Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply of Final Show Cause Notice post Preliminary Scrutiny, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- ii. As per online portal, name of parent organization/society is 'AKLANK VIDYALAYA ASSOCIATION' whereas uploaded copy of Certificate of Registration dated 19.10.1956 in the name of 'AKLANKA VIDYALAYA ASSOCIATION'. Both name is mismatched.
- iii. Institution has not uploaded on the portal the revised legible approved building plan showing complete address as per portal, total land area, total built up area, earmarked total land area and total built up area for all running courses and demarcated land area and built-up area for teacher education programme including multidisciplinary programmes. It only submits explanation.
- iv. In reply to first SCN, institution has uploaded BCC showing that building on lease basis is used for B.Ed. course, whereas in reply to final SCN, revised BCC dated 04.02.2026 is uploaded showing that building is used for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course.
- v. As per portal, institution itself is running multidisciplinary programme(s). Demarcated land area and built-up area for B.Ed. course and MDI courses running in the campus are not reflected in the uploaded revised BCC.
- vi. As per portal land is on ownership basis, however in BCC mentioned that land is on lease basis.
- vii. At point no.5 'Location with khata/khasra/Street No./Ward No., Name of the Place, Corporation/Municipality/Panchayat No', there is no mention of Plot/Khasra No. as per online portal.
- viii. In the absence of revised building plan, constructed floor-wise built-up area shown in Building Completion Certificate could not be verified. The uploaded BCC is certified by Secretary without mentioning date of inspection of institution building by Registered Architect/Engineer.
- ix. Geotagged photographs of Computer Lab and ICT facilities shown are not adequate as per recognized programmes running in the campus.
- x. Non-Encumbrance Certificate dated 03.02.2026 by Advocate along with copy of e-Challan

- is uploaded without mentioning land area, plot no., complete address with pin code of society as per portal. Another NEC dated 13.08.202 by Nagar Nigam, Kota is uploaded wherein tampering of plot no. shown in the address is made applying white correction fluid.
- xi. The institution has not uploaded the 'Fresh certificate of merger' issued by the Registrar of Societies as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
 - xii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
 - xiii. Infrastructural and instructional facilities as per photos are not adequate as per NCTE norms and regulations.
 - xiv. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
 - xv. Uploaded lease deed by the institution is not legible. The institution has not uploaded certified copy of the lease deed issued by the competent Government Authority.
 - xvi. A board with the name of the college is seen to have been put up temporarily. This board can be removed at any time.
 - xvii. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
 - xviii. The institution has not uploaded legible Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
 - xix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
 - xx. The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.

Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

- ii. Break-up of Built up area mentioned in the Building Plan for the Teacher Education Programme/S- Building Plans are not approved by the competent authority- Not Accepted.
- iii. Other information required- Barrier free toilets are not created for the physically handicapped persons- Not Accepted.
- iv. Many Documents are not issued and approved by the competent authority.
- v. Building Completion- Building Completion Certificate is not issued by the competent authority- Not Accepted.
- vi. Floor Wise Built-Up Area (in sq m)- Building Completion Certificate is not issued by the competent authority.- Not Accepted
- vii. Digital or Online Resources- Not Available.
- viii. Availability of Developed Kitchen Garden- Not Available.
- ix. Rain Water Harvesting System- Not Available.
- x. The Institution is not accessible to the students with disabilities; Library and Lab facilities are inadequate; Required faculty members with fully qualified are not found.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply of final Show Cause Notice post Inspection, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The principal is not present during virtual inspection of the institution.
- ii. Divyang students and faculty can't use the ramp in ground floor because it's too steep.
- iii. There is no provision for a Lift or a Ramp to access the 1st and 2nd floors from the ground floor.
- iv. Sitting capacity of the multipurpose hall is not as per NCTE norms. The Multipurpose Hall seems to be a temporary arrangement.
- v. There is no student attendance register in the respective room (ICT lab, Science Lab & Psychological Lab). It seems no students ever come to any of the labs.
- vi. According to NCTE norms, the institution is mandated to maintain a minimum of 1,000 book titles in its library. However, the library's current collection falls significantly short of this requirement.
- vii. Library sitting capacity is not as per NCTE norms.
- viii. The number of journals in the library is not as per NCTE norms. The library does not

currently possess any journal copies published in 2025.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Virtual Inspection Report dated 07.05.2026, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee decided as under:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Virtual Inspection Report dated 06.05.2026, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Address of institution- Not clear documents produced by college – Not Accepted.
- ii. Building plan- Building is not as per requirement of NCTE. Building Plan is not prepared by the Architect who is registered with the Council of Architecture- Not Accepted.
- iii. Break-up of Built up area mentioned in the Building Plan for the Teacher Education Programme/S- Multi purpose hall is not as per norms. Furniture and fixtures in Multi purpose hall are not as per NCTE requirement. Rooms seems small against the claim of college- Not Accepted.
- iv. Other Information required- Some portion of building is under construction. No proper fire safety is available in the building. Basic facilities are not visible in the building. College management did not give any satisfactory answer for the same.
- v. Building Completion- Some constructions are going on in the building- Not Accepted.
- vi. Book in Library Not Sufficient- Not Accepted.
- vii. Seating Capacity- Proper Furniture was not available- Not Accepted.
- viii. Title of Book- No Librarian was available. No Bills produced by college. Information provided by College seems doubtful.
- ix. Professional Research General-Not accepted.
- x. Electronic Publication-Not Available
- xi. Digital or Online Resources- Not Available.
- xii. Science Stream Laboratories- Not properly maintained.
- xiii. Humanities Stream Laboratories, Common Room-Not Properly Maintained
- xiv. Availability of Adequate Furniture- Not Available.
- xv. Repair and replacement of Furniture and other Equipment- Not Available.
- xvi. Availability of Developed Kitchen Garden, Rain Water Harvesting System- Not Available.
- xvii. Facilities for Co-curricular Activities- Not Sufficient.
- xviii. Institution has lack of basic infrastructure and not provided accurate information during Virtual Inspection.

- xix. The Multipurpose Hall has an area of only 900 square feet with a seating capacity of 80, which is inadequate for conducting academic activities such as seminars, workshops, and conferences. Additionally, the quality of furniture is not satisfactory and requires improvement.
- xx. There is no proper marking or identification system for institutional assets, making it difficult to establish ownership and accountability. Furthermore, no proper stock register is maintained by the institution.
- xxi. The Computer Laboratory is equipped with only 12 computers, which is insufficient in proportion to the student strength and restricts effective practical exposure.
- xxii. The institution does not have a Language Laboratory. Additionally, no language software has been purchased or installed to support language proficiency and skill development.
- xxiii. During the inspection, only 2–3 teaching staff members were present for the ongoing course, while others were absent. Therefore, staff recruitment, eligibility criteria, and salary structure must strictly adhere to prescribed norms to maintain academic standards and institutional credibility.
- xxiv. Laboratories such as the Psychology Lab and Geography Lab are inadequately equipped with poor-quality materials. The laboratory spaces are too small, lack proper seating arrangements, and are not functional due to insufficient equipment.
- xxv. No librarian was present in the library. As per verbal communication, the library has approximately 2,500 books and 900 titles; however, no accession register is maintained to verify the stock. The library has no encyclopedias, journals, and digital/e-resources. The seating capacity is also inadequate, and the available books are not aligned with the syllabus of teacher education courses.
- xxvi. The college building does not have a proper ramp facility for persons with disabilities.
- xxvii. Classrooms have lack proper furniture and ICT facility, which adversely affects the teaching–learning process.
- xxviii. Overall, the institutional infrastructure does not meet the required norms.
- xxix. No Ramp or Lift provision for the upper floors.
- xxx. No toilets for physically challenged persons.

Therefore, the Committee decided that final Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of final Show Cause Notice.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Virtual Inspection Report dated 06.05.2026, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Inclusive environment missing- Only one ramp present and it not is not as per standards. Various Imp. Spaces (Like Labs, class rooms etc.) were not accessible.
- ii. Toilets Facilities are not present for PH Candidate.
- iii. Labs are shared with many courses. like B.Sc. etc. and Intake of B.Sc. first year only is 450, which makes it very difficult to share.
- iv. The faculty members are not all present and No Identity card at the time of Inspection and not qualified as per norms. The principal is not present at the time of Inspection. Some documents are not available for example ECS for salary and students fees receipts.
- v. No Stock register, and consumable register are not properly maintained in any lab/Room. Many consumable items are not purchased in recent time (like last purchase was in 2011)
- vi. No Proper girls common room.
- vii. In Library, educational journals and educational encyclopaedias were not present, no digital resources available.
- viii. Principal has changed recently.
- ix. In Library, Volumes, Titles, are mixed up with other course books, So could not be verified. No proper records of education journals purchased in past. Encyclopaedias are less than required.
- x. Computer lab is shared with BBA and BCA which makes high working load on it.
- xi. Digital Library is not present in the institute.
- xii. Many faculty members are shared with B.Sc., B.A. M.Sc. etc other courses.
- xiii. Class available is not sufficient for institutes current course intake.

Therefore, the Committee decided that final Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online

transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of final Show Cause Notice.

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Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Visiting Team Report, Reply to Show Cause Notice post inspection, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

As the reply given by the institution is not satisfactory, the Committee accepts the report of the visiting team in this regard that:-

- i. Basic infrastructure is missing; several washbasins lack pipelines, and flush tanks are absent in the toilets.
- ii. The uploaded photograph shows that ramp is not proper to access to the first floor.
- iii. The seating arrangements for faculty are inadequate, with a significant shortage of tables and chairs in staffroom.
- iv. The uploaded photograph shows that in Multipurpose Hall the seating capacity is substantially lower than the mandatory NCTE requirements. Furthermore, essential ICT equipment, such as LCD projector, is missing.
- v. The uploaded photograph shows that the Zoology and Chemistry labs lack sufficient seating and workstations for students to perform experiments effectively.
- vi. In ICT Lab, the number of functional computers is insufficient to cater to the student intake.
- vii. The uploaded photograph shows that the playground exists only as an unmaintained open space without any specific marking or designated courts for recognized sports.
- viii. The academic schedule reflects poor planning; classes are being allotted in the Seminar Hall and Girls
- ix. ' Common Room, which is academically inappropriate. This flawed timetable has also been uploaded to the college website.
- x. Building Plan is not made by the Council of Architecture registered Architect and not uploaded in good resolution to read – Not Accepted.
- xi. The break-up of built-up area mentioned in the application form does not match with the uploaded building plan.

As per the decision of WRC, an email was sent to the institution on 12 February 2026 with a request to fill up the proforma and submit it to WRC for conduct of VT as per the court order

The proceedings in the matter have been conducted through video conferencing.

1. Issue notice. Mr. Jai Sahai Endlaw, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-National Council for Teacher Education [“NCTE”]. The petition is taken up for disposal with the consent of learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner was granted recognition by Western Regional Committee [“WRC”] of the NCTE for its B.Ed. course on 31.03.2008. A revised recognition order was issued on 27.05.2015, pursuant to the notification of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. However, the WRC withdrew the petitioner’s recognition by an order dated 04.09.2019. The petitioner approached this Court against the withdrawal order by way of W.P.(C) 12567/2019. By an order dated 19.02.2020, the Court set aside the withdrawal order of the WRC and restored the recognition of the petitioner for the academic session 2020-21. The matter was remanded to the WRC for a fresh decision on the petitioner’s case. The matter remains pending with the WRC since then.

3. In these circumstances, the withdrawal order having been set aside by this Court, there is no impediment to the petitioner’s participation in counselling or admitting students, until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is issued by the WRC.

4. Consequently, the WRC is directed to restore the petitioner’s status as a recognised institution for the year 2021-22 and subsequently until a fresh recognition order is passed. The WRC will issue a restoration of recognition order within one week and also incorporate the petitioner’s name on its website as a recognised institution. The NCTE is also directed to inform the petitioner’s affiliating university and the concerned department of the State Government within the same period.

5. The petition, alongwith the pending application, stands disposed of in these terms.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 30.07.2021, the recognition for the B.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each).
