As per directives of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 19116/2025 titled Shri Sharda College of Education & Anr. vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. together with filing of Contempt Petition (C) No.476/2026 in W.P. (C) No.19116/2025 titled as Shri Sharda College of Education & Anr. Vs. Ms. Rashmi Shukla, Regional Director, Western Regional Committee (NCTE) & Anr., following matters have been considered by the Committee.

Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and NCTE, WRC Committee noted that in pursuance of order dated 17.12.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 19116/2025 titled Shri Sharda College of Education & Anr. vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., the Hon'ble Court passed the following directions:

“...5. This writ petition is disposed of leaving it open to the Petitioners to make a fresh application for inspection of the new premises, as aforementioned, for running the courses in question. As and when the application is received by the Respondents, decision will be taken within eight weeks from the date of the receipt. Needless to state that if the application is compliant with the applicable rules and regulations and is complete in all respects, steps will be taken to inspect the new premises. In case of any shortcomings, Respondents will send an intimation pointing out the deficiencies and Petitioners will take steps to cure/rectify them. If for any reason, the approval cannot be granted, a reasoned and speaking order will be passed by the Respondents and communicate the same to the Petitioners. This entire exercise shall be completed within eight weeks.”

Further, the petitioner institution filed the Contempt Petition (C) No.476/2026 in W.P. (C) No.19116/2025 titled as Shri Sharda College of Education & Anr. Vs. Ms. Rashmi Shukla, Regional

Director, Western Regional Committee (NCTE) & Anr. in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. An E.mail dated 23.03.2026 regarding the hearing update has been received from the Panel Counsel, Shri Anuj Kapoor. The Standing Counsel has communicated the outcome of the hearing through the following email, quoted verbatim:

“Dear LC,

The aforesaid contempt petition was listed for hearing today. It was submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the time period of 8 weeks had already elapsed, and despite the order and its due compliance by the institute, their fresh application dated 20.12.2025 for shifting premises has not been considered. The Court has issued notice in the matter and has directed the Respondents; NCTE and WRC to decide the application of the Petitioner college within a period of 2 weeks from today. The matter is now listed for hearing on 15.04.2026. This is urgent and for your information and necessary action.”

In reference to court order dated 17.12.2025, a fresh application dated 18.12.2025 for shifting of premises is submitted by the institution vide their letter Ref: 102/SET/2025-26 dated 20.12.2025 received in WRC, NCTE on 26.12.2025. The Committee observed that the institution be asked to submit following documents for further processing of its shifting application as per extant procedure of NCTE:-

- i. NOC from the State Examination Board for shifting of premises.
- ii. The provision of shifting the institution from one district to another district as per laws of the Land, Govt. of Gujarat.
- iii. NOC from the Govt. of Gujarat to shift the institution from one district to another district.
- iv. Copy of Resolution passed by the Management Committee/ parent body for shifting TEI duly notarized.
- v. Copy of translated version of the certified registered land document/Sale Deed clearly earmarking that this is the original copy of translated into English/Hindi language duly notarized and photocopy of original certified registered Sale Deed.
- vi. Original affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper in NCTE prescribed proforma regarding land documents as per NCTE norms.
- vii. Mutation Certificate of land issued by competent Govt. authority.
- viii. Conversion of Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning name of the institution/society, all Khasra/Plot/Survey No., Land Area after conversion to use the land from agriculture to educational purpose issued by the competent Govt. authority in prescribed format of State Govt.
- ix. Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by competent authority of State Govt. indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- x. Legible copy of approved building plan certified by competent authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary/ other programmes (if any).

- xi. Earmarked and demarcated land area and built up area for all running Teacher Education programmes by the institution.
- xii. Site Plan issued by competent authority of State Government.
- xiii. Latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in prescribed format of NCTE (covering 17 points) duly certified by competent Govt. authority mentioning detail information in respect of all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- xiv. Permission/ letter for Building Construction certified by competent Govt. authority.
- xv. Geographic location of the institution/ GPS coordinates indicating Latitude and Longitude of institution.
- xvi. Geotag photos with different angles of institution building Front view, Rear View, Multipurpose Hall, Library, Lab 1, Lab 2, Lab 3 and playground, Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilets indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph (if any).
- xvii. Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by competent Govt. authority.
- xviii. Fire Safety Certificate issued by competent Govt. Authority of Fire Safety Department, Govt. of Gujarat.
- xix. Latest certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the competent Govt. authority.
- xx. Latest Faculty list in original duly approved by State Govt. for P.T.C.(D.El.Ed.) course in NCTE prescribed proforma mentioning academic session along with letters of approval of concerned Affiliating Body for selection/ appointment of faculties in respect of the said course.
- xxi. Original Notarized Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper by the management regarding selection and appointment of faculties as per laid down procedure on the recommendations of Committee constituted by Affiliating Body for P.T.C. (D.El.Ed.) course.
- xxii. Original Notarized Affidavit on Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by the individual selected /appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma for P.T.C. (D.El.Ed.) course.
- xxiii. Copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts issued by Nationalized/Scheduled Bank towards Endowment Fund (Rs.5.00 lakh) and Reserve Fund (Rs.7.00 lakh) in the joint operation mode with Regional Director, WRC-NCTE and the Management along with duly filled Form 'A' in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per provisions under Clause 10(1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- xxiv. Status regarding maintaining and updating of institution's website along with downloaded copies in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

It is informed by the institution vide letter Ref. Nil dated 28.04.2025 received in WRC, NCTE on 30.05.2025, the institution has been affiliated with State Examination Board and Primary Education Department, Gujarat since 2002-2003. However, over the past 10 years the institute did not admit any new students.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution shall be required to submit a reply and documents supported with an Affidavit within 07 (seven) days from receipt of this notice. After submission of all requisite documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit and fulfillment of laid down conditions in accordance with provisions under Clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 within the stipulated time period, the matter be placed before WRC for further necessary action in light of NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, instructions and guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time.

Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and NCTE, WRC Committee noted that in pursuance of order dated 17.12.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 19116/2025 titled Shri Sharda College of Education & Anr. vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., a fresh application dated 18.12.2025 for shifting of premises is submitted by the institution vide their letter Ref: 102/SET/2025-26 dated 20.12.2025 received in WRC, NCTE on 26.12.2025. The Committee observed that the institution be asked to submit following documents for further processing of its shifting application as per extant procedure of NCTE:-

- i. NOC from the present Affiliating University to transfer to another University under the jurisdiction of shifting of premises.
- ii. The provision of shifting the institution from one district to another district as per laws of the Land, Govt. of Gujarat.
- iii. NOC from the Govt. of Gujarat to shift the institution from one district to another district.
- iv. Copy of Resolution passed by the Management Committee/ parent body for shifting TEI duly notarized.
- v. NOC from the Govt. of Gujarat to shift the institution from one district to another district.
- vi. Copy of translated version of the certified registered land document/Sale Deed clearly earmarking that this is the original copy of translated into English/Hindi language duly notarized and photocopy of original certified registered Sale Deed.

- xxv. Status regarding maintaining and updating of institution's website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- xxvi. Status of stay by Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in R/ SCA No.13615 of 2024 filed by Petitioner Institution in reference to Order dated 05.09.2024 issued by Education Department, Govt. of Gujarat and subsequent letter dated 07.09.2024 issued by Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University related to de-affiliation of B.Ed. course.

A copy of institution/society letter Ref. No.10/SET/2024-25 dated 23.09.2024 is enclosed along with another letter Ref. No.40/SET/2025-26 dated 20.09.2024/10.07.2025 received in WRC, NCTE on 24.07.2025, wherein mentioned that the institution has temporarily moved to the new premises at Chattral, Ta; Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution shall be required to submit a reply and documents supported with an Affidavit within 07 (seven) days from receipt of this notice. After submission of all requisite documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit and fulfillment of laid down conditions in accordance with provisions under Clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 within the stipulated time period, the matter be placed before WRC for further necessary action in light of NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, instructions and guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time.

Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and following observations have been made by the Committee:

That Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 1641/2026 titled Shri Ukabhai Dodiya B.Ed. College vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., vide its order dated 05.02.2026 passed the following directions:

“...1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayer: “(a) Issue a Writ of Certiorari and direct the respondent no.2 to consider & decide the pending application dt. 05.02.2021, submitted by the petitioner for shifting of its premises, in accordance with law expeditiously in a time bound manner;

2. Mr. Arora, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the application for change of premise of the petitioner has not been decided for a considerable period of time by respondent No. 2.

3. For the said reasons, issue notice.

4. Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents without admitting the averments made by the petitioner and subject to verification of the documents, he states that if the application has not been decided so far, the same shall be done expeditiously and without admitting the averments made by the petitioner and subject to verification of the record.

5. Directing the respondent to hear and dispose of the representation of the petitioner expeditiously and not later than 8 weeks from today, the petition is disposed of.

6. In case the petitioner is aggrieved, the petitioner will be at liberty to challenge the outcome.”

In view of the directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide court order dated 05.02.2026, application dated 05.02.2021 for shifting of premises along with other documents and communications made by the institution from time to time were carefully examined as per extant Regulation and guidelines of NCTE and Committee made following observations:

- (i) The validity of Demand Draft of Rs.27,000/- dated 20.02.2025 submitted in connection with shifting of premises has been expired. The institution be asked to re-validate the DD or submit a fresh DD against this amount to WRC, NCTE within 07 days of receipt of the letter.
- (ii) WRC is in opinion that the application for shifting of the premises has been made by the institution in the year 2021.

In view of the above, the Committee resolved that Visiting Team be constituted for conducting Virtual Inspection of the institution at the proposed shifting to its new premises located at S.No. 453 Paiki, At. Visanvel Gadu Chorwad Road, Near GEB Sub Station Ta. Maliya Hatina, Dist. Junagadh, Gujarat- 362255 in order to ascertain and scrutinize all the essential documents and at the time of verification, VT shall also check/verify student list year-wise, website and Fire Safety Certificate and all Building & land related documents, so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the course as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

The office of WRC, NCTE shall initiate process for conduct of virtual inspection only after receiving of Demand Draft of Rs.27,000/- in favour of Member Secretary, NCTE payable at Dwarka, New Delhi.
