1	<p><b>Decision of WRC :</b></p> <p>On careful perusal of the original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Directions of the Hon'ble Court, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee noted the following:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 29.01.2026 in W.P.(C) 1207/2026, the matter was considered by WRC in its 453<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> to 07<sup>th</sup> March 2026 wherein the WRC decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply / representation within 7 days of the issue of Show Cause Notice.</li> <li>2. Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC, the Show Cause Notice dated 20.03.2026 was issued to the institution through E-mail as well as through post with a copy endorsed to the Society of the institution and the affiliating body.</li> <li>3. The Show Cause Notice sent to the institution &amp; Society through post has been returned undelivered by postal department with the remarks "No such person in this address."</li> <li>4. No reply has been received from the institution, society or the respective Affiliating Body till date and the stipulated time period of seven days is over.</li> </ol> <p><b>The WRC noted that the decision is to be taken by WRC within the time period as stipulated by the Hon'ble Court, hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply / representation within 7 days of the issue of Final Show Cause Notice, failing which appropriate decision will be taken by WRC on merits.</b></p>

**Decision of WRC**

The online applications of the aforesaid 13 institutions along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Rules, NCTE Regulations 2014, Directions of the Hon'ble Court, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Western Regional Committee. The Committee noted the following::

- The above mentioned institutions approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in various Writ Petitions (as mentioned against each institution)
- The Petitioner Institutions submitted applications for transition of its B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. courses to I.T.E.P. Course. WRC issued the impugned order refusing the transition application citing alleged deficiencies in the submission, as the Committee observed that the applications of the institutions was liable to be refused in pursuance of the Public Notice dated 12.09.2025 issued on the official portal of the NCTE, wherein it has been stipulated that institutions which do not fulfil the prescribed requirement of being a multidisciplinary institution shall be summarily rejected by the concerned Regional Committee.
- The Petitioners challenged the refusal order of the WRC before the Hon'ble High Court on the ground that no opportunity was given to make a written representation. The institutions filed various Writ Petitions before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in this regard and the Hon'ble Court passed an order with the following directions: -
  - The Court held that the impugned order, though based on alleged deficiencies in the application, was passed without granting the petitioner a reasonable opportunity of making a written representation as mandated by the proviso to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993. Such denial of opportunity violated principles of natural justice and the mandatory statutory requirement.
  - The contention of the respondents/NCTE that the decision amounted to a mere "rejection" under Regulation 7(1) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and not a "refusal"

<p>attracting Section 14(3)(b), was rejected. The Court held that the distinction between “rejection” and “refusal” under the Regulations is irrelevant for the applicability of Section 14(3)(b), which mandates an opportunity of representation before denial of recognition or transition. Reliance on clauses of the Public Notice dated 12.09.2025 to justify summarily rejection was also negated as executive instructions cannot override statutory provisions.</p> <p>2. Accordingly, the impugned orders by WRC were set aside. The respondents/WRC were directed to issue a show cause notice specifying deficiencies, grant the petitioners an opportunity to submit a written representation within two weeks, and thereafter pass a fresh reasoned order within two weeks in accordance with law. The Court clarified that it expressed no opinion on the merits of the case and disposed of the writ petition.</p> <p>3. Pursuant to the said court judgment, the matter was placed before the WRC at its 447 (Part-1) meeting held on 21-23<sup>rd</sup> January 2026 whereupon, as per the minutes of the meeting the Committee resolved as follows:</p> <p><i>“The Committee, after thorough examination and deliberation, decided that to challenge the order dated 01.12.2025 in W.P.(C) 18213/2025 titled Tak Shiksha Niketan T.T. College vs. National Council for Teacher Education &amp; Anr. in the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi. The decision of WRC shall accordingly be forwarded to the concerned Division/ Department of NCTE for further necessary action.”</i></p> <p>4. The court order clearly stipulates that, without going into the merits of the case, a reasonable opportunity of being heard shall be afforded to the petitioners. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice (SCN) be issued to all the affected institutes before taking any further action in the matter.</p> <p><b>After perusal and deliberation, the Committee observed that the application of the institutions were liable to be refused in pursuance of the Public Notice dated 12.09.2025 issued on the official portal of the NCTE, wherein it has been stipulated that institutions which do not fulfil the prescribed requirement of being a multidisciplinary institution shall be summarily rejected by the concerned Regional Committee. However, in compliance with the directions contained in the Orders (date mentioned against each institution) passed by the Hon’ble High Court, it is clear that the Court has not gone into the merits of the case and has directed that a reasonable opportunity be provided to the petitioner institution. Accordingly, the Committee resolved to undertake a complete scrutiny of the application(s), including the preliminary criteria mentioned therein, submitted by the petitioner institution before issuance of any Show Cause Notice.</b></p>
