<p>In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, reply of final Show Cause Notice post Preliminary Scrutiny, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The name of applicant institution i.e. LBS TT College, which does not match with the name of the institution i.e. LBS College as mentioned in the letter of affiliation dated 11.07.2025 issued by GOVIND GURU TRIBAL UNIVERSITY uploaded by the institution for multi-disciplinary programme, the name of institution is L.B.S. Lal bahadur shastri Mahavidyalaya. There is mismatch in the name of applicant institution with MDI institution. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018-MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTERegl022/16/2023-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 22/16/2023-Reg.Sec-HQ dated 5.2.2024 (2025-26). The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.</li> <li>As per the uploaded Mutation Certificate, mentioned Khasra No. is 2655/9101, 2656, 2657/9108, 2658/9108, 2655 and 2658/9112, whereas the mentioned Khasra No. in the land</li> </ol>			

- details column is 2655, 2656, 2658, 9333/2685, 2686, 9334/2685. The khasra No. is mismatched.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded proper Mutation (Jamabandi) Certificate mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government
  - iv. As per the uploaded Building plan, the mentioned Khasra No. is 2655, 2656, 2658, 2685, 2686 & 2654, whereas the mentioned Khasra No. in the land details column is 2655, 2656, 2658, 9333/2685, 2686, 9334/2685. The khasra No. is mismatched. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
  - v. The website of the institution has not been maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution has not updated the website as per NCTE regulations.
  - vi. The institution mentioned land details column Khasra No. is 2655, 2656, 2658, 9333/2685, 2686, 9334/2685 (ii) The institution has mentioned the Khasra No. in the address column of the online application is 2655, 2656, 2658, 2685, 2686. (iii) As per the uploaded Mutation Certificate 2655/9101, 2656, 2657/9108, 2658/9108, 2655 and 2658/9112 (iv) The institution has uploaded CLU is mentioned khasra No. 9109/9113, 2658/9112, 9109/9113, 2658/9108, 2655/9107, 2656, 2686, 9333/2685, 9334/2685. The Khasra Nos. are mismatched.
  - vii. It cannot be ascertained from the pay distribution register/statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale. The institution has not been able to prove/confirm whether the institution is paying salaries to the teaching staff as per Central/State Govt norms.
  - viii. Committee noted that, the geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
  - ix. The uploaded building plan is not proper. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
  - x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
  - xi. In the filled information of Land Details in online application, Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 4211.68. The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. 80x3=240, B.Sc.70x3= 210, as per the affiliation order they are running M.A. Geography 60x2=120, M.Sc. Chemistry 30x2=60. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with of multidisciplinary courses and intake for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (4 units), Middle (4 units) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (4 units), Middle (4 units) course cannot be ascertained.
  - xii. As per institution uploaded Land Affidavit dated 22.01.2026, total land area 10227 sq.mts. and total built up area 6339.94 sq.mts(Block-A 4211.68 Sq.mts. +Block-B 2127.96 Sq.mts.) showing khasra no.2654,2655, 2656, 2658, 2685, 2686, whereas in the filled information of Land Details in online application, Land area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) 5228, Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 4211.68 showing Khasra no. 2655, 2656, 2658, 9333/2685, 2686, 9334/2685. Both total land area, total built up area and khasra no. are

mismatched.

**In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

**Decision of WRC:**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, reply of final Show Cause Notice post Preliminary Scrutiny, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The name of applicant institution is 'Bhartiya Balika Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya' and name of multidisciplinary institution is 'Bhartiya Mahila P.G. Mahavidyalaya'. Hence, there is a mismatch with respect to the name of the college. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.
- ii. Copy of building plan certified by Sahayak Abhiyanta is uploaded showing Khasra No.303/164,306/164 Total land area 11100 sq.mts. and earmarking built up area in the name of BHARTIYA BALIKA SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, BIKANER BY PASS ROAD, CHANDPURA, SIKAR Block-A (G.F.+F.F.+S.F.) B.Ed. and B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. (Built up area 3000 sq.mts.) and B.A., M.A. (built up area 1500 sq.mts.) and in the name of BHARTIYA MAHILA PG MAHAVIDYALAYA, CHANDPURA, SIKAR RAJ. Block-B (G.F.+F.F.) M.SC., B.SC. (built up area 2214.97 sq.mts. Khasra nos. mentioned in the building plan is not reflected in the recognition order for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course.
- iii. The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. intake (660), B.Sc. intake (300), M.A. intake (160), M.Sc. intake (200), combined intake of 1320. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 1320 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 100 intake for B.A.B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. and 200 intake for B.Ed. course cannot be ascertained, since the institution has mentioned the total built-up area 4500 sq.mts.
- iv. The website of the institution is not functional. The functional website of institution has not been created, maintained and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- v. As per given geographic location, name of institution "Bhartiya Institute of Engineering &..." is shown on the google map. As per transition application geographic location coordinates with latitude 27.5711109 and longitude 75.1437159 pertains to the institution, whereas different latitude 75.14382487591412 and different longitude 27.571001100291976 are mentioned in its reply to point of SCN and no explanation submitted in reply of point of final Show Cause Notice

- post Preliminary Scrutiny.
- vi. Committee noted that the geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
  - vii. Committee noted that the geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
  - viii. The Institution has not uploaded the list of teaching staff per NCTE norms for all courses of teacher education duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE.
  - ix. Committee noted that, College Khasra Numbers/plot numbers and other details are not mentioned in the uploaded building safety certificate no.1906 issued on dated 03.10.2025 is without office seal of certificate issuing authority. It has not mentioned therein that the certificate is issued in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority as required under NCTE Regulations, 2021.
  - x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
  - xi. The institution has not uploaded the proper Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.

**Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply of Final Show Cause Notice post Preliminary Scrutiny, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Recognition was granted for 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course vide order dated 15.02.2017 in the name and address “PSP College of Education,Plot No.-6714/1237, Street Number-Na, Village- Paratapur Garhi, P.O. Garhi, Tehsil/Taluka- Garhi,Town/City- Garhi, Dist. Banswara, Rajasthan, Pin Code-327024”, whereas institution applied for transition to ITEP course in the name and address “PSP College of Education Partapur, Khasra no.6714/1237,7023/6714/1237, Street/Road- Behind Garhi Court Office, Village/Town - PARTAPUR,P.o./Taluka- Garhi,Dist. Banswara, Rajasthan, Pin Code- 327022”, the Plot/Khasra no. Street/Road and Pin code are mismatched.
- ii. The name of applicant institution is ‘PSP College of Education’ as per the NCTE recognition order whereas the name of institution conducting Multi-Disciplinary Courses is ‘Prabha Shankar

Pandya P.G College, Partapur'. The name of institution is mismatched. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution. Further it is noted from the Building Plan uploaded by the institution that two other institutions are also functioning at the same premises (i) Prabha Shankar Pandya T.T. College, Partapur (2 Year B.Ed.) (ii) Prabha Shankar Pandya College, Partapur (2 Year D.El.Ed.).

- iii. The institution has uploaded Fire safety certificate issued in the name and address "PRABHA SHANKAR PANDYA SEVA SANSTHAN PARTAPUR, 6714/1237 7023/6714/1237, GARHI TEHSIL ROAD PARTAPUR, PARTAPUR, PARTAPUR -GARHI, BANSWARA, RAJASTHAN". Plot/Khasra no. Street/Road, address of society as per recognition are mismatched. On verification fire NOC portal, approved plot area is 10200 sq. mts., whereas as per online application, in Land Details, mentioned land area is 8000 sq. mts. Both land areas are mismatched. The institution has not uploaded requisite Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx).
- iv. The institution has not updated and maintained the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- v. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms. There is a mismatch of pin code of place taken geotagged photograph with recognition order, hence same is not accepted.
- vi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate. There is a mismatch of pin code of place taken geotagged photograph with recognition order, hence same is not accepted.
- vii. The name of Applicant College is not reflected in the geotagged photo uploaded. There is a mismatch of pin code of place taken geotagged photograph with recognition order, hence same is not accepted.
- viii. The uploaded building plan is not proper. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- ix. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale. The institution has not been able to prove/confirm whether the institution is paying salaries to the teaching staff as per Central/State Govt norms.
- x. The institution has uploaded the list of teaching staff duly approved and countersigned by different Affiliating University (GGTU Banswara) instead of Mohanlal Sukhadiya University, Udaipur as per recognition order. The uploaded faculty list is not in the prescribed format of NCTE and not as per NCTE norms.

**In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The name of institution recognised by NCTE is 'Saraswati Vidhya Mandir Sansthan' whereas the institution running the Multidisciplinary course is 'Saraswati College'. The name is mismatched. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTERegl011/3/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 06.05.2025 (2026-27). The institution does not fall in the category of multi-disciplinary institution.
- ii. As per the uploaded CLU, the mentioned Kh.no.415, 414, 1988/1986/416, 416, 197/417, 1986/416 and 1988/1986/416, whereas Khata no.416 mentioned in the Address Column and in the uploaded BCC, khasra no. mentioned is 416, 417 and 442. The Khasra No. is mismatched. The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- iii. The institution has not updated and maintained the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. Approved faculty list by Affiliating University/Body is not uploaded on the website.
- iv. As per the uploaded Building Plan, the mentioned land area is 8500 sq.mts. and hand-written land area 7200 sq.mts.(total area 15700 sq.mts.) and Built-up area (3492+1649=5141 sq.mts.), whereas in the land detail column, mentioned land area 8500 sq.mts. and Built-up area is 3492 sq.mts. The land and built-up area are mismatched. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- v. As per the uploaded Building safety certificate, the mentioned Khasra No.416, approved plot area is 3492 sq.mts. whereas in the online application for BCC, CLU, the Khasra No. 415, 414, 1988/1986/416, 416, 197/417, 1986/416 and 1988/1986/416 with land area 8500 sq.mts. The land area and Khasra No. are mismatched. Total built up area of both TE course and MDI course is mentioned 3492 sq.mts., which is differently mentioned in uploaded building plan.
- vi. In the Land Details, Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 3492. If assume that, the institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A.  $70 \times 3 = 210$ , B.Sc.  $70 \times 3 = 210$ , M.Sc.  $60 \times 2 = 120$ . The sufficiency of land area and built-up area for the above courses with of

- multidisciplinary courses and intake for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), course cannot be ascertained. - ii. The uploaded list of teaching staff is not proper, date of joining in the current assignment in respect of selected / appointed faculties is not reflected. The institution has not uploaded proper faculty list countersigned by Affiliating University as per NCTE regulation 2014 and amendments time by time.
- iii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- iv. The name of the Multidisciplinary college name is Sant Radha Raman College, the name of institution applied for transition to ITEP programme is "Sant Radha Raman College". However, name of institution recognized for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. is "Sant Radha Raman Teacher Traing College". The names of institution are mismatched. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27.
- v. As per the letter of affiliation F.No.16-1/CSU/Acd/SRRC/A1/2025 865 dated: 01.08.2025 issued by the Central Sanskrit University uploaded by the institution, it is running B.Sc. Yogic Science and Shastri (Sahitya and Vyakarana). The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27.
- vi. The name of applicant institution applied for transition to ITEP programme is not reflected on any part of building in the geotagged photo uploaded. A Flex board showing name of the college (Sant Radha Raman Teacher Training College) is seen to have been put up temporarily, uploaded on the transition application portal. This board can be removed at any time, hence same is not accepted. The photo of building on website home does not exactly match with geotagged photograph uploaded.
- vii. The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by

- Competent Government Authority.
- viii. The institution has not uploaded Exemption Certificate (12A) issued by Competent Government Authority.
- ix. The institution has not uploaded requisite Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx). On verification of uploaded fire safety certificate from Fire NOC portal, mentioned approved plot area is 520 sq. mts., whereas in the Column of land details in online application mentioned total land area is 5020 sq. mts. Both land area are mismatched.
- x. As per the Building plan uploaded by the institution mentioned land area is 5045.1 sq.mts. and Built-up area 2880 sq.mts. wherein the first floor measuring built-up area 1440 sq.mts. for teacher education courses and ground floor measuring 1440 sq.mts. which is not sufficient for both courses as per the NCTE norms and standards. The area earmarked for Multi-disciplinary courses is not adequate as per the Guidelines issued by the Government of Rajasthan available on <https://hte.rajasthan.gov.in/dept/dce/uploads/doc/NOCpolicy202122.pdf>.
- xi. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale The institution has not uploaded the bank statement of teaching staff to verify it.
- xii. The name of applicant institution does not match with the name mentioned in the NRC–NCTE recognition order dated 12.06.2017, wherein recognition was granted to ‘Sant Radha Raman TeacherTraing College,’ while the applicant institution as per online portal is ‘Sant Radha Raman College’. Sant Radha Raman college is not running 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed degree hence the applicant institution “Sant Radha Raman college” is not eligible for transition to ITEP programme.
- xiii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xiv. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the condition of computer Laboratory, and other labs are not in good condition.
- xv. The name of institution granted recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course is not reflected on the top of the building shown on homepage of website. Geotagged photo uploaded does not match with photo of institution building uploaded on website home page. Approved faculty list countersigned by Affiliating University and other conditions/documents as per NCTE Regulations is not uploaded on website. The website has not been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- xvi. The institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- xvii. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- xviii. The institution has uploaded a copy of Building Safety Certificate (BSC) vide no.3614 dated 07.08.2023 issued by Executive Engineer PWD Division Neemkathana. In the said certificate, name of society (Sant Radha Raman Shikshan Sansthan Distt. Neemkathana) valid for three years i.e. up to year 2025-26. The complete address of society with pin code as per online application is not mentioned therein. Name of district mentioned in the certificate is mismatched

- with online transition application. It has not mentioned in the BSC that the certificate is issued in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority as required under NCTE Regulations, 2021.
- xix. The institution recognised by NCTE is ‘Sant Radha Raman Teacher Training College’ while the applicant institution as per online portal is ‘Sant Radha Raman College’. With regard to multi-disciplinary institution, the institution has uploaded the affiliation from Central Sanskrit University. The same is not acceptable in view of the fact that the ITEP course of the institution is affiliated with Pt Deen Dayal Shekhawati University, Sikar and the MDI course is affiliated with Central Sanskrit University. The institution is not a multi-disciplinary institution in view of the guidelines of NCTE.
- xx. Multipurpose Hall and related facilities as per NCTE Norms and Regulations are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs, hence not acceptable.
- xxi. In the online application Land Details, Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 2880. The institution is running multidisciplinary and teacher education programme/ courses in the same campus/premises i.e. B.A. 240x3=720, B.Sc.120x3=360. M.A.240x2=720. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with of multidisciplinary courses and intake for Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 2 units, B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit), course cannot be ascertained.

**Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

- xvi. There is a lack of clarity regarding the built-up area. While the total area as per the building plan is 5550.00 Sq Mt, only 3350 Sq Mt is earmarked for specific training programs (B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed.). The physical demarcation and distribution of this space remain unclear and cannot be verified from the provided plans.

- xvii. The institution fails to provide dedicated toilet facilities for PWD (Persons with Disabilities) students, which is a mandatory requirement.
- xviii. Fire extinguishers are installed on the premises; however, they do not mention any expiry or maintenance dates, making their operational reliability questionable.

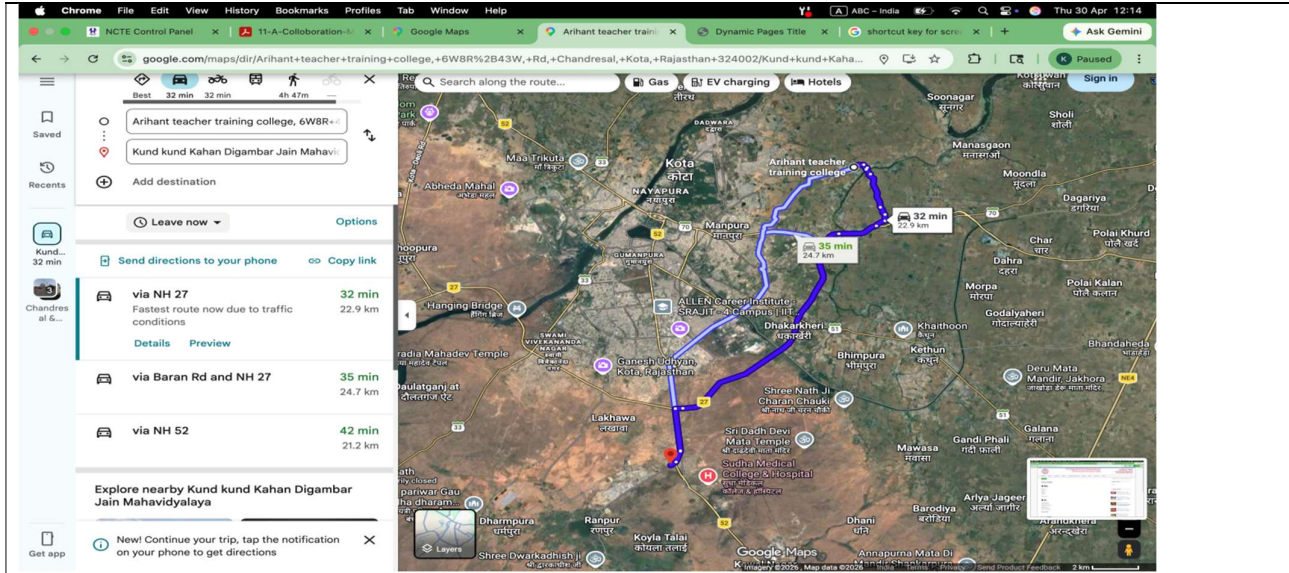
