The Committee took up for consideration the agenda and after detailed deliberation, the Committee observed as under:

- After following extant procedure of NCTE the applications of the above institutions were refused permission for transition from existing existing B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. into ITEP programme.
- Being aggrieved against the decision of WRC in refusing/rejecting transition applications, the above mentioned institutions approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by filing Writ Petitions mentioned against each. The Hon'ble Court had disposed of the Writ Petition (s) filed by the institutions on different dates, quashing the refusal order of WRC and remanding back the matter to WRC to reconsider reply to show cause notice (s) submitted by above mentioned institutions as per law within a period of two weeks and also directing WRC to provide copy of inspection report to the institution (s).

2. The Committee noted the orders of the Hon'ble Court passed in Writ Petition mentioned against each institution, whereby the matter was remanded to WRC for reconsideration of the institution's reply to the Show Cause Notice.

3. In Compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Court, the Committee reconsidered the institution's reply to SCN post VT and decided to provide a copy of the inspection report to the institution and also decided that the institutions be directed to submit its reply / representation on the following grounds within seven days :-

		i. The JLN COLLEGE applied for BA-B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. 2 units each, and they are running Integrated B.Ed., B.A and B.Sc, but the instructional and infrastructural facilities to accommodate ITEP 04 units are not sufficient, and they are not fulfilling the norms of NCTE accordingly. ii. Required Classrooms were not present for current courses. iii. The Institute does not have the infrastructure to run all multidisciplinary and teacher education programme in the same place. iv. Labs were not having Basic infrastructure like Chair and proper lighting. v. Labs were not having Basic infrastructure like Chair other furniture and various apparatus. vi. Classrooms furniture were very dilapidated in conditions. vii. Washrooms for Specially Abled Persons was not available. viii. Library resources were not having adequate books. Bills in library were looked very improper. ix. Labs were having improper stock register. No stock verification was done in several years. It looks like a fake register. Bills for lab equipment were improper. x. Attendance registers and project files were not shown at the time of inspection. xi. Facilities for special ability person is not proper and does not following universal guideline. Basic things like ramp for upper floor does not exist but institute claimed in form. xii. Insufficient infrastructure facilities. Required Classrooms were not present for current courses.

		i. Another institution bearing transition application no.2627202509192914 B.R. CHAUDHARY COLLEGE, Kh. No.33/244, Street/Road- 19 JRK, PAKKA BHADWAN, HANUMANGARH, RAJASTHAN-335802 having identical Khasra number and same Street/Road- 19 JRK, with same address of this transition application has been refused at the stage of preliminary scrutiny of application vide order dated 24.04.2026 ii. Address, Kh. No. and Street/Road of this transition application bearing no.2627202509223028 BANSAL COLLEGE OF HIGHER EDUCATION Kh.no. 33/244 KILLA NO 22, Street/Road- 19 JRK, PAKKA BHADWA, 19 JRK, HANUMANGARH, GOLUWALA, HANUMANGARH, RAJASTHAN-335802 is identical with B.R. Chaudhary College as quoted above. An offline verified complaint received against the institution Bansal College of Higher Education. iii. Name and address of Parent organization as per recognition order dated 30.04.2017 for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. is "B. R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya, Village- 19 JRK, Tehsil/Taluka-Hanumangar Street/ Road Pkka Bhadwa, Hanumangarh, Rajasthan-335802" whereas in the first para of the amended certificate of registration vide no.04/Hanumangarh/2016-2017 dated 07.01.2021, the name and address of parent organization mentioned "B. R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti, 19 J.R.K(Pakka Bhadwa)Tehsil & Dist. Hanumangarh. The name of parent organization is mismatched with recognition order. iv. As per uploaded amended certificate of registration dated 07.01.2021, the changed name and address of parent organization reflected in the said certificate is "Bansal Education Welfare Society, (hand-written 19 inserted in black colour pen) J.R.K(Pakka Bhadwa)Tehsil & Dist. Hanumangarh". v. In the document uploaded for latest NEC dated 08.01.2026 issued by Tahasildar, Hanumangarh dated 08.01.2026 which is without affixing office seal of Tahasildar, land Kh.no.32/244, 33/244, Total land area 0.992 hectare or 9920 sq.mts. in the

		name of Bansal Education Welfare Society Goluwala. The land area as per Land Details of online application is 11530 sq.mts., land area is mismatched. A round stamp of Secretary is affixed in the latest NEC showing society name and address "B. R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samittee, 19 JRK Pakka Bhadwa", whereas the new name of society "Bansal Education Welfare Society" as per online application. The society name is mismatched as reflected in the latest NEC. vi. Uploaded building plan is not clearly legible; the approving authority of building plan is also not legible. As per online application, the institution itself is running Multidisciplinary programmes (B.A. 240x3=720, B.Sc. 70x3= 210), in addition, it is running B.Ed. (100 intake), B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (100 intake). The Ground or First Floor with earmarked area for Teacher Education Course and demarcated area for MDI Courses is not clearly highlighted in the uploaded illegible building plan by the institution. vii. Building Plan is approved by Assistant Engineer (Sahayak Abhianta) PWD who is competent authority to approve the Building Plan. it is also stamped by Registered architect duly showing the Built up area of first floor and ground floor." However, seal and signation of approving authority of plan is not clearly legible. viii. Date of inspection of building by the certifying authority is not mentioned in the uploaded BCC. As per land details, kh.no.32/244, 33/244 land area 11540 sq.mts. built up area 3460 sq.mts. date of registration of land 03.05.2016, whereas in the uploaded BCC certified by AE, PWD, Pilibanga Division (without date) pertains to land bearing Kh.no.1332/30, Stone no.32/244, 33/244, Muno.86,87, killa no.16, 25-11,20,21,22 Chk 19 JRK G.P. Pakka Bhadwa Total land area of institution 12980 sq.mts..total built up area of institution 3478 sq.mts. Date of registration of land 02.05.2016. Location of land in single plot, supporting documentary proof issued by Govt. dept. is not uploaded. As per BCC, Building plan is approved by Panchayat, whereas mentioned in the reply of SCN that Building plan is approved by Assistant Engineer (Sahayak Abhiyanta) PWD. Recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course was issued vide order 30.04.2017 whereas date of completion of construction of building is in year 2020. Earmarked total area and built up area mentioning name of each Teacher Education programme is not reflected in the BCC. Information regarding running of all other courses and its demarcated land and built-up area is not mentioned in the BCC. ix. At the time of initial submission of online application Letter change of Land use (CLU) for educational purpose dated 08.03.2016 is uploaded mentioning the Converted/ diverted land area under the CLU (in sq m) 11530, whereas actual converted land area in respect of land kh.no.32/244, 33/244 is 9920 sq.mts. There is difference in converted/ diverted land area for use of land for educational purposes. x. The institution submits only explanation "Building Plan is approved by Assistant Engineer (Sahayak Abhianta) PWD who is competent authority to approve the Building Plan. it is also stamped by Registered architect duly showing the Built-up area of first floor and ground floor." In the uploaded BCC, it has mentioned that building plan is approved by Panchayat, which contradicts the statement made by the institution.

	i.	Basic amenities are not available as per NCTE norms.
	ii.	Basic facilities such as toilets, lifts, ramps, tactile markings etc. are not available for persons with special needs for easy and efficient use of the campus and built environment by all.

	iii. Certificate of Building Safety based on VISUAL INSPECTION from Sub Div Officer, PWD REWA dated 16 Jan 2025 is uploaded. In this Building Safety Certificate, it is not mentioned that certificate is issued in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority as required under NCTE Regulations, 2021. iv. There is no provision of lift, ramp in building. No proper ramp at entrance to building, Absence of Handrails, Tactile paving, etc. v. No Toilets available for Persons with Special Abilities or Elderly or Physically Challenged persons. vi. Approved Plan does not provide Room Number. vii. It is noted that the 'DRS B.Ed College' is running only B.Com. BCA, PGDCA, Diploma in Yoga Education course. The institution is not running multidisciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTE Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multidisciplinary institution. viii. The institution is not offering B.A. course. The institute does not have enough land area to conduct teacher education programmes and other courses in the same premises. The institute does not own land as per NCTE rules.

	i. The VT member observed that no staff member was available for communication at the time of the inspection. In its response, the institution uploaded a photograph of an employee; however, the committee was unable to verify whether that employee was actually present at that time. ii. A VT member remarked that the organization's infrastructure is not in a condition to function as an institution. In response, the organization uploaded some photographs; however, these were not geotagged. Consequently, the committee has been unable to verify whether or not the organization's infrastructure is in a condition to function as an institution. iii. VT Members remarked that None of the laboratories were up to the marks of NCTE. Classrooms were not in good condition. Seating arrangement in classrooms were not proper. iv. Title of Book Less than 1000 Education Encyclopaedia Electronic Publication Digital or Online Resources are not available. No proper seating arrangements were there in the library. v. As VT Members reported Humanities Stream Laboratories, Faculty Room, Availability of adequate Furniture, Effective arrangement of clearing of campus, water and toilet, Rain Water Harvesting System, Facilities for co-curricular Activities are not available. vi. The institute has applied for the B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed.. programs. The institute currently offers only the B.A. program. It does not offer the B.Sc. program. Consequently, the institute was unable to upload the affiliation order for the BSc program vii. Furniture does not meet the requirement for the Institute. viii. facilities like Ram not available for ground floor, No Support is available with ramp to first floor. ix. College did not produce salary slips of the teachers.

	i. The institution has not uploaded the required and specific documents. However, 46 pages of documents have been uploaded for reply; The address of the institution is not clear; The documents submitted by the college are not accepted. ii. The building does not comply with NCTE norms, and the building plan has not been prepared by an architect registered with the Council of Architecture—this is unacceptable. In reply of this, the institution has not uploaded the appropriate documents related to the building plan; it has only uploaded a covering letter. iii. “Break-up of Built up area mentioned in the Building Plan for the Teacher Education Programme/S- Multipurpose hall is not as per norms. Furniture and fixtures in Multi purpose hall are not as per NCTE requirement. Rooms seems small against the claim of college- Not Accepted.” In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. iv. “Other Information required- Some portion of building is under construction. No proper fire safety is available in the building. Basic facilities are not visible in the building. College management did not give any satisfactory answer for the same”. In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. v. “Building Completion- Some constructions are going on in the building- Not Accepted.” In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. vi. As per NCTE norms “The library shall cater to the requirements of the programme and shall have a seating capacity for at least fifty persons equipped with minimum 1000 (one thousand) titles and 4000 (four thousand) books. At least one hundred titles of quality books shall be added to the library every year. “Book in Library Not Sufficient- Not Accepted..” In reply of this, the college has uploaded photographs of some tax invoice. The college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. vii. “The college has uploaded a photograph of the Seating Capacity-” In reply of this, the college has uploaded a photo showing the seating arrangement; the photo reveals that there is absolutely no area for movement. The college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. viii. “Seating Capacity- Proper Furniture was not available- Not Accepted.” The college has uploaded a photo showing the seating arrangement; the photo reveals that there is absolutely no area for movement. The college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. ix. “Title of Book- No Librarian was available. No Bills produced by college. Information provided by College seems doubtful.” A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. x. “Professional Research General-Not accepted.” “Electronic Publication-Not Available” “Digital or Online Resources- Not Available”. In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xi. “Science Stream Laboratories- Not properly maintained.” “Humanities Stream Laboratories, Common Room-Not Properly Maintained”. In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xii. “Availability of Adequate Furniture- Not Available.” “Facilities for Co-curricular Activities- Not Sufficient.” In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point.	

	xiii. "Institution has lack of basic infrastructure and not provided accurate information during Virtual Inspection." In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xiv. "The Multipurpose Hall has an area of only 900 square feet with a seating capacity of 80, which is inadequate for conducting academic activities such as seminars, workshops, and conferences. Additionally, the quality of furniture is not satisfactory and requires improvement." In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xv. "There is no proper marking or identification system for institutional assets, making it difficult to establish ownership and accountability. Furthermore, no proper stock register is maintained by the institution." In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xvi. "The Computer Laboratory is equipped with only 12 computers, which is insufficient in proportion to the student strength and restricts effective practical exposure." "The institution does not have a Language Laboratory. Additionally, no language software has been purchased or installed to support language proficiency and skill development." In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xvii. "During the inspection, only 2–3 teaching staff members were present for the ongoing course, while others were absent. Therefore, staff recruitment, eligibility criteria, and salary structure must strictly adhere to prescribed norms to maintain academic standards and institutional credibility." A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xviii. No librarian was present in the library. As per verbal communication, the library has approximately 2,500 books and 900 titles; however, no accession register is maintained to verify the stock. The library has no encyclopedias, journals, and digital/e-resources. The seating capacity is also inadequate, and the available books are not aligned with the syllabus of teacher education courses. xix. "Laboratories such as the Psychology Lab and Geography Lab are inadequately equipped with poor-quality materials. The laboratory spaces are too small, lack proper seating arrangements, and are not functional due to insufficient equipment." In reply of this, the college has uploaded various 198 pages documents. A proper reply has not been provided regarding the specific point. xx. The college building does not have a proper ramp facility for persons with disabilities. No Ramp or Lift provision for the upper floors. xxi. Classrooms have lack proper furniture and ICT facility, which adversely affects the teaching–learning process. xxii. No toilets for physically challenged persons.

	i. "Photo of Institute's Building-Not Accepted. The authenticity of the building shown during the inspection is doubtful; it appeared that the inspection was conducted in a public school by placing signboards such as classrooms, common room, and laboratories." in the reply of this; The institution has uploaded various land-related documents in this regard; however, this does not resolve the issues. ii. the observations of the online visiting team are "Class Room - Not Accepted." "Seating Capacity- Not Accepted" in the reply of this; The institution has uploaded various photographs in this regard. However, these photos do not prove that the classrooms are spacious and that the seating capacity meets NCTE norms.	

iii.	"Seating Capacity of Multipurpose Hall - Not Accepted. During the Inspection, the College attempted to misguide the Team by arranging Rented Chairs and Furniture from a Tent House in the Multipurpose Hall.". In response to this, the institution has uploaded various invoices for the purchase of furniture. However, these photographs do not resolve the issues in question.
iv.	"Science Stream Laboratories- Not Available" "Humanities Stream Laboratories- Not Available" "Activity Cum Resource Center- Not Available." "Health And Physical Education Room- Not Available." In response to this, the institution has uploaded stock register pages and some photos. However, these photographs and stock register pages do not resolve the issues in question.
v.	"Faculty Room- Not Available." "The staff room does not have a separate space for teachers" "Common Room- Not Available." "Facilities For Co-Curricular Activities- Not Available." In response to this, the institution has uploaded stock register pages, invoice and some photos. However, these photographs and stock register pages do not resolve the issues in question.
vi.	"From the very beginning of the inspection, the college attempted to conceal facts and presented misleading information before the inspection team."
vii.	The college building does not have a proper ramp for persons with disabilities; only stairs were covered with plywood and presented as a ramp.
viii.	There is no proper ventilation in ground floor classrooms and laboratories.
ix.	There is no issue register to support the already running teacher education course in the college.
x.	The college has not made arrangements as per NCTE norms for essential facilities such as a library, laboratories, multipurpose hall, humanities stream laboratories, health and physical education room, psychology lab, and adequate furniture, despite being operational.
xi.	The fire safety certificate has been obtained in the name of the managing committee and does not mention the college; the website also indicates that the same committee operates multiple institution/colleges/school.
xii.	"The authenticity of the institution is questionable." "From the above facts, it is evident that the college neither has its own building nor the required educational resources for the ITEP programme."
xiii.	"Adequate accessibility provisions are lacking, as there are no lifts or ramps to facilitate access to upper floors for specially-abled individuals." "Currently institute does not have Ramp/Lift for upper floors, instead of it a wooden board put on staircase with black carpet covering it."
xiv.	"There is no issue register or documentation to support the teacher education courses currently claimed to be running like proper purchase of goods and stock verifications."
xv.	"Some office spaces presented Girls and Boys common rooms. Files and other furniture were seen in these rooms, no pad vending machine in institute/ Girls common rooms."
xvi.	"To simulate a prepared environment, the college arranged rented furniture and chairs from a tent house for the multipurpose hall as none of it was having record pen written Paper slip pasted on it for the day."
xvii.	There are less numbers of classrooms in the institute. The college has failed to establish required facilities including a library, psychology lab, humanities laboratories, and health and physical education rooms as per NCTE norms.
xviii.	The building presented appears to belong to many institutes as other Institute put same pics on their website. Like Shree Krishna Public School; Shri Krishna TT College Sikandra.
xix.	Labs are being run in Underground/Basement which is not permitted as per NBC 2016 and NCTE Norms. Laboratories lack proper ventilation, especially Chemistry, Botany and Physics lab.
