III. अध्यक्ष की अनुमति से, श्रीमती रश्मि शुक्ला, क्षेत्रीय निदेशक व संयोजक, पश्चिमी क्षेत्रीय समिति ने समिति के समक्ष कार्यसूची प्रस्तुत की। प्रत्येक कार्यसूची पर मदवार निर्णय निम्नानुसार है:-

1	<u>CONSIDERATION OF COURT MATTER</u> - <i>Filing of Letters Patent Appeals (LPAs) before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the Common Order dated 29.05.2026 passed in W.P.(C) No. 4860/2026 (Vision College of Teachers Training) & connected matters and subsequent orders of like effect.</i>
	The Committee took up for consideration the agenda relating to the ITEP transition court matters and the Legal Opinion dated 20.07.2026 furnished by the Panel Counsel, NCTE. After detailed deliberation, the Committee observed as under: 1. The Committee noted that, in furtherance of the National Education Policy, 2020 and the NCTE Gazette Notification dated 26.10.2021, NCTE had, through successive Public Notices (including those dated 05.02.2024, 05.03.2024, 06.05.2025, 25.08.2025 and, finally, 12.09.2025), gave an opportunity to existing NCTE institutions offering the 4-year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. for transition into the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP). 2. The Committee noted that several such institutions approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by way of writ petitions, and that in the lead batch of W.P.(C) No. 4860/2026 (titled <i>Vision College of Teachers Training</i>) and connected matters, the Hon'ble Court, vide Common Order dated 29.05.2026, quashed the refusal orders and directed that inspection of the institutions be conducted within three weeks and the applications be finally decided on or before 30.06.2026. This was despite the submissions advanced on behalf of NCTE that the Regulations and the S.O.P. contemplate a two-stage scrutiny mechanism involving two separate Show Cause Notices, that under Regulation 7(7) the Regional Committee may decide the matter "on its own merits," and that the petitioners have an efficacious statutory remedy of appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act. 3. The Committee noted that, following the Common Order dated 29.05.2026, the Hon'ble Court has, on various subsequent dates, passed a series of orders of like effect in other connected writ petitions, similarly quashing the refusal orders and directing to conduct inspection of the institution (s). 4. The Committee considered the Legal Opinion dated 20.07.2026 of the Panel Counsel, wherein, for the reasons stated therein, it has been advised that the Common Order dated 29.05.2026 and all subsequent orders of like effect be challenged by way of Letters Patent Appeals (LPAs) before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, in a phased manner, as detailed in the said Opinion.

	<u>DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE</u> Having regard to the facts and circumstances aforesaid and the Legal Opinion dated 20.07.2026 of the Panel Counsel, the Committee resolved and decided as under:- (i) The Committee recommended to challenge to the Common Order dated 29.05.2026 passed in W.P.(C) No. 4860/2026 (Vision College of Teachers Training) & connected matters and subsequent orders vide dated (29.05.2026, 05.06.2026, 08.06.2026, 15.06.2026, 24.07.2026, 01.07.2026, 02.07.2026, 03.07.2026, 06.07.2026, 07.07.2026, 08.07.2026) of like effect quashing the refusal orders and directing to conduct Inspection, by filing Letters Patent Appeals before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The WRC further decided to challenge any subsequent Order (s) on the same line. (ii) The Committee recommended that the LPAs be filed in a phased manner as recommended in the Legal Opinion dated 20.07.2026, commencing at the first stage with the lead matter W.P.(C) No. 4860/2026 and a select group of matters. (iv) The Committee took note that inspections stand conducted in respect of some of the institutions in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court. Having deliberated upon the matter, the Committee decided that further action in respect of such applications shall be kept in abeyance, and that further action shall be taken subject to and in consonance with the outcome of the Letters Patent Appeals.

	This institution was recognised by WRC-NCTE for ITEP course vide order dated 21/05/2026 as per the decision taken by WRC in its 460th meeting from the academic session 2027-2028. 2. Aggrieved by the order of WRC granting recognition for the academic session 2027-2028, the institution approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 762/2026 wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 14th July 2026 has directed as under :- <i>"...10. For the reasons stated above, the writ petitions are allowed in the following terms:</i> <i>"....i) The National Council for Teacher Education shall issue a modified recognition order forthwith and in any case within week Vidyapith by order dated 21.05.2026 operative from the academic session 2026-27 and permitting the petitioner to admit students against the recognised intake."</i> <i>"....ii) Upon issuance of the modified recognition order, the petitioner shall be provisionally permitted to participate in the counselling and admission process for the academic session 2026-27, subject to compliance with the applicable norms and regulatory requirements...."</i> The WRC considered the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and decided that the recognition order dated 21/05/2026 granted by WRC for ITEP 4 Unit B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit),		

	Middle (1 unit) may be modified to the extent that the academic session in the Recognition order may be treated as 2026-2027 subject to compliance with the applicable norms and regulatory requirements.
