- According to information available on Google, 'Gyan Sagar College of Education' and 'Gyan Sagar College of Engineering' are both located on the same campus in Sironja village, Sagar district, Madhya Pradesh, along NH-26 (Narsinghpur Road). Since both colleges share the same premises, there is no distance between them; consequently, one can easily walk between the buildings of the two colleges within the campus. And in the same campus they are running B.Sc. also. the institution is required to upload the proper information regarding the courses running in the same campus .

Both colleges are part of the same campus on NH-26 near Sironja, so their coordinates are essentially the same.

Both institutions are located on the exact same campus along NH-26, Narsinghpur Road in Sironja, Sagar, Madhya Pradesh (near the Jubilee Petrol Pump). [CollegeBatch.com](#) +2

- ii. With reference to point (i), the institution is required to upload the building plan approved by the competent authority of the State Government. This plan must specify the name of the institution, the Khasra/plot/survey number, and the total land area and total built-up area allocated for each course conducted on the premises; it must also separately indicate the land and built-up area allocated for teacher education programmes (including multi-disciplinary programmes).
- iii. According to Google's information, 'Gyan Sagar College of Education, Sironja, Sagar' also conducts a B.Ed., D.El.Ed., course; however, the institution has not mentioned this information in its online application. The institution is required to upload the all courses information running in the same campuses. The organization should provide a clarification regarding this matter.
- iv. The website WWW.GSCE.IN, mentioned by the applicant organization in the online application, is not functional. The institution's website does not comply with the provisions of Clauses 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14), and 10(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution should develop the website in accordance with the amendments made from time to time.
- v. To implement this course, the concerned institution must already be conducting multidisciplinary courses (e.g., B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., etc.). The institution is required to upload details of all courses conducted on its premises; additionally, it is mandatory to upload a year-wise list of students enrolled in all ongoing courses, duly certified by the affiliated university.
- vi. The institution is required to upload the proper land documents of 158/409/1, 158/409/2, 158/409/3..
- vii. The institution is required to upload the proper mutation certificate issued by government competent authority of all khasaras. (A land mutation certificate (or *Dakhil Kharij* order) in Madhya Pradesh (MP) is a digitally generated revenue court order rather than a standalone certificate. Issued by the Tehsildar or Sub-Divisional Officer, it officially transfers property ownership in the government's Record of Rights) note that this Land Mutation Certificate should be verifiable against the updated 'Khatauni' available on the state's 'Revenue Case Management System' (RCMS) or the 'Bhulekh' portal.
- viii. The institution is required to upload the proper land use certificate (CLU) issued by government competent authority.
- ix. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmed duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last one years indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff. To demonstrate that the college is paying salaries to teaching staff in accordance with UGC and government directives, the institution must attach the bank statements of those employees.
- x. The institution is nine years old. Based on the teacher staff profile uploaded by

- the institution, it appears that the teaching staff has not yet been fully recruited in accordance with NCTE norms.
- xi. Regarding the applicant institution, the 'Visiting Team' (VT) has noted that the institution's library holds a total of 4,000 books across 1,000 titles. The institution has been in existence for nine years. Photographs of the library uploaded by the 'Visiting Team' indicate that the library does not meet NCTE norms. The institution is required to clarify that the library complies with NCTE norms and to upload relevant evidence supporting this. Note: The concerned institution must clarify whether the B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses are being conducted on the same premises.
 - xii. Photographs of the multi-purpose hall uploaded by the 'Visiting Team' reveal that once chairs are arranged for seating, there is no space left for students to move around. The hall does not appear suitable for organizing seminars and workshops. The multi-purpose hall fails to meet NCTE norms. The concerned institution is required to clarify its compliance with NCTE norms regarding the multi-purpose hall and upload supporting evidence. Note: The concerned institution must clarify whether the B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses are being conducted on the same premises.
 - xiii. The visiting team has uploaded photos of the college's front and rear sides, but the college's name is not visible on any of these buildings. The institution is required to upload geo-tagged photos that display the college's name on the building.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall

- in the category of multi-disciplinary institution. Hence, this institution is not eligible for Transition of B.A. B.Ed. Middle (1 unit) course.

 - ix. Building Completion is not accepted because Instead of Architect's Signature, it is done by some Art firm. which is not a valid authority for building completion. The institution is required to clarify the same.
 - x. Building is not PWD friendly. The institution failed to satisfy the VT in case of a ramp or lift.
 - xi. Library:The library is available but in very poor condition. Required numbers of books and titles are not available. The institution failed to show any evidence that the library is functional. The institution is running the above teacher education programme i.e. Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree. 2 units 100x2=200 started from 23/7/2007, 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed 1 unit 50x4=200 started form 22/5/2019, B.Sc. B.Ed degree 1 unit 50x4=100 started from 3/3/2021.The institution should renew subscriptions to the latest national and international journals. Digital Library facilities should be strengthened with adequate e-resources, online databases, and digital access for students and faculty. Uploaded information indicate that the library does not meet NCTE norms. Institution failed to show the evidence of the stock in the library and laboratories. Stock registers were not updated. The institution does not satisfy the prescribed statutory norms for library resources. There is a

- significant shortfall in the required number of books, separate titles, subscribed journals, and reference materials such as encyclopedias. In addition, the reading room capacity is below the mandatory requirement of seating at least 50 students. The institution is required to clarify that . the library, the library reading room, and the facilities therein comply with NCTE norms and to upload relevant evidence supporting this.
- xii. Laboratories were available but prepared only for the inspection. There was no evidence that laboratories are functional to the students. Deficient Laboratory and Stock Register Maintenance. The laboratories are poorly equipped and inadequately maintained, indicating a lack of regular academic use and operational readiness. The institution must demonstrate that all required laboratories are functional on a daily basis. Further, stock registers relating to equipment, consumables, and institutional assets are not properly updated, verified, or maintained as per standard requirements. The institution is in violation of standard operational guidelines regarding practical infrastructure. Laboratories required for the curriculum are severely under-equipped and poorly maintained, showing signs of cosmetic preparation rather than ongoing academic utility. You are required to prove continuous, daily operational viability of all labs. The institution is required to clarify that . the all laboratories and the facilities therein comply with NCTE norms and to upload relevant evidence supporting this.
- xiii. Non-compliance with PwD Accessibility Standards ; The campus infrastructure is not suitably equipped to support Persons with Disabilities. Essential facilities such as standard ramps, accessible toilets, and functional lift access to upper floors are either absent or inadequate. The existing steel-frame ramp does not conform to required accessibility specifications. The institution is required to clarify that.
- xiv. This institution conducts Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree. 2 units 100x2=200 started from 23/7/2007, 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed 1 unit 50x4=200 started form 22/5/2019, B.Sc. B.Ed degree 1 unit 50x4=100 started from 3/3/2021. The institution shall have one earmarked hall with seating capacity of minimum two hundred seats and minimum total area of 2000 sq. ft (Two thousand square feet). This hall shall be equipped for conducting seminars and workshops with installation of an audio-visual system. However, two teacher training courses are being conducted simultaneously at this institute. Consequently, the existing facilities are inadequate for all two courses. The institution needs to provide and explanation regarding this matter, supported by relevant evidence

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.
