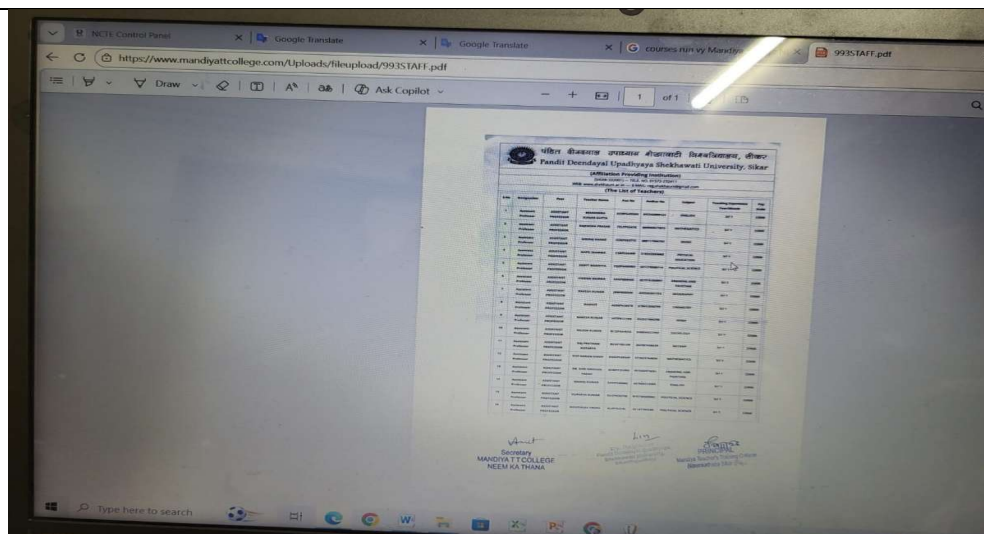

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Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Visiting Team Report, Reply to Show Cause Notice post inspection, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- The Management/Society/Trust is running three colleges viz. (1) Mandiya TT College, Sikar (B.Ed (2 Units), (2) Mandiya College, Sikar (Degree College) and (3) Mandiya TT College, Sikar (B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed) (2 Units) on the total land of 4086.78 sqm which is inadequate as per NCTE Norms & Standards for 400 students annually for the B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed.

- courses, 200 students for the B.Ed. course and 720 students for Degree college (Total 1020 students).
- ii. The institution operates a teacher training program and Multidisciplinary programme (an Arts and Science college (offering undergraduate and postgraduate courses) within the same premises. To conduct these courses, the institution has not yet uploaded the building plan approved by the competent authority of the state government; this plan should clearly specify the institution's name, Khasra/plot/survey number, total land area, and total built-up area. Furthermore, it is necessary to indicate the specific land and built-up area allocated for each course within the premises—including the teacher training program and multi-disciplinary programs. The institution has failed to upload such a building plan approved by the competent authority of the state government.
 - iii. In the online application form as well in reply to SCN prior Visiting Team, the institution has uploaded the land documents for Khasra No. 227/731/3 measuring 0.415 hect wherein in reply to SCN post inspection, the institution has uploaded the additional land documents for Khasra No. 224/1027 registered on 24.11.2017 and 03.01.2023 measuring 0.12 hect and 0.17 hect. The same is not acceptable in view of the :-
 - a. Prior to inspection, the institution was directed to submit the certified copy of all the land documents of the society / trust / institution and in response the institution has submitted only the land documents for Khasra No 227/731/3 measuring 0.415 hect.
 - b. The institution has not submitted the Non Encumbrance Certificate, Change of Land Use Certificate etc for Khasra No. 224/1027 registered on 24.11.2017 and 03.01.2023 measuring 0.12 hect and 0.17 hect (total 0.29 hect).
 - c. The institution has not submitted any documentary proof from the Competent Government Authority that the for Khasra No. 227/731/3 and Khasra No. 224/1027 are adjacent to each other.
 - d. As per the VT Report, the Visiting Team members during virtual inspection have also verified the land documents with regard to Khasra No. 227/731/3 measuring 0.415 hect and the VT members not remarked / mentioned anything about additional land for Khasra No 224/1027.
 - e. The Building plan and BCC uploaded by the institution makes a mention of only Khasra No. 227/731/3 measuring 0.415 hect.
 - iv. The institution conducts B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. (2 units each) and B.Ed. (2 units) courses. According to NCTE regulations, a 'built-up area' of 4,200 square meters is mandatory for these courses; however, the built-up area stated by the institution in the affidavit submitted with the online application is only 3,357.62 square meters, which falls short of NCTE norms. Consequently, the institution lacks the necessary built-up area to conduct these courses in accordance with NCTE regulations.
 - v. The institution is required to pay the monthly salary to teaching staff in accordance with UGC /State government norms; however, the applicant institution fails to do so. A screenshot of the institution's website is attached herewith.



- vi. The application of the College for transition to ITEP was rejected by the NCTE on 09/04/2026 as the college was not a multidisciplinary institute. However, consequent to the rejection by the NCTE, the college entered into a collaboration with 'Mandiya College' in order to become multidisciplinary institute. Though the college entered into collaboration after the rejection of their application by NCTE but having later entered into collaboration with other institute, the applicant college approached court on 30/04/2026 against the rejection of their application by NCTE. So, the college approached court on wrong information after fraudulently creating a wrong impression in the court about wrong rejection by the NCTE. Further, as per the University's letter No. 40766 dated 19/06/2026, the University has stated that it has received an application regarding the affiliation of your institution, 'Mandiya College', for the year 2026-27; this letter makes it clear that Mandiya College still does not hold University affiliation currently.
- vii. According to the online application, the area of the library and reading room is 106.83 square meters. The applicant institution conducts the B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. (2 units each) and B.Ed. (2 units) courses; this implies a total of 600 students—comprising 400 students annually for the B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. courses and 200 students for the B.Ed. course. The available library space of 106.82 square meters is insufficient for these 600 students.
- viii. The applicant institution has stated that it possesses a large number of books. The institution is required to purchase 100 books annually for the two courses; however, no appropriate evidence has been submitted to substantiate this claim. Consequently, the institution's claim cannot be accepted.
- ix. The institution has uploaded geotagged photographs of multipurpose hall, The institution is running Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 2 units, and 2 units of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. The photograph of this multi-purpose hall shows that the space available therein is very congested as there is no adequate space available for movement inside the hall. The objective of requirement of the hall as per the regulation of the NCTE gets defeated with such constrained space. Hence, multipurpose hall does not comply with NCTE norms and standards.
- x. The concerned 'transition institution' has been operational for the past nine years and has been conducting the B.Ed. course for 17 years. Despite its long existence, the institution has not yet appointed full teaching staff in accordance with NCTE regulations. Furthermore, it appears that the institution does not pay its teachers salaries as per UGC or State Government norms.

- xi. The uploaded geotagged photo shows that the stairs have been covered with a temporary rexine, creating an illusion of a ramp leading to the upper floors. In fact, the geotagged photograph shows that; there are no ramp or lift facilities to reach the upper floors.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Visiting Team Report, Reply to Letter of Intent, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- The institution is required to upload the letter issued by the University regarding the recruitment of teaching staff, the list of experts nominated in accordance with the regulations and other necessary documents pertinent to the recruitment process .i.e. advertisement and other.
- Institution is required to upload the documents pertaining to the educational qualifications of all the teachers it has appointed, experience certificate if applicable as specified in the affidavit.
- “Statement giving the staff profile. The details therein should be filled by every faculty/staff members” is not in the prescribed format and not accordance with NCTE norms. The concerned institution is required to upload this information in the prescribed format and in compliance with NCTE norms.

- iv. Upon examining the website, the following information “Screenshot of name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph uploaded on the website” not found in proper format. The institution is required to upload the same in proper format.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post Lol be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Visiting Team Report, Reply to Show Cause Notice post inspection, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The society is having the total land area of 21490 sqm on lease basis from Nagarpalika, as per documents submitted by it. The above society is running the following courses approved by NCTE on the above land :-

- ii. As per information available on the website of Mahala Veterinary college i.e. <http://mvcreengus.com/Programs.aspx>, Mahala College i.e. <http://www.mahalacollege.com>, Mahala Residential School <https://mrpsschool.in>, Mahala Nursing College <http://mncreengus.com> / other regulatory bodies, the following courses are being run on the above land :-

- Bachelor of Veterinary Science (BVSc) (Five years)
- B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com
- B.S.c (Nursing)
- Mahala Residential School
- Bachelor of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences (BNYS) degree

- Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharma)
- iii. They operate as specialized, individual colleges within the same campus. In this connection it is submitted that, however, the built-up area stated by the institution in the affidavit submitted with the online application is only 9757.07 square meters, which falls short of for all courses.
 - iv. The institution in its application has not mentioned about running the B.P.Ed course by it. It has intentionally hidden the fact that it is running the B.P.Ed course on the above land.
 - v. As per the provisions of NCTE Regulations 2014, the land area of 5 Acres (20200 sqm) is required exclusively for running the B.P.Ed course. The institution does not have adequate land area for running all the other NCTE approved courses except B.P.Ed, as mentioned in para 1 above.
 - vi. By failing to provide information regarding the various courses, the institute is creating ambiguity about its infrastructure facilities. When considering all the aforementioned courses collectively, it can be stated with certainty that the institute lacks adequate Land Area, Built Up area and infrastructure to conduct them.
 - vii. In response to the point regarding the failure to repair the public address system, the Institution has uploaded irrelevant photos. These photos do not demonstrate that they possess a public address system. However, the institution has not uploaded any bill regarding its repair/replacement.
 - viii. To substantiate the claim that electronic publications and digital or online resources are available, the institution has attached a bill and a letter dated May 22, 2026. In reality, the institution conducts the teacher training courses mentioned in para 1 above. The institution does not possess electronic publications or digital/online resources. This implies that the institution is not prioritizing quality Education.
 - ix. As per norms working laboratory specially science should be on ground floor. equipment's of laboratory was not up to mark as institution is already running B.Sc. program. fabricated laboratory. The organization has uploaded some photos in support of this. However, the photos do not prove that the laboratory is located on the first floor, nor do they establish that the laboratory equipment is of high quality.
 - x. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
 - xi. The institution has uploaded a photograph of Health And Physical Education Room However, these photos cannot prove that the Health and Physical Education Room was shown on the day of the inspection.
 - xii. The institution has uploaded some photos in support of availability of Ramp. However, these photos cannot prove that a ramp facility is available to reach the upper floor. The building plan uploaded does not mention the availability of ramp.
 - xiii. The multipurpose hall was on the second floor, and the ramp was not there. The institution has uploaded some photos in support of this. However, these photos cannot prove that a ramp facility is available to reach the upper floor or in Multipurpose hall.
 - xiv. The online visiting team has observed that the arrangement and quality of the laboratories are unsatisfactory. Therefore, this institution is not suitable for launching the ITEP (Integrated Teacher Education Program). The institution has uploaded some photos in support of this. However, these photos cannot prove the arrangement and quality of laboratories. No bills towards purchase of laboratory equipments, chemicals etc. has been uploaded.
 - xv. In response to deficiency for Library, the applicant institution has stated that it possesses a large number of books and journals. As per NCTE norms the institution is required to have 3000 book with 1000 titles in its Library which is not available further no documentary evidence such as bills, entry in accession register/issue register for augmenting the library with 100 books annually is uploaded. Consequently, the institution's claim cannot be accepted.

- xvi. The uploaded bank statement by the institution shows that the institution is not paying the salary as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- xvii. The uploaded geo-tagged photographs indicate that furniture is not available in the multi-purpose hall. While the institution has uploaded photographs to support its claim, these do not substantiate the availability of furniture sufficient for seating capacity of minimum two hundred seats. Moreover, upon careful observation, it is evident that there is no furniture available to seat 200 students,
- xviii. The institution has required to upload details of the teaching staff for the Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) – 3 units; Master of Education (M.Ed.) – 1 unit; B.Ed.-M.Ed. (3-Year Integrated) – 1 unit; 4-Year Integrated Programme (B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed.) – 2 units; B.P.Ed (1 unit) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) – 4 units courses on its website. However, upon inspection of the website, teaching staff appointed in accordance with NCTE norms were not found.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Further, the WRC also decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution in File Nos. RJ-1441 - M.Ed, RJ-1439 - B.Ed, RJ-983 - D.El.Ed, NRCAPP201615200 - B.Ed.M.Ed (Integrated), RJ.... - B.P.Ed, directing the institution to submit the following documents, within 15 days of the issue of SCN :-

1. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents)
2. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
3. The institution is required to submit latest copy of Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
4. The institution is required to submit a attested/notarised copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme)
5. A attested/notarised copy of site plan showing all the plot/Survey No. mentioned in the land documents in one location alongwith land area and built up area.
6. The Institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Building Completion Certificate issued by the competent authority.
7. The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the State Government.
8. The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the State Government.
9. The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the State Government.
10. The institution is required to submit Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format. 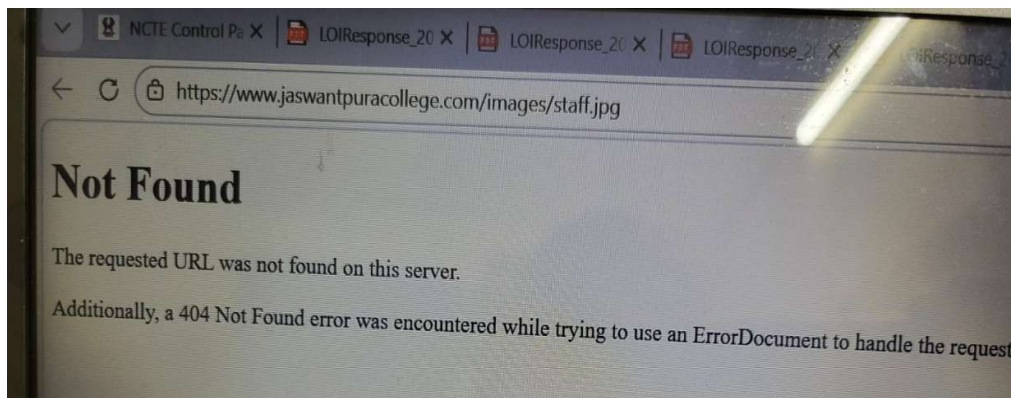

Regarding mismatch of plot area in Fire safety certificate, detail explanation submitted vide uploaded letter no.spl-08 dated 20.06.2026 along with copy of letter of clarification vide no.61 dated 20.06.2026 by Nagar Parishad, Chomu and a copy of another fire safety certificate vide no.57306 dated 03.02.20e6 valid up to 02.02.2028 with plot area 3500 sq.mts. in respect of institution viz.Sharda College (name is mismatched with online application).
 - vi. The website of the institution has not been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations as amended from time to time.
 - vii. The institution conducts two units for the 'Bachelor of Education' (B.Ed.) degree and two units for the 4-year integrated course leading to 'B.A. B.Ed.' / 'B.Sc. B.Ed.' degrees. The B.Ed. college has been in existence for 18 years, while the 'B.A. B.Ed.' / 'B.Sc. B.Ed.' program has been running for 9 years. The institution uploaded a geo-tagged photograph of the library and reading room; however, the seating capacity in the reading room is inadequate, and the library does not meet NCTE norms. The institution submitted a response by uploading various photographs in this regard. The applicant institution stated that it possesses a large number of books and journals. The institution is required to purchase 100 books annually for the respective courses; however, no valid evidence has been presented to substantiate this claim. Consequently, this claim by the institution cannot be accepted. The institution is required to maintain separate sets of books for the ITEP course and the B.Ed. course. The library is not in consonance with NCTE norms.

There is a discrepancy between these two figures regarding the land area. The institution does not possess a fire safety certificate covering the entire premises and construction.
