Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, documents uploaded by the institution and directions passed in W.P.(C) 18844/2025 vide order dated 11.12.2025 by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Authorization letter on the stamp paper as per admissible government rate is not uploaded.
- ii. The institution has expressed its intention to become a multidisciplinary institution through collaboration, as stipulated in the NCTE Guidelines for transforming NCTE recognized stand-alone teacher education institutions into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- iv. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for collaboration are affiliated with the same university.
- v. The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- vi. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence i.e. affidavit in NCTE prescribed proforma related to collaboration (as per online application) and not confirmed the name of any institution running multidisciplinary programme with whom collaboration is made and institution has not informed that both institution are situated within the radius of 10 Kilometres, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- vii. The website of the institution has not been compliance as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 of para 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the website as per NCTE regulations
- viii. The institution is required to upload Copy of not-for-profit certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- ix. The institution is required to upload Exemption Certificate (12A) certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- x. The institution is required to upload the complete details of Society/Trust/Members with Aadhar and PAN number issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- xi. The institution is required to upload the details of student admitted year-wise for all running programmes issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- xii. For confirming the institution's eligible for transition into ITEP course as it is Collaboration, institution is required to upload the affiliation order of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with approved intake capacity and present intake capacity as a Multi-Disciplinary Institution.
- xiii. The institution is required to upload Complete Certified land documents mentioning all Khasra No.

- issued by the Competent Government Authority. The institution is required to upload land related Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- xiv. The institution is required to upload Mutation (Jamabandi) Certificate mentioning Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- xv. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.

Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply to First Show Cause Notice in pursuance of court order dated 08.04.2026 and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution has NOT uploaded certified copy of land documents issued by the competent authority of State Govt. for khasra no. 359, 360 and 690/350 which is mentioned in the portal. The institution is

- required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- ii. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
 - iii. The Institution is required to upload geotagged photographs of the ramp for accessing the first floor.
 - iv. The uploaded documents are not proper. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for collaboration are affiliated with the same university.
 - v. The multipurpose hall should measure 2,000 square feet and must have a seating capacity for 200 students. The uploaded geotagged photographs indicate that the multipurpose hall does not comply with NCTE norms and standards. The furniture within the multipurpose hall is insufficient and falls short of the required seating capacity for 200 students
 - vi. According to NCTE norms, the library is required to have 1,000 titles and 4,000 books available. Furthermore, it is mandatory to procure at least 100 new books annually, and the reading room within the library must have a seating capacity of at least 50. The uploaded 'geotagged' photographs indicate that, when compared to NCTE standards, the seating capacity of the library's reading room is inadequate. Additionally, it is not possible to ascertain the actual number of books currently held by this college, which has been in existence for nine years. In this regard, the institution is required to provide its clarification.
 - vii. It is mandatory for classrooms to have a seating capacity of at least 50 students, along with the necessary furniture for seating. The uploaded 'geotagged' photographs indicate that the classrooms available at the college lack sufficient furniture for students to sit. The institution is required to provide its clarification.
 - viii. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmes duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
 - ix. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
 - x. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playground and sports facility.
 - xi. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
 - xii. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
 - xxiv. The institution has uploaded the BCC mentioning different Plots. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
 - xxv. The institution has uploaded approved building plan for khasra no.359, but floor wise built-up area (in sq.m.) mentioned in the building plan is not matched with mentioned built up area in the portal.
 - xxvi. The website of the institution has not been in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - xxvii. For confirming the institution's eligible for transition into ITEP course as it is collaboration, the institution is required to upload the affiliation order of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with approved intake capacity and present intake capacity as a Multi-Disciplinary Institution.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply to First Show Cause Notice in pursuance of court order dated 08.04.2026 and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution has not uploaded the 'Fresh certificate of merger' issued by the Registrar of Societies as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions
- ii. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- iii. For confirming the institution's eligible for transition into ITEP course as it is Merger, the institution is required to upload the affiliation order with approved intake capacity and current intake capacity of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with intake capacity as a Multi-Disciplinary Institution.
- iv. The proposal for 'merger' between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. This NOC is issued with some condition, the institution is required to upload unconditional approval NOC.
- v. Issued NOC under Clause 4.2.2 is conditional and one condition is of teaching staff. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmes duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
- vi. The institution is required to update and maintain the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- vii. The institution has NOT uploaded the proper mutation certificate/jamadandi, obtained from Revenue Records of the State. The institution is required to upload Mutation (Jamabandi) Certificate mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- viii. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for Merger are affiliated with the same university, as required under Clause 4.2(ii) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.'
- ix. Regarding Existing Teacher Education Programme(s), the institution has uploaded STC recognition order dated 08.11.2004 recognised by NCTE.
- x. Mentioning size of multipurpose Hall (in sq.m.) 452.28 and size of Library-Cum-Reading Room (in sq.m) 84.437 in the portal is NOT reflected/earmarked in the building plan approved by Assistant Engineer, PWD, Upkhand (Uttar), Jaipur.
- xi. The Merger multidisciplinary institution and teacher education institution are running in the same premises. The institution is required to upload the affiliation orders of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with intake capacity as a Multi-Disciplinary Institution. The institution is running following teacher education programme i.e. Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) one unit, Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 3 units, Master of Education (M.Ed) degree 1 unit, and B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1unit). The institution possesses a land area of 8,094 square meters, with a built-up area of 6,814 square meters. It is necessary to verify whether this built-up area and land are sufficient to conduct all the multidisciplinary and teacher education courses. Therefore, the institution should provide details regarding all the courses being conducted on the premises.

- xii. The institution has NOT uploaded year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.
- xiii. The geotag photos shows that the institution building does not have a proper ramp facility for persons with disabilities. No Ramp or Lift provision for the upper floors.
- xiv. The institution has uploaded a copy of the 'Non-Encumbrance Certificate', but the Khasra/plot/survey numbers mentioned therein do not match with the Khasra numbers mentioned in the land details.
- xv. The institution has uploaded so many documents regarding Land. The institution is required to upload the proper legible certified copy of registered land documents. The institution is required to upload affidavit mentioning Land area and land details.
- xvi. According to NCTE norms, the library is required to have 1,000 titles and 4,000 books available. Furthermore, it is mandatory to procure at least 100 new books annually, and the reading room within the library must have a seating capacity of at least 50. The uploaded 'geotagged' photographs indicate that, when compared to NCTE standards, the seating capacity of the library's reading room is inadequate. Additionally, it is not possible to ascertain the actual number of books currently held by this college, which has been in existence for nine years. In this regard, the institution is required to provide its clarification.
- xvii. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- xviii. The website of the institution has not been in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 of para as amended from time to time.
- xix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Reply to SCN post Letter of Intent and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee decided as under:

- The institution has complied with the requirements as laid down by NCTE for grant of recognition / permission for ITEP course.

The WRC decided that the formal recognition / permission for Transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed course into ITEP B.A. B.Ed (Secondary) (One Unit) and B.Sc. B.Ed (Secondary) (One Unit) be granted to the institution from the academic session 2026-2027.

Decision of WRC :

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session

2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Virtual Inspection Report, Reply of final Show Cause Notice post Inspection, and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:-

As the reply given by the institution is not satisfactory, the Committee accepts the report of the visiting team in this regard that:-

- i. The observation of the team conducted the online visit is that..."Health and Physical Education Room - Not Well Managed". In response to this, the institution has uploaded some photographs in this regard; however, the uploaded photographs do not geotag the "Health and Physical Education Room", so this does not resolve the issue. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observation of the online visiting team.
- ii. The institution was not showing the documents in the property. The faculty members are not qualified and not available as per the norms. Classrooms, labs, and the playground are not good." In reply of this; The institution has uploaded faculty list and faculty members which are not qualified and not available as per the norms. Classrooms, labs, and the playground photographs are not uploaded.; however, this does not resolve the issues. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the online visiting team.
- iii. "Science stream laboratories- not adequately equipped." In reply of this; Uploaded photos of science labs are not geotagged. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the online visiting team.
- iv. The observations recorded by the online visiting team are as follows: "availability of adequate furniture - effective system of cleaning premises, water and toilet - not well managed"; In response to this, the institution has uploaded some photos but they are not geotagged. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.
- v. The observation of the team conducted the online visit is that... "Science Stream Laboratories-, Humanities Stream Laboratories- Activity Cum Resource Center-Not Adequately Equipped, Health and Physical Education Room-Not Well Managed." In response to this, the institution has uploaded some photos but they are not geotagged. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.
- vi. The observations recorded by the online visiting team are as follows: "Geographic Location- There is mismatch between the details given in application and record received at the time of inspection. Distance between two locations - 2.242 km." In response to this, the institution has not uploaded supporting documents in respect of mismatch. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.
- vii. The observations recorded by the team conducted the online visit are as follows: "Facilities For Co-Curricular Activities One Activity Room" "Activity cum resource center- not adequately equipped." In response to this, the institution has not uploaded geotag photographs of the above. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.
- viii. The observations recorded by the team conducted the online visit are as follows: "Library is not developed as per NCTE Norms. regarding Book in Library, Title of Book-, Professional Research General- Education Encyclopaedia- Electronic Publication and Digital or Online Resources" "No clarity in number of titles in the library." "Electronic publication- not available." "Digital or online resources- not available." "Professional research general – not accepted." "Education encyclopaedia- not available." "In response to this, the Institution has uploaded a letter bearing the signature of the society's secretary, but this is not a satisfactory and proper answer. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.
- ix. The observation of the team conducted the online visit is that... "The institution failed to take the members through appropriate documents in detail, facilities, and amenities during the inspection. The facilities, library resources, and laboratories are not equipped to serve the purpose of the course. Photos are not matching, as there are different buildings; no rooms were found designated for the applied course." In

the response to this, the answer uploaded by institution is not a satisfactory and proper. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.

x. "Availability of Developed Kitchen Garden- Not Available, Rain Water Harvesting System- Not Available".

xi. The observation of the team conducted the online visit is that... "Faculty Room, Common Room are Not Adequate, Store room- Not Well Managed" "As per the virtual inspection and records verified, the facilities, library resources, laboratories, a multipurpose hall, playground are not in good condition. Photos are not matching." In the response to this, the answer uploaded by institution is not satisfactory and proper. Therefore, the Regional Committee accepts the observations of the visiting team online.

xii. The observations recorded by the team conducted the online visit are as follows: "Photos of Institute's Building- Not Accepted as photos are mismatching." "Humanities stream laboratories- not adequately equipped." "Land Details- Instead of the land detail document, an affidavit was attached. Land registration data is mismatched." - The Institution has uploaded geo-tagged photos of two buildings. The name "R G College Viratnagar" is visible on one building, while "R G Teacher Training College" appears on the other; however, the two colleges have distinct latitude and longitude coordinates.
- The institution has uploaded geotagged photographs multipurpose. The latitude and longitude of this photo differ from those of the other uploaded photos. The multipurpose hall should measure 2,000 square feet and must have a seating capacity for 200 students. This hall shall be equipped for conducting seminars and workshops with installation of an audio-visual system The uploaded geotagged photographs indicate that the multipurpose hall does not comply with NCTE norms and standards. The

- furniture within the multipurpose hall is insufficient and falls short of the required seating capacity for 200 students. The institution should provide a clarification in this regard and attach the relevant evidence.
- v. The institution has uploaded a geo-tagged photograph of the library and reading room; the latitude and longitude coordinates of this photograph differ from those of the other uploaded photographs. - The letter uploaded by the institution is No Objection Certificate, The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
- The name of the applicant college is 'Vivek Degree Teacher Training College, Kalwar', whereas the uploaded building plan is in the name of another college. hence, the institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. earmarked

The extension is subject to fulfilment of all the conditions and norms by the UGC, State Government and the University. if the prescribed norms are not fulfilled, the provisional affiliation will be withdrawn by this university. in this connection one NOTE is there "The temporary affiliation of 2025-26 has been confirmed as per the

- affidavit submitted by you (Institution). Before joining the upcoming session (2026-27), a copy of the land conversion order for educational purposes should be submitted to the university office as per rules." The affiliation of collaboration institution is conditional.
- iv. The institution is running Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 2 units, and 2 units of 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed degree.. The ITEP institution is 9 years old college and B.Ed. is 17 years old college, institution has uploaded a geo-tagged photograph of the library and reading room; Furthermore, the uploaded geo-tagged photographs indicate that the seating capacity of the library's reading room is inadequate and that the library does not meet NCTE norms.. The institution has reported possessing 4,000 books. In reality, the institution is required to have more than 4,000 books for the ITEP program and separate books for the B.Ed. program. The library is not as per NCTE norms.
 - v. The institution has uploaded geotagged photographs of multipurpose hall, The institution is running Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 2 units, and B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed In the context of the above-mentioned courses for this course. As per NCTE Norms for ITEP or transition programme, the multipurpose hall should measure 2,000 square feet and must have a seating capacity for 200 students. This hall shall be equipped for conducting seminars and workshops with installation of an audio-visual system The uploaded geotagged photographs indicate that the multipurpose hall does not comply with NCTE norms and standards. The furniture within the multipurpose hall is insufficient and falls short of the required seating capacity for 200 students. The institution should provide a clarification in this regard and attach the relevant evidence.
 - vi. The concerned 'transition institution' has been operational for the past nine years. and in they are running B.Ed. also which is 17 years old institution. Therefore, it is mandatory for the institution to upload the list of teaching staff for all courses conducted under the 'Faculty of Education'; this list must be duly approved and countersigned by the affiliating body. Additionally, to verify whether teachers are paid according to Central or State government pay scales, the institution is required to upload bank statements from the last six months showing salary transactions for the teaching staff. Furthermore, it is also mandatory for the institution to upload the bank statements of the concerned staff members to verify the actual salaries received by them over the past six months.
 - vii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the A Flex board with the name of the college is seen to be put up temporarily. This board can be removed at any time.
 - viii. The institution is required to upload the proper recognition order of 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed degree issued by NCTE.
 - ix. The website is required to be functional and updated in compliance to Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - x. A geotagged photograph reveals that the facility has a ramp on the ground floor; however, there are no ramps or elevators to access the upper floors.
 - xi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
 - xii. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs
 - xiii. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes^प
 - xiv. The land area (in square meters) mentioned by the applicant institution in the affidavit is 4,087 (4,086.78), and the built-up area (in square meters) mentioned therein is 3,358 (3,357.62). The institution conducts two units of the 'Bachelor of Education' (B.Ed.) degree and two units of the 4-year integrated programme for the B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. degree. The built-up area of 3,358 square meters available with the institution is not sufficient according to NCTE norms.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

Complete address of institution inspected by Sahayak Abhiyanta, PWD is not reflected on the submitted Building Safety Certificate issued by PWD.

An E.mail dated 08.05.2026 was received from Panel Counsel of NCTE informing that matter of W.P. 6287/26 titled Swastik Adhyapan Mandir & Anr. vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. was heard on 08.05.2026. The Hon'ble Court has disposed of the case with direction to WRC to decide the representation of the Petitioner-College dated 14.07.2025 within 4 weeks from today. Further, the Hon'ble Court has directed that if the representation is decided in favour of the Petitioner-College, the WRC shall update the status of the recognition on the website and inform that State Government and the affiliating body of the Petitioner-College, of its recognized status. The Hon'ble Court has specifically stated that the relief granted shall be "subject to verification" of the documents of the Petitioner-College.
- vi. No separate representation dated 14.07.2025 has been found in the office records of WRC. On perusal of the representation dated 14.07.2025 enclosed with the writ petition by the institution, it is noted that this is institution's request for uploading the recognition order of P.T.C./D.El.Ed. course on NCTE website.
- vii. The Committee noted that status of recognition of P.T.C. course is withdrawn, and chronological status has been uploaded on NCTE website.

In view of the above, WRC decided that the status of recognition of PTC course as “Withdrawn” shall continue reflected in the records and on the NCTE Website. The representation dated 14.07.2025 enclosed with the writ petition is hereby disposed of.
