is paying salary as per Central/State Govt norms.
- xiv. The geotagged photo uploaded does not show the applicant college name on the building.
- xv. A geotagged photograph shows part of the building left unrepaired.

- xvi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xvii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the condition of computer Laboratory, Library, and other labs are not in good condition.
- xviii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

- iv. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- v. The institution is running the undergraduate (B.A.) in Arts Discipline only it is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025- Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.

- vi. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- vii. The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- viii. Institution uploaded irrelevant documents in this column no.8. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes
- ix. The institution is conducting Multidisciplinary and Teacher Education courses in the same premises i.e. B.A. intake and approved capacity not mentioned. And intake for D.EL.ED., course was not mentioned in the online application. B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), $100 \times 4 = 400$ the institution has mentioned the total built-up area 3741 sq.mts. This built-up area is not sufficient to run the above courses.
- x. Institution uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) in this column. The institution is required to upload the Mutation certificate (Jamadandi) issued by government competent authority.
- xi. Institution uploaded Fire Safety and Security Certificate in this column, which is signed by Asst. Project Engineer, PWD Seoni (MP). The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- xii. A board with the name of the college is seen to have been put up temporarily. This board can be removed at any time.
- xiii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xiv. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xv. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.

- iv. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- v. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- vi. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- vii. The University uploaded the MAP of building. The University is required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government showing that the building is situated on a single plot.
- viii. The uploaded list of teaching staff duly countersigned by its affiliating body is not in the prescribed format of NCTE and not as per NCTE regulation 2014 and amendments time by time.
