Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution together with reply of final SCN were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed that deficiencies pointed out in final SCN are persisting:

- i. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- ii. The uploaded documents are irrelevant. The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- iii. The uploaded list of teaching staff is not duly countersigned by its affiliating body and not in the prescribed format of NCTE and not as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 and amendments time by time.
- iv. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- v. TEI has uploaded fire safety certificate in the name of "Bhom Singh Memorial Charitable Trust" valid up to 06.01.2028 with approved plot area 1500 sq.mts. in the online application, the institution has mentioned in the land details, in which the area of the land has been mentioned as 33,000 square meters. Both land area mismatch.
- vi. A board with the name of the college is seen to be put up temporarily. This board can be removed at any time.
- vii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- viii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- ix. The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- x. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- xi. The institution website "<http://www.bsmct.com/>" is not operational at the time of scrutiny. The institution has failed to maintain and update the website in violation of compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- xii. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programme.

- ii. The uploaded documents are not proper. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- iii. The uploaded documents are not proper. The proposal for 'merger' between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- iv. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- v. The uploaded Certificate of Land Use (CLU) is not in the prescribed format in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) of the Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission and Allotment of Use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes) Rules, 2012, nor mentions all Khasra/Plot/Survey numbers issued by the competent government authority.
- vi. The name of applicant College is not reflected in the geotagged photo uploaded.
- vii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- viii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- ix. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- xi. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- xii. The institution has not uploaded copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the concerned Govt. Competent Authority for khasra no. 199 and 1475/1130.
- xiii. The institution website "<http://gdcollege.bijarniagoes.com/>" is not operational at the time of scrutiny. The institution has failed to maintain and update the website in violation of compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- xiv. In the Land Details, Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 3440. The both applicant and merger institutions are running multidisciplinary and teacher education programme/ courses in the same campus/premises i.e. B.A. 120x3=360, B.Sc.60x3=180. M.A. 100x2=200, M.Sc. 60x2=120. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with of multidisciplinary courses and intake, B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1unit), course cannot be ascertained.
- xv. The institution has applied for issuance of online Fire Safety Certificate to Nagar Palika, Mandrella Distt.-Jhunjhunu (Raj.) on LSG Portal on 29.09.2025 but till to date certificate has

not been generated. Copy of online Fire Safety Certificate application submitted to Nagar Palika, Mandrella Distt.-Jhunjhunu (Raj.) vide application No.LSG/MANDRELLA/FIRENOC / 2025-26 / 59533 dated 29.09.2025 is attached. This application checked on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx. and found application is Rejected and NOC NOT ISSUED.

- xvi. The uploaded list of teaching staff duly countersigned by its affiliating body is not in the prescribed format of NCTE and not as per NCTE regulation 2014 and amendments time by time.
- xvii. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.

Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Division Ghatol, but khasra no. 108-115,145,146/742,146/745,146/750,147,155-156,165-169,174-175,177,182 not reflected in the Building Safety Certificate. The University has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- iii. The University has not uploaded proper Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- iv. The University has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- v. In the Land Details, University claimed that Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) 78235. the University is conducting degree courses BBA/BBA (Honours) BBA(Honours with Research) BBA digital Marketing, BBA Fintech and Digital Banking, .BCA-AIML, CYBER SECURITY, B.Com, B.Com, (Honours), B.Com. (Honours with Research), B.A. in English, B.A. LLB, BBA LLB (Hons), LLB, B.Sc. Nursing), B.Tech (Biotechnology), B.Tech (Biomedical Engineering) B.Tech (Computer Science Engineering)B.Tech (Food Technology) B.Pharm. B.Sc. (Clinical Dietetics/ B.Sc. (Hons) Clinical Dietetics B.Sc. (CD), Bachelor in Radiation Technology/ Medical Imaging Technology BRT/B.Sc. MIT, Bachelor in Operation Theatre Technology, B.Sc. The university has NOT uploaded mutation certificate obtained from Revenue Records of the State Govt. for khasra no. 108-115, 145, 146/742, 146/745, 146/750, 147, 155-156, 165-169, 174-175, 177 and 182 instead of that they uploaded notarized copy of Lease Deed with To Whom It May Concern Certificate dated 29.01.2025 on the basis of report of the Tehsildar regarding Kh. Nos. pertaining to land approved by Up-Zila Collector & Magistrate, Jaipur-II Sanganer, Jaipur. The University is required to upload Mutation Certificate mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- viii. The University has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- ix. University has not uploaded specific documents. Kh. No. 108-115, 145, 146/742, 146/745, 146/750, 147, 155-156, 165-169, 174-175, 177, 182 mentioned in portal are NOT reflected in the registered land documents Lease Deed.

- iv. Institution is running multidisciplinary and teacher education programme in a same premises. For both multidisciplinary and teacher education programme, the uploaded geotagged photographs reveal that the reading room in the library does not have seating capacity for students as per NCTE norms.
- v. The uploaded list of teaching staff is not in the prescribed format of NCTE and teaching staff is not as per NCTE norms and this prescribed format is not approved by the university authority.
- vi. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.

- vii. The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.Sc.120x3= 260, B.Com 60x3=180, B.C.A. 180x3=540 Combine intake 980. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit) its required 2600 sq mt. for this course in the building plan Demarked built up area 2306.85 which is not as per NCTE Norms. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- iii. Website home page does not clearly reflect name of institution building. The institution is required to maintain and update website showing all parameters in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The Institution is required to upload the category of Institution in the institution details.
- iv. Address of society as per portal is NIRMAL HAPPY SCHOOL SAMITI HINDAUN CITY, plot no. F-157, Mohan Nagar, Hindaun City, Karauli, Rajasthan-322230, whereas uploaded fire safety certificate dated 24-12-2025 valid up to 23-12-2027 is issued in the address "NIRMAL HAPPY SCHOOL SAMITI HINDAUN CITY, 02, NIRMAL HAPPY SCHOOL SAMITI, HINDAUN CITY, HINDAUN CITY, HINDAUN, KARAULI, RAJASTHAN" with approved plot area 4533 sq.mts. As per portal land area is 12000 sq.mts. Both area is mismatch.
- v. The institution must upload the list of teaching staff in the prescribed format of NCTE duly approved by the concerned Registrar and the affiliated university and teaching staff should be as per NCTE norms.
- vi. The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- vii. Both institutions are running multidisciplinary and teacher education programme/ courses in the same campus/premises i.e. B.A. 320x3=960, B.Sc.380x3=1140. M.Sc.65x2=130. The

- sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with of multidisciplinary courses and intake for Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 2 units, B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit) course cannot be ascertained.
- viii. The name of applicant College is not reflected on any part of building in the geotagged photos uploaded.
- ix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms and furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- xi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xii. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- xiii. Copy of proof of shifting approval order of B.Ed. course to a new address (if any) is not uploaded on the portal.
- xiv. TEI has uploaded a copy of Land Calcification Certificate dated 30-05-2023 issued by Tahasildar, Hindaun City, Karauli mentioning Kh.No.1452, 1453, 1521/1 1521/2 land area 1.86 Hectare and 4.59 Acre in the name of “NIRMAL HAPPY SCHOOL SAMITI, HINDAUN CITY” out of which patta has been issued by Nagar Parishad, Hindaun City dated 19.07.2017 land area 4627.69 sq.mts. and dated 19.07.2017 land area 4491.97 sq.mts.(total area 13638 ssq.mts.) for use of land for educational purpose and these khasra nos. are contiguous to each other. Plot / Khasra no. shown in the portal is not mentioned in either B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed recognition order or B.Ed. recognition order.

- ix. The Zoology and Chemistry labs lack sufficient seating and workstations for students to perform experiments effectively.
- x. In ICT Lab the number of functional computers is insufficient to cater to the student intake.
- xi. The playground exists only as an unmaintained open space without any specific marking or designated courts for recognized sports.
- xii. The academic schedule reflects poor planning; classes are being allotted in the Seminar Hall and Girls' Common Room, which is academically inappropriate. This flawed timetable has also been uploaded to the college website. (<https://srrcollege.com/assets/user/assets/pdf/time%20table%202025-26.pdf>)
- xiii. The institution also conducts several other programmes, including B.A. (360 seats), B.Sc. in Mathematics & Biology (120 seats), and M.A. programs in Hindi, English, Geography, and Political Science (40 seats each); however, there are not enough classrooms to accommodate these students alongside the Teacher Education programme.
- xiv. During inspection, the institution uploaded Front view and Rear-view photos to the dashboard, without receiving the necessary instructions from the VT members.
- xv. There is a significant discrepancy in the dashboard data. While 4400 sq. m. is mentioned as the Total Built-Up Area, the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) indicates a different area specifically allotted for Teacher Education. This data is mismatch.
- xvi. There is a significant inconsistency in the institution's identity; the college website refers to it as "Shree Rangey Raghav College," whereas the NCTE dashboard lists it as "Shree Rangey Raghav Mahavidyalaya."
- xvii. Building Plan is not made by the Council of Architecture registered Architect and not uploaded in good resolution to read.
- xviii. The break up of built up area mentioned in the application form does not match with the uploaded building plan.
