In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Even till the time of this scrutiny, the website of institution www.mjvsansthan.org has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the website as per NCTE regulations.
- ii. As Per the Website Uploaded By institution in online application form i.e. [HTTPS://DEEPSHIKHA.ORG/](https://DEEPSHIKHA.ORG/) The Institution Is Conducting Degree Courses I.E. B.A. 60x3=180, B.Sc.60x3= 180. As Per The Website Of Institution They Are Running B.Tch. And M.Tech., Bba And MBA, BCA And MCA, B.Com., Political Diploma In Civil, Electrical, Mechanical And Electronics And Communication. Pharmacy And Other. The Institution Is Required To Upload The Approved Annual Intake Of All Courses On The Online Portal. The Sufficiency Of Land Area And Built-Up Area For The Above Courses With Of Multidisciplinary Courses And Intake For B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (2 Unit) Course Cannot Be Ascertained.
- iii. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale
- iv. The institution has not upload Mutation Certificate mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- v. In this column institution uploaded self-made salary details that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- vi. committee noted that, College Khasra Numbers/plot numbers and other details are not mentioned in the Uploaded building safety certificate no. EE-III/BSC/D-266 issued on dated 4/2/2026
- vii. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- viii. The institution has uploaded so many irrelevant documents. The institution has not uploaded the proper Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- ix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xi. The uploaded B.Sc. B.Ed. staff profile is not readable. The Committee cannot ascertain whether the teaching staff profile is within the prescribed pattern of NCTE and as per NCTE Regulations 2014 and as amended from time to time.
- xii. The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU). The institution has uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Arese (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.

- xiii. The institution has the total land area of 3000 sqm wherein the institution is running the various Degree Courses and proposed ITEP course, which is not sufficient. As per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, the land area of 3000 sqm is exclusively required for ITEP course.
- xiv. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.

Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- ii. The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded geotag photos of Lift, Ramp, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet with date of photographs with different angles.
- iv. The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- v. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- vi. As per the affiliation order No. P9 () AFFILIATION-ACAD./2025-26/34644, the institution to be collaborated with is only running B.A. Courses. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.
- vii. The institution has not uploaded the Revised recognition order for B. Ed course.
- viii. Authorization letter has NOT uploaded on the stamp paper as per admissible government rate.
- ix. The same society has sold a part of Khasra No. 1011/154 to another society for establishing Vikas Teacher Training College. 2627202510043686.
- x. The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xi. Institution has NOT uploaded the NOC letter no. p-9() affiliation/ ba.bed./bsC.bed./2025-26/32859 issued by its affiliating body as mentioned in the online portal.

- xii. Institution has uploaded the land documents of Kh. No. 1011/154 of 5000 sq.m. land. documents of Kh. NO.1013/803/154 has not uploaded by the institution.
- xiii. The institution has not uploaded/provide proof that all khasara number i.e. Kh. No. 1013/803/154 , 1011/154 are a single plot, upload a proof issued by government competent authority. The institution is required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government showing that the building is situated on a single plot.
- xiv. The records of 2627202510043670, 2627202510043682 and 2627202510043686 Institution have been reviewed, and it is observed that the Kh. No. (Khasra Number) mentioned in all three files is the same, indicating consistency of land identification across the records of all three institutions.
- xv. The institution has not uploaded geotag photo of institution building Front view, Rear View, Multipurpose Hall, Library, Lab 1, Lab 2, Lab 3 and playground with date of photographs.
- xvi. The institution has not uploaded the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmed duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution has not uploaded the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
- xvii. The Institution has not uploaded information of all programme/courses run by institution in the campus and the institution is required to upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.
- xviii. The same society is running the two colleges on the same land. Arjunram Teacher Training College, Sikar (Application No 262720510043670) Shri Arjunram Shikshan Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya, Sikar (Application No 262720510043682).
- xix. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx.
- xx. Institution has not uploaded the Building plan of Kh. No. 1013/154 -1011/154 of total land built-up area is 5676.2 sq.m. Further, the earmarked land and built-up area for each course being run in the same premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for teacher education programmes is not mentioned in the building plan. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- xxi. The institution has not uploded submit the de-marketed site plan duly approved by the competent authority of the state government earmarking the land & built-up area for ITEP course and other courses/ school being run in the premises as per the Guidelines issued by the Government of Rajasthan for available on <https://hte.rajasthan.gov.in/dept/dce/uploads/doc/NOCpolicy202122.pdf>.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

(I,II,III,IV), website and Fire Safety Certificate and all Building & land related documents, so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the course.

Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution has not uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx.
- ii. The institution has not uploaded the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by the competent Government authority.
- iv. The Name of Applicant institution is "Prabha Devi Memorial Mahavidyalaya Kabri Dungri, Mundota, Jalsu, (Amer), Kabri Dungri, Jaipur, Rajasthan-303706" and the multidisciplinary college Name is "Prabha Devi Memorial PG Mahavidhyalaya, Kabri Doongari Tehsil Amer Jaipur" the name of both institutions does not match.
- v. The institution has NOT uploaded complete additional information on their website as per clause 7(14), 8(6), 10(3) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 and clause 2(C) of the NCTE Regulations.
- vi. The institution has not uploaded BCC in the NCTE prescribe Format of the NCTE mentioning all Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- vii. The institution uploaded Sale Deed 27.02.2024 issued by Up-Panjiyak, Teh- Jalsu, Jaipur for Kh. Nos. 557, 556, 558, 555/1, 555/2 and 555/3 but NOT reflected Kh. Nos. 31/2, 31/975/2 and 18 which are mentioned in portal.
- viii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- ix. The institution has uploaded bank statement for the period of 01-03-2024 to 01-04-2025 only which is also uploaded at the time of reply of fist SCN with approval letter of teaching staff (1+15) approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur dated 11.11.2017, but not uploaded staff list of all Education Faculty programme countersigned by University of Rajasthan. Now, the institution has uploaded the bank statement period 01.03.2024 to 01.03.2025, cross checked as per approved staff randomly, and NOT found/ reflected and NOT highlighted the transaction of the salary / remuneration is to its teaching staff in bank statement. Over all conclusion is salary is not clear as per Central/State Govt. pay scale.
- x. The committee noticed that in the geotagged photo uploaded, the name of the applicant college does not appear on the facade of the college building/main building. After serving the show cause notice, the college painted the name of its college on one side of the building.
- xi. The institution has not uploaded the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- xii. The institution has not uploaded the list of teaching staff in the prescribed format of NCTE duly approved by the concerned Registrar and the affiliated university and teaching staff should be as per NCTE norms.
- xiii. The uploaded building plan is not proper. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each

- course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes
- xiv. Committee noted that, the institution has uploaded the building plan approved by Assistant Engineer. The Khasra No. 31/2, 975/2, 556, 557, 558, 555/1, 555/2, 555/3, 557/1 with a land area of 7200 sq. mts. is mentioned therein. However, There is also a mismatch between the land area indicated in the Plan and the land area stated in the affidavit and on the online portal. Further, the earmarked land and built-up area for each course being run in the same premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for teacher education programmes is not mentioned in the building plan.
- xv. The uploaded geotagged photographs show that the seating capacity of the reading room of the library is not sufficient as per NCTE norms. After receiving the show cause notice, the institution created a space for the purpose of taking geotagged photos. Actually, it looks like it is a classroom. And this reading room does not have proper furniture.
- xvi. As per the Uploaded BCC is not mentioning all Khasra no. The institution is required to upload BCC in the NCTE prescribe Format of the NCTE mentioning all Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority. The institution has uploaded BCC in the NCTE prescribed format mentioning all Khasra No. issued by Local Authority i.e. Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Kudoyo ka Bag, Panchayat Samiti, Jaipur.
- xvii. In the Land Details Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 15000. The Name of Applicant institution is “Prabha Devi Memorial Mahavidyalaya Kabri Dungri, Mundota, Jalsu, (Amer), Kabri Dungri, Jaipur, Rajasthan-303706” and the multidisciplinary college Name is “Prabha Devi Memorial PG Mahavidhyalaya, Kabri Doongari Tehsil Amer Jaipur” the name of both institutions does not match. Assume that, Prabha Devi Memorial Mahavidyalaya is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. 300x3=900, B.Sc.240x3= 720, B.Com. 120x3=360, M.A. (history, English, Drawing & Painting, Geography, Hindi, Political Science, Sanskrit, Economics, Public Administration, Sociology,) 400x2=800, M.Sc. (Physics, Chemistry and Zoology) 120x2=240, M.Com 120x2=240 total 3260 students. as per geotag photo uploaded its shows that they are running D.Pharm. PGTDA. Yoga and PGDCA also. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with multidisciplinary courses and intake for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), Middle (2 unit) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), Middle (2 unit) 400x4=1600 course cannot be ascertained.
- xviii. College Khasra Numbers/plot numbers and other things are not mentioned in the Uploaded building safety certificate no. EE/PWD/Shp/D-1105 issued on dated 15/01/2026. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

The institution has not replied to the Show Cause Notice issued on 9.1.2026.

- i. The institution has not uploaded the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.

- ii. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx.
- iii. The institution is required to update and maintain the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- iv. The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- v. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.

Sec-HQ dated 22/16/2023-Reg.Sec-HQ dated 5.2.2024 (2025-26). The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.
- vii. The institution has mentioned Land area 5090 sq mt. in land details whereas in CLU and NEC mentioned land area 2500 sqmt. land area mentioned mismatched. The institution is required to clarify the same.
- viii. The name of applicant institution is Maharaja Shri Surajmal Teacher Training College and the name of multidisciplinary Institution is Maharaj Shri Surajmal college Both Institutions name mismatch
- ix. Two different college name board i.e. applicant college name Maharaja Shri Surajmal Teacher Training College and multidisciplinary college name Maharaj Shri Surajmal college are seen on the college building.
- x. A geotagged photograph shows some part of the building left unrepaired.
- xi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- xiii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xiv. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- xv. The uploaded geotagged photographs show that the library and other labs are not in good condition.
- xvi. The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- xvii. Lift, Ramp, Safe Drinking Water related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- xviii. College Khasra Numbers/plot numbers and other things are not mentioned in the Uploaded building safety certificate no. 4068 issued on dated 24/09/2024.
