**Decision of WRC:**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Visiting Team Report, Reply to Show Cause Notice post inspection, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under: -

**As the reply given by the institution is not satisfactory, the Committee accepts the report of the visiting team in this regard that:-**

- i. The VT member observed that no staff member was available for communication at the time of the inspection. In its response, the institution uploaded a photograph of an employee; however, the committee was unable to verify whether that employee was actually present at that time.
- ii. A VT member remarked that the organization's infrastructure is not in a condition to function as an institution. In response, the organization uploaded some photographs; however, these were not geotagged. Consequently, the committee has been unable to

- verify whether or not the organization's infrastructure is in a condition to function as an institution.
- iii. VT Members remarked that None of the laboratories were up to the marks of NCTE. Classrooms were not in good condition. Seating arrangement in classrooms were not proper.
  - iv. Title of Book Less than 1000 Education Encyclopaedia Electronic Publication Digital or Online Resources are not available. No proper seating arrangements were there in the library.
  - v. As VT Members reported Humanities Stream Laboratories, Faculty Room, Availability of adequate Furniture, Effective arrangement of clearing of campus, water and toilet, Rain Water Harvesting System, Facilities for co-curricular Activities are not available.
  - vi. The institute has applied for the B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed.. programs. The institute currently offers only the B.A. program. It does not offer the B.Sc. program. Consequently, the institute was unable to upload the affiliation order for the BSc program
  - vii. Furniture does not meet the requirement for the Institute.
  - viii. facilities like Ram not available for ground floor, No Support is available with ramp to first floor.
  - ix. College did not produce salary slips of the teachers.

**Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

**As the reply given by the institution is not satisfactory, the Committee accepts the report of the visiting team in this regard that**

- i. The dedicated toilet for specially-abled individuals is non-compliant; a floor step prevents easy entry, and the interior lacks necessary wall support/grab bars.
- ii. The institute failed to produce a registered Sale Deed or any equivalent legal documentation to establish and verify legal ownership of the land.
- iii. The overall condition of the restrooms Toilet is extremely poor, failing to meet basic hygiene and maintenance standards.
- iv. The institute lacks and does not possess an all-weather approach road, thereby rendering the campus difficult to access during adverse weather conditions.
- v. The Music and Sports rooms lack basic furniture and proper storage cupboards. Equipment is improperly kept on classroom desks covered in yellow cloth rather than professional workstations. Additionally, no inventory records are maintained for these assets, resulting in zero accountability.
- vi. No proper dead stock register is being maintained, making it impossible to verify permanent assets and long-term equipment. Lack of a structured consumable register prevents the tracking of daily-use materials, chemicals, and supplies. No Attendance register present in any Lab Library etc. place.
- vii. The Science laboratories (Physics, Chemistry, and Botany) lack adequate seating arrangements. The absence of chairs or stools for students significantly hampers the conduct of practical work, and only a limited number of essential instruments are available.
- viii. Adequate accessibility provisions are lacking, as there are no lifts or ramps to facilitate access to upper floors for specially-abled individuals. Furthermore, the presence of

- raised brick steps at the entrances of ground floor rooms, likely intended to prevent rainwater ingress, further restricts accessibility.
- ix. The widespread use of classroom desks as substitutes for specialized furniture across multiple departments reflects a systemic inadequacy in infrastructure planning.
  - x. The Psychology laboratory is inadequately equipped, lacking basic furniture. Equipment was observed to be placed on classroom desks covered with cloth instead of appropriate workstations. Moreover, there is a complete absence of secure storage cupboards or cabinets, leaving sensitive equipment exposed to dust, damage, and potential theft.

**In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

**In view of the above, the Committee decided that no action is required on the complaint received against the institution. The Complaint Division NCTE HQrs. be intimated the decision of WRC along with copies of refusal orders issued by WRC.**

**Decision of WRC:**

The file/related records of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

A copy of same Complaint dated 26.08.2020 & 26.10.2020 against the institution namely Shri Krishan Co-Education College, Village-Harsoli, Khasra No.4363/3359/2 & 344, Street/Road-Mundawar Road, Taluka/Mandal-Kotkasim, Town/City-Harsoli, District- Alwar-301401, Rajasthan was received from Complaint Division, NCTE Hqrs. vide letters dated 19.06.2025 received in WRC on 09.10.2025, wherein the complainant has mentioned regarding irregularities in the matter of infrastructure facilities, appointment of faculty, payment of salary to staff, attendance of students etc. The Committee noted the complaint and decided that following documents may be sought from the institution:

- (ii) The institution is required to submit the following documents in respect of its land and building located in its existing premises wherein recognition was granted by NCTE for B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. courses.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit Site Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- (v) The institution is required to submit the latest list of teaching staff for session 2025-2026 for all courses countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body/Examining Body as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- (vi) The institution is required to submit the bank statement of last six months for all running courses indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff appointed for various courses separately.

- (vii) The institution is required to submit the list/details of students admitted for session 2025-2026 for all courses.
- (viii) The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx)
- (ix) The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (x) The institution is required to submit latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (xi) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate and certified land documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (xii) The institution is required to submit latest Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (xiii) The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (xiv) The institution is required to submit Form 'A' in original issued by Bank Manager of the concerned bank along with copies of valid FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Fund in joint operation mode in reference to Clause 10 (1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- (xv) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

**In view of the above, being time bound matter, the Committee decided as under:**

- (1) Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution with copy of complaint with direction to submit reply along with requisite documents mentioned above supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (2) The complaint to be forwarded to the Secretary, Department of College Education, Jaipur, Commissioner, College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Block No-4 R K S Sankul, JLN Road, Jaipur, 302015 Rajasthan, Department of Elementary Education, Bikaner, Government of Rajasthan and District Magistrate (DM), Alwar, Rajasthan with request to take necessary action by means of initiating investigation and submission of report on the allegations made in the complaint within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
