- i. The institution is required to upload the letter issued by the University regarding the recruitment of teaching staff, the list of experts nominated in accordance with the regulations and other necessary documents pertinent to the recruitment process.
- ii. The institution is required to upload the documents pertaining to the educational qualifications of all the teachers it has appointed, experience certificate if applicable as specified in the affidavit.
- iii. "Statement giving the staff profile. The details therein should be filled by every faculty/staff members" is not in the prescribed format and not in accordance with NCTE norms. The concerned institution is required to upload this information in the prescribed format and in compliance with NCTE norms.
- iv. The institution is required to upload the latest 'Form A', which reflects the current status of the endowment fund of ₹5 lakh and the reserve fund of ₹7 lakh and confirming that the FDR is specifically for the B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. programme at "SRI GURU NANAK KHALSA PG COLLEGE". Additionally, the information regarding the FDR in 'Form A' must match with the details in the original FDR i.e. Serial number and FDR number and other details.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post LoI be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Virtual Inspection Report dated 17.06.2026 and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- The institution is required to upload the list of students admitted to its B.A. and B.Sc. programmes, bearing the signature of the University Registrar. This is necessary to verify the status of the multidisciplinary programmes being conducted by the institution.
- The institution currently conducts teacher training programmes, including the 'Diploma in Elementary Education' (D.El.Ed.) (1 unit), the 'Bachelor of Education' (B.Ed.) degree (2 units), and the 4-year Integrated B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. programme (2 units); additionally, the institution claims to run B.A. and B.Sc. programmes on the same premises. The total built-up area of the institution's building is 4,245 [sq. meters], which is insufficient for conducting the aforementioned courses.
- The institution website " HTTP://WWW.ORIENTALLALBURRA.IN/" is not operational at the time of scrutiny. The institution is required to update and maintain the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- It came to the notice of the OVT members that the multi-purpose hall does not meet NCTE norms, toilet facilities should be accommodated and multimedia facilities should be accommodated. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms, furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate. This hall is not equipped with an audio-visual system for hosting seminars and workshops. Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. The institution should provide a clarification in this regard and submit appropriate evidence.
- The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmes duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff. And the institution should also upload the employees' bank statements of last six months.
- As per the Observation of OVT, 30 seating capacity in the library, they need 20 more students to accommodate., they must include books every year last purchasing was done in 2023, Professional Research General not accepted. The library shall cater to the requirements of the programme and shall have a seating capacity for at least fifty persons equipped with minimum 1000 (one thousand) titles and 4000 (four thousand) books. These include text and reference books related to all courses of study, readings and literature related with the approaches delineated in the programme; educational encyclopaedias, electronic publications and digital or online resources and minimum five referral professional research journals. The institutions shall create digital library with relevant and adequate resource materials. The institution should provide a clarification in this regard and submit appropriate evidence.

- vii. According to the observations of the On-line visiting team, resources such as educational encyclopaedias, electronic publications, and digital or online resources are not available at the concerned institution.
- viii. Humanities Stream Laboratories - need to establish geography lab, and language lab.
- ix. In the Common Room need sanitary dispenser and medical facilities.
- x. Availability of developed Kitchen Garden, Rain Water Harvesting System are not available in the institution.
- xi. As per the direction from NCTE, VT members undergone the virtual inspection on 17.06.2026@ 10.30 AM. Through the observation not satisfied.
- xii. language lab should be established.
- xiii. Psychology lab has very limited resources; apparatus and seating capacity must be incorporated accordingly.
- xiv. Computer lab needs 50 computers; only 20 computers with plastic furniture were present; it should be replaced with computer tables and chairs accordingly.
- xv. Second and third floors need connectivity, and other facilities for physically different abled people should be accommodated.
- xvi. The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- xvii. A permanent nameplate has not been installed on the college building; instead, a flex banner has been put up.
- xviii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xix. The uploaded building plan is not proper. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area, earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- xx. In the initially uploaded BCC, the institution claimed to have reserved 628 sq.m. for the B.Ed. course, 464 sq.m. for the D.El.Ed. course, and 792 sq.m. for the proposed ITEP courses; however, this space is insufficient according to NCTE norms. They now claim to have 3,000 sq.m. available for B.Ed. and D.El.Ed., 2,600 sq.m. for B.A. B.Ed., and 2,291 sq m. for B.A. and B.Sc. courses. The NCTE WRC recommends verifying the actual construction status through the District Collector and taking appropriate action against the institution if it has provided false information.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

- As per affidavit by individual faculty, the percentage of marks mentioned in respect of HoD at sl.1 and faculty at sl.no.2 is mismatched with the affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper about appointment of faculty/staff. Experience certificates in respect of HoD as mentioned in the affidavit is not uploaded.
- The Statement giving the staff profile. The details therein should be filled by every faculty/staff members. This point of LoI has not been complied by the institution. As per documents staff profile of each candidate filled/applied for faculty position is uploaded on institution website, the staff profile in respect of faculty at sl.no. 10, 13, 14 & 15 is not signed by the candidate.
- Screenshot of names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc. uploaded on website is uploaded on the portal, which is not countersigned by Affiliating University.
- Screenshot of facilities added during the last quarter uploaded on website - mentioned not applicable on website.
- Print out of FDRs dated 04.06.2026 issued by Bank of India are uploaded along with Form 'A' (without date) issued by bank manager. In both the FDRs, joint name is mentioned 'Regional Director, WRC-NCTE, JAIPUR' which is incorrect.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post LoI be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

The online application of the institution was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for ITEP along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, Documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

As per the decision of WRC, the Online / Virtual Inspection of the University was conducted on 10th June 2026 at 10.30 AM. The VT Members have submitted the report online on 11th June 2026 (first half).

2. The Registrar of the University vide letter dated 13th June 2026 addressed to Chairperson, NCTE has sent a complaint against VT Members, which has been forwarded to WRC.

3. The University in its complaint has mentioned that during the course of interaction, it was indicated that consultancy services could be provided for completion documentation and facilitating approvals relating to ITEP proposal on a paid basis.

The WRC considered the entire matter alongwith the online application of the institution and observed the following :-

1. As per the VT Policy of NCTE, the VT Members were required to upload the report on 10th June 2026 itself however, they have uploaded the report on 11th June 2026, which is violation of Clause 7 (8) of NCTE Regulations 2014.
2. The institution in its reply to Show Cause Notice prior to VT has submitted the following documents to WRC in online portal :-
 - a. Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Fire Department of the State which is valid till 17th March 2028.
 - b. Land Title Certificate dated 25th September 2025 issued by Laxmangarh, Sikar Tehsildar that the land is presently used by Mody University of Science and Technology, Lakshmanagarh, Dist Sikar, Rajasthan is used for educational purpose and managed by Trust No 5/10560 named Mody Education Foundation (Formerly known as Mody Institute of Education and Research and Mody Institute of Technology and Science), New Delhi.
 - c. The institution has uploaded the Building plan approved by Assistant Engineer, PWD.

Keeping in view the above facts and the documents available in online application of the institution, the WRC decided that Re-Inspection of the above institution be conducted by deputed fresh Visiting Team.

Further, the WRC decided that the above complaint be forwarded to Complaint Division, NCTE-HQrs for necessary action / enquiry in the matter. Till the finalisation of enquiry by Complaints Division, the VT Members mentioned in the complaint may not be deputed to any Inspection.

The institution is required to upload the letter issued by the University regarding the recruitment of teaching staff, the list of experts nominated in accordance with the regulations and other necessary documents pertinent to the recruitment process i.e. advertisement, selection procedure etc.
- ii. The institution is required to upload the documents pertaining to the educational qualifications of all the teachers it has appointed, experience certificate if applicable as specified in the affidavit.
- iii. An examination of the staff profiles on the website reveals that NCTE norms were not adhered to during the recruitment of teaching staff; the appointed teaching staff is not as per NCTE norms.
- iv. Statement giving the staff profile. The details therein should be filled by every faculty/staff members. This point of Letter of Intent has not been complied and relevant statement regarding staff profile filled by every faculty/staff member is not uploaded on the portal, instead the institution has uploaded copy of staff approval letter vide no.3912 dated 05.06.2026 issued by University of Kota in respect of 01 HOD + 22 Assistant Professor + 01 Librarian for ITEP programme. and a copy of faculty list approved by Registrar, University of Kota (without date) not mentioning academic session and the name and address of institution in the top of the proforma of teaching staff. The name of Principal shown in Affidavit on Rs.100/- by the

- management is not reflected in the University of Kota letter dated 05.06.2026. Principal, HOD and some faculties shown in the approved faculty list were working/ joined prior to 16.05.2026. The scale of pay of faculties is not reflected. It is necessary for the institution to upload the correct information.
- v. Screenshot of name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter signed by Principal (without date) uploaded on website is uploaded on the portal. In the statement signed without date of Principal regarding faculty members who joined during last quarter uploaded on website, date of joining of 01 HOD + 22 faculties + 01 Librarian (except Principal) is shown as 16.05.2026, which is not matched with date of joining in respect of faculties shown joined prior to 16.05.2026 in the approved faculty list dated 05.06.2026. The institution is required to upload the proper information.
 - vi. Screenshot of names of students admitted during the current session (2025-2026) along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc. uploaded on website signed by Principal (without date) is uploaded on the portal. Recognition was granted to B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course vide order dated 08.02.2018. Date of admission in respect of student B.A.B.Ed.(IV Year) (2025-2026) reflected in the list at sl.no.21 (07-07-1989), sl.no.30 (09-11-2005), sl.no.33 (19-11-2002), sl.no.37 (12-03-2005), which is prior to date of grant of recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. The institution is required to upload the proper information.
 - vii. "Screenshot of available infrastructural facilities uploaded on website" the institution is required to upload the proper photographs and details.
 - viii. The institution is required to upload the proper details regarding the "Screenshot of available infrastructural facilities uploaded on website".
 - ix. The institution has applied for the BA-B.Ed. and B.Sc.-B.Ed. courses; however, the collaboration institution "Om Kothari Institute of Management and Research" does not conduct the B.Sc. course.
 - x. It has been observed that some employees obtained their degrees with less than 45% marks. The institution should recruit teaching staff in accordance with the prescribed criteria.
 - xi. As per the norms of the NCTE (National Council for Teacher Education), the Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) for the 'Endowment Fund' and 'Reserve Fund' must be obtained from a nationalized (public sector) bank or a scheduled commercial bank. The concerned institution failed to adhere to these guidelines while creating the FDR.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post LoI be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

- iv. Statement giving the staff profile. The details therein should be filled by all faculty/staff members have not in the prescribed format of NCTE Norms and not as per NCTE norms. The institution is required to upload the same in the prescribed format of NCTE and as per NCTE norms.
- v. The institution is required to upload the proper information regarding "Screenshot of name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter uploaded on website."
- vi. The institution is required to upload the proper information regarding "Screenshot of names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc. uploaded on website."
- vii. The institution is required to upload the proper information regarding "Screenshot of fee charged from students uploaded on website."
- viii. The institution is required to upload the proper and relevant information regarding "Screenshot of available infrastructural facilities uploaded on website."
- ix. The institution is required to upload the evidence regarding the "Screenshot of facilities added during the last quarter uploaded on website."

Decision of WRC :-

The WRC, after following extant procedure of NCTE, have decided to refuse the below mentioned online transition applications (2026-2027) from existing B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. into ITEP programme.

2. Being aggrieved against the decision of WRC in refusing/rejecting transition applications, the above-mentioned institutions approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by filing Writ Petitions mentioned against each.

3. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 05.06.2026 in W.P.(C) 8075/2026 titled as GYAN SAGAR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & ANR. vs. NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION along with other batch matters has disposed the writ petitions with the following directions: -

"...5. Accordingly, the present petitions are allowed and the impugned refusal order(s) issued by the Western Regional Committee on diverse dates are set aside. As such, the respondents shall conduct inspection of the petitioner institutes within a period of three weeks from today and shall thereafter take all appropriate and necessary steps to ensure that the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Maa Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya v. State of U.P.: (2013) 2 SCC 617 are scrupulously complied with. The entire exercise, including the issuance of Show Cause Notice pointing out the deficiencies, furnishing of their replies, the adjudication of those show cause notices, and all other ancillary activities connected therewith/flowing therefrom shall be completed on or before 15.07.2026 for the forthcoming academic session 2026-2027. "...4. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the impugned Refusal Orders issued by the Western Regional Committee on diverse dates are set aside. The respondents shall conduct inspection of the petitioners' institutes within a period of three weeks from today and shall thereafter take all appropriate and necessary steps to ensure that the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Maa Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya v. State of U.P., (2013) 2 SCC 617, are scrupulously complied with.

5. The entire exercise, including the issuance of show cause notices pointing out the deficiencies, furnishing of replies thereto, adjudication of such show cause notices, and all ancillary activities connected therewith or flowing therefrom, shall be completed on or before 31.07.2026 for the forthcoming Academic Session 2026-2027.

6. The present petitions, along with the pending applications, stand disposed of accordingly.

7. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith."

The entire matter was discussed thoroughly by WRC in detail and the WRC decided that as per the opinion of the Legal Counsel for NCTE and directions of the Hon'ble Court, Visiting Team be constituted for Virtual Inspection of the Institution (s) in order to ascertain and scrutinize all the essential documents and at the time of verification,

- VT shall also check/ verify student list year-wise (I,II,III,IV), functional website uploaded with mandatory disclosure documents, Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Fire Safety Certificate with requisite approved Plot Area by Govt. authority and all Building & land related documents i.e. Certified Registered Land documents, Mutation Certificate, Land Use Certificate (CLU), Non-Encumbrance Certificate, check the approved Building Plan, approved Site Plan showing contiguity of plots, conform that the land reserved for each course run within the institution's premises and the demarcated construction area for teacher education programmes including multidisciplinary programmes should be mentioned;
- VT shall check availability of requisite numbers of Classrooms, size of Multipurpose Hall with all equipment, different subject-wise Laboratories and its record keeping, Library resources having available space in library-cum-reading room and its record keeping, digitalization of library components, check Activity cum Resource Centre equipped with all facilities as per norms, Health and Physical Education Room with adequate games and sports equipment as per norms, Faculty Rooms with equipment, Administrative Office Space with equipment, Common Room, Store room with adequate space, check functional and appropriate furniture for general and differently able persons in required number for instructional and other purposes, Playground having sports and

games facilities, check the institution environment is disable friendly having requisite facilities fully compatible for Persons With Disability (PWD) as per norms;

- VT shall check, which courses are offered by the institution among the multidisciplinary courses, i.e. B.A., B.Sc., B.Com? The intake, latest affiliation order, etc.;
- VT shall check which courses are offered in addition to these in the same premises, i.e. school, ITI, Diploma courses, other courses.
- Also, VT shall check whether the available building and land is sufficient to run all courses. If the institution has done collaboration or merger, then, according to its rules, VT shall check whether the Government Justification and NOC and the University have approved the both institutions, and VT shall check the distance between the two institutions, check the teaching staff list approved by University or Not, check the six months salary statement of staff so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the applied transition to ITEP course as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
