The Committee noted the directions of the Hon'ble High Court Madhya Pradesh in W.P. No. 19984 of 2026 vide order dated 30/06/2026 interalia as under:

- a. "Shri Navtej Singh Ruprah, learned counsel for the petitioners,
- b. Submits
- c. That he has served all the respondents Humdast.
- d. Let service report be filed in the registry.
- e. Shri Siddharth Gontiya, learned counsel for the respondent No.3 and Shri Suyash Mohan Guru, learned counsel for the respondent No.4, pray for time to file their replies.
- f. Let replies be filed within three weeks.
- g. List after three weeks.
- h. Interim order, if any, to continue till then."

The Committee noted that the institution has submitted an application for shifting of premises From Satya Sai College of Education, At Hudkitala Post Budbuda, Tahpsil Waraseoni Baalaghat, Madhya Pradesh to Satya Sai College of Education, Sardar Patel knowledge City Waraseoni Road, Dongraiya, Balaghat, Madhya Pradesh. The application of the institution is found deficient for the following: -

1. The institution is required to deposit the DD of Rs 177,000/- in favour of "Member Secretary NCTE". The DD No. 284942 dated 10.04.2024 be returned to the institution.
2. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents)
3. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
4. The institution is required to submit latest copy of Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
5. NOC from the affiliating body for shifting of premises
6. The institution is required to submit a attested/notarised copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme)
7. An attested/notarised copy of site plan showing all the plot/Survey No. mentioned in the land documents in one location alongwith land area and built up area.

8. The Institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Building Completion Certificate issued by the competent authority.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity to submit the documents within 07 days from the date of issue of Show Cause notice, so as to enable WRC to take decision in the matter.

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Decision of WRC:-

On careful perusal of the original file of the institution along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Show Cause Notice, directions of *the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 5103/2026 vide Order dated 17.04.2026*, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is recognised for B.Ed & D.El.Ed course
- ii. The recognition of B.Ed course was withdrawn by WRC vide order dated 01.09.2020. The institution preferred an appeal against the decision of WRC and the Appellate Authority has remanded back the case to WRC vide order dated 28.01.2021.
- iii. The institution was issued Show Cause Notice vide dated 24-25th March 2021 as per the decision of WRC taken in 336th meeting.

	iv. As per records of WRC, the institution has not responded to the Show Cause Notice till date. v. The institution has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. and the Hon'ble Court has passed the following order dated 17.04.2026 :- 1. <i>"This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers: "(a) direction to Respondent No.2 to consider further and decide, in a time bound manner, the partially pending Application of the Petitioner Institution, seeking permission for shifting the premises, from its "existing" to its "new", qua the duly recognized B.Ed. course; and (b) consequent direction to Respondent No.2 to issue the Order of Restoration of Recognition to Petitioner Institution for running the B.Ed. course at its new premises, with the original sanctioned intake and all consequential benefits of being a recognized institution..."</i> 2. <i>For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.</i> 3. <i>Ms. Malhotra, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and opposes the petition.</i> 4. <i>I am of the view that the petitioner is only seeking consideration of his representation in a time bound manner for shifting of its premises and for restoration of recognition for running B.Ed. course. The respondents, in case are not agreeable, can always raise all of their objections in the order passed considering the representation of the petitioner.</i> 5. <i>For the said reasons, the petition is allowed and the respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation as per law and in accordance with the extant rules and regulations, in an expeditious manner and not later than 8 weeks from today.</i> 6. <i>The petition is disposed of, in the aforesaid terms, along with, pending applications, if any."</i> The WRC considered the entire matter in detail and decided that the institution be directed to submit the following documents, so that decision on shifting of application can be taken :- 1. Vide letter dated 02nd February 2017, the institution was requested to send proper application for shifting of premises alongwith the processing fees and essential documents, which has not been submitted by the institution till date. 2. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents) 3. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. 4. The institution is required to submit latest copy of Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. 5. NOC from the affiliating body for shifting of premises 6. The institution is required to submit a attested/notarised copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme) 7. 	<u>Decision of WRC:-</u> On careful perusal of the original file of the institution along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Show Cause Notice, directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2633/2020 vide Order dated 20.03.2026, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:- 1. The institution was issued show cause notice as per the decision of WRC taken in 460 (Part-III) meeting vide dated 21/05/2026 on the following grounds :-																		

	a. The institution has been recognised by NCTE at Plot No.38 & 40, Ward No. 33, Khasra No.3042, Saraswati Nagar, Panna Road, Chhattarpur, Madhya Pradesh, vide order dated 12.09.2008. b. The request of the institution to restore the second unit of its B.Ed. course which was discontinued by the WRC as per the decision taken by it in the 457th meeting will tantamount to an increase in annual intake of B.Ed. course from the existing 50 seats (one unit) to 100 seats (two units). c. Earlier WRC had taken decision not to allow the restoration of the intake from 50 to 100 students by the Vidyawati Chaturvedi Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya on the premise that the college is seeking o increase the intake as a fresh application which as per Section 15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, read with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014, and the National Council for Teacher Education Rules, 1997 is mandatorily required to be submitted in online mode in the prescribed format, along with the prescribed processing fee. d. However, now after directions of the Honourable High Court of Delhi, dated 08.05.2026, WRC has decided to give the Vidyawati Chaturvedi Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya another chance to explain why its application for restoring the second unit of its B.Ed. course resulting in increase of the total intake should again be considered by WRC. e. In view of the above, the Vidyawati Chaturvedi Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya is given another chance to represent its case with full facts complying with the objections of the WRC made while discontinuing the second unit of the B.Ed. course run by it. 2. In response to SCN, the institution has submitted the reply vide dated 26.05.2026 which was considered by WRC and the following points emerged :- a. The faculty submitted by the institution is approved in March 2017. The institution has not submitted any documentary proof to the effect that the staff appointed in 2017 are still working in the institution. b. The institution has been recognised by NCTE at Plot No. 38 & 40, Ward No. 33, Khasra No. 3042, Saraswati Nagar, Panna Road, Chhattarpur, Madhya Pradesh, vide order dated 12.09.2008. c. The institution suo-motto shifted to new premises at Kishore Sagar Talab Road, Chhattarpur, Madhya Pradesh in 2016, without prior approval from NCTE, which is in clear violation of the provisions of Clause 8(9) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014. d. The institution has not submitted an application as per NCTE Regulations 2014 with requisite processing fee for change/shifting of premises till date. e. The institution, vide its letter dated 14.03.2026, has addressed a communication to WRC requesting change of premises, without enclosing the requisite application or essential documents thereto. The Committee, on careful perusal of the entire matter, decided that Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution giving an opportunity to the institution to submit its representation/ comments on the above observations of WRC within seven days before a final decision is taken by WRC.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, along with documents received from institution, affiliating university and concerned bank related to complaint matter, the Committee observed as under:

- i. In response to WRC's letter no.225162 dated 20.05.2024 followed by reminder letter No.8840 dated 20.02.2026, no reply/ inquiry report received from the land and revenue authority (Collector & District Magistrate, Jhunjhunu) on the court / complaint matter related with land documents of the institution as alleged by the complainant, which is self-explanatory.
- ii. Reply vide letter no.25109 dated 12.06.2024 received from Affiliating University (Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, Sikar) forwarding certain documents pertaining to institution related with land, salary statement of staff, certificate issued by bank, faculty approval letter dated 10.03.2021. However, affiliating university has not furnished any comments on the forwarded complaint as well as copy of latest approved faculty list in respect of institution.
- iii. Reply vide letter no.254 dated 05.06.2024 received from institution shows that salary as per UGC/State Govt. pay scale is not paid to faculties as required under NCTE norms and regulations.

Therefore, the Committee decided as under:

1. The Principal Secretary, Higher Education, Govt. of Rajasthan be requested enclosing copy of court order dated 19.03.2024 along with copy of alleged complaint against the institution to submit inquiry report intimating details of land in possession of the institution since the complainant in its complaint stated that the institution is having less land i.e. 819 sq. gauge against requirement of 2500 sq. mts. for conducting B.Ed. course with annual intake 100 students. The report of State Govt. supported with documents shall be submitted within 15 days from the receipt of the letter from WRC, NCTE. Copy of the letter be endorsed to District Magistrate, Jhunjhunu.
2. The Commissioner, College/ Higher Education, Govt. of Rajasthan be requested be requested enclosing copy of court order dated 19.03.2024 along with copy of alleged complaint against the institution to submit inquiry report intimating details of land in possession of the institution since the complainant in its complaint stated that the institution is having less land i.e. 819 sq. gauge against requirement of 2500 sq. mts. for conducting B.Ed. course with annual intake 100 students. The report of State Govt. supported with documents shall be submitted within 15 days from the receipt of the letter from WRC, NCTE. Copy of the letter be endorsed to District Magistrate, Jhunjhunu.
3. The Affiliating University be requested to furnish point-wise comments on the alleged complaint along with latest approved faculty list for B.Ed. course in respect of the institution within 15 days from the receipt of the letter from WRC, NCTE.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, along with compliance related to revised recognition order issued in pursuance of court order dated 12.12.2025, the Committee observed as under:

- i. Application dated 28.01.2026 for shifting of premises is received in WRC NCTE on 09.02.2026.
- ii. NOC of affiliating body related to status of affiliation for B.Ed. course from the academic session 2013-2014 to 2026-2027 is not submitted.
- iii. Information not provided as to how the institution was running B.Ed. course while affiliation withdrawn by the affiliating university.
- iv. NOC not submitted from Affiliating University i.e. Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University for shifting of premises.
- v. Prior to approval for shifting of premises, M.K. University cannot grant affiliation to B.Ed. course.

1) In reference to SCN u/S 17 dated 23.12.2025 issued in pursuance of Revised Recognition Order dated 23.12.2025 on the direction of Hon'ble Court, reply vide letter dated 19.01.2026 submitted by institution. The Committee observed that institution is still deficient on the following:

- (i) Rent deed (Lease agreement) registered dated 28.12.2004 in the name of trust is submitted, which is valid for 50 years.
- (ii) Mutation certificate of land issued by competent Govt. authority is not submitted.
- (iii) Blueprint of approved Building plan where institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course is submitted, which is not certified by the Competent Govt. Authority and not indicated therein, the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multipurpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms and other amenities.
- (iv) Self-Declaration Certificate dated 28.01.2026 is submitted by Trustee, Vitthalprabhu Education & Charitable Trust to the effect that the land is free from all kinds of encumbrances. Latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances is not submitted.
- (v) Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses is not submitted.
- (vi) Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
- (vii) In support of BCC, copy of Occupancy Certificate dated 07.02.2017 for plot no./Survey no.3 Paiki 1 & 2/1 is submitted, wherein stated that the building is now completed and fit for occupation issued by Civil Supervisor, Patan Municipality. The Plot/Survey no. mentioned in the document pertains to application for the proposed shifting of premises. Latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed

	format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises is not submitted.
