Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, and the Committee observed as under:

- The institution was granted the recognition for the D.Ed. course vide order No. WRC/5-6/2008/58607-58612 dated 04.08.2009.
- The recognition for D.Ed. course was withdrawn vide WRC order dated 27.09.2016. The institution preferred an Appeal against the WRC withdrawal order which was heard by the appeal committee and the WRC withdrawal order was kept in against and the case was remanded back vide appeal committee order No. 89-760\2016\appeal/5th meeting-2017/52716 dated 18.4.2017
- Thereafter, the matter was considered in WRC 277th meeting held on 29th to 30th June 2017 as the committee decided as under:

The case file was seen. This is a case of Appeal. The Rajya Shiksha Kendra, Bhopal had forwarded letter no. 8378/JaPra/46/14 dt. 15/03/2016 enclosing Report from the Collector about the non-existence of land and building of Kaila Devi College. Subsequently Show Cause Notice was issued and recognition was withdrawn vide letter dt. 27/09/2016. Thereafter, the institution went in Appeal saying that the Show Cause Notice was addressed to the old mailing address of the institution and secondly that the institution had shifted to Khasra no. 512, Village-Baraua vide WRC order dt. 15/03/2013.

The Appeal Committee had remanded the case to the WRC to reissue Show Cause Notice to the new address.

However, it is clear that the Show Cause Notice pertains to the land and building in the old address, Show Cause Notice (2016) was sent to the old address and returned undelivered.

Therefore, there is a chronological misfit. The WRC decided as follows:-

- Shifting was permitted after following due procedure.*
- The Collector gave the Report (2015) saying that there is neither land nor building at plot no. 512, Village-Baraua to which the institution had already shifted in 2013.*
- Re-issue Show Cause Notice as directed by the Appellate Authority.*
- The facts of the case be brought to the notice of the Collector to take action as deemed by him. The old report be also forwarded to him. The Collector be requested to send the report at an early date.*

As per Appeal order, the order of withdrawal is kept in abeyance.

- However, as per the available records the ATR of the above decision of WRC is not readily available in the regulatory file.
- The Committee noted that the institution has filed the court case W.P. No- 5918/2026 before the hon'ble high court of Delhi and the court has passed order dated: 20.07.2026 with following directions:

“The captioned matter was listed today for hearing.

The Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of the matter in terms of similar orders passed by this Hon'ble Court state that once the Appeal Committee remand back the matter, the withdrawal order stands automatically quashed.

The Hon'ble Court has further directed that the WRC shall issue an order restoring the recognition within one week from today and has further direction that the petitioner -College shall be allowed to participate in the cancelling for the present academic year.

This for your kind information and record.”

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 20.07.2026, the recognition for the D.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 50 students.

The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance.

The committee further decided that the adherence of the NCTE regulations, Norms and Standards is required to be ascertained from the institution in respect of the infrastructure, instructional facilities and staff etc. Hence, a show cause notice for the same be issued for submission of the reply within 15 days.

The WRC also noted that as per the decision of WRC in its 277th meeting decided that the District Collector is required to submit a report saying that there is neither land nor building at plot no. 512, Village-Baraua to which the institution had already shifted in 2013. The report be requisitioned from the District Collector. A letter to the District Collector with a copy to Secretary, Education be issued.

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, and the Committee observed as under:

The matter was considered in its 457th (P-1 C) held on 20th to 22nd April 2026 WRC Committee decided as under:-

“The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)3614/2026 titled OM COLLEGE OF EDUCATION VS. NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION & ANR vide its order 20.03.2026 disposed of the case with following directions, the operative part of the court is as under:

“(a) direct the Respondent No.2 to consider & decide the pending application of Petitioner Institution submitted for shifting of its premises, from its ‘existing’ to ‘new’, expeditiously & preferably within a period of one month; and...”

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.

3. Mr. Sethi, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that the application will be decided expeditiously.

4. Hence, the petition is allowed and the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the application dated 08.12.2023 expeditiously and not later than 4 weeks from today.

5. With these directions, the petition is disposed of.”

The Committee took note of the fact that the institution has been requested vide WRC email dated 17.04.2026 to furnish the requisite information for conducting inspection in the prescribed proforma along with the supporting land documents for constituting the visiting team to cause virtual inspection. The institution has also been reminded vide email dated 22.04.2026. however, the reply is still awaited.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that, in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 20.03.2026, the institution may be provided a period of three (03) days to furnish the requisite proforma with supporting documents.”

The institution has submitted ETI form with supporting documents. The VT was conducted through online, VT Schedule ID 260200 Schedule Dated 23.05.2026 VT Members name (1) Dr. Sudarshan Mishra (2) Dr. Ruchi Dubey (3) Mr. Kamallesh Kumar, VT report was submitted on 28.05.2026.

The matter was considered in its 462nd (P-I) held on 03rd to 04th June 2026 the Committee decided as under:-

“The recognition was granted to the institution at Plot No. 249/1, Village – Ranapur, Post Office – Ranapur, Tehsil – Ranaur, District – Jhabua – 457661, Madhya Pradesh for B.Ed & D.El.Ed. courses.

2. The institution has submitted an application for shifting premises to Khasra no. 114/7, 115/6, Gram – Thandla, Tehsil – Thandla, District – Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh

3. The virtual Visiting Team for shifting of premises was conducted and the VTR was considered by WRC in its meeting wherein the WRC observed as under:-

i. The institution has not produced the faculty details as per the format for both D.El.Ed. and B.Ed.

As per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.06.2026. the institution has submitted reply of SCN received on 15.07.2026. **It is noticed that the list of teaching staff submitted by the institution is not in the prescribed format of NCTE. Further, the institution has not enclosed the letter of approval of its teaching staff issued by the competent authority of the affiliating university.**

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation / submission on the above observations of WRC, within 15 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

<u>Decision of WRC:</u> The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, and the Committee observed as under: - The recognition was granted to the institution namely CHINDHUJI LAXMANRAO PURKE SHIKSHAN PRASARAK MANDAL, SHRI VASANT PURKE PROFESSORS COLONY, DARDA NAGAR, YAVATMAL 445001 Order No. WRC/5-MAHARASHTRA for B.Ed. course vide 6/APW00809/123143/71/2007/C-13034-13039 dt. 17.03.2007 - The revised order was issued to the institution namely CHINDHUJI LAXMANRAO PURKE SHIKSHAN No. PRASARAK MANDAL, SHRI VASANT PURKE PROFESSORS COLONY, DARDA NAGAR, YAVATMAL order MAHARASHTRA-445001 vide WRC/APW00809/123143/2015/145504,507,510,512,517,521 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16. - As per decision of WRC in its 255th meeting Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.03.2017 on the following points:- <i>Staff Profile for the session 2015-16 duly approved by the affiliating body. Originally notarized Change of land Use/Non-Encumbrance Certificate, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate.</i> - Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on. 31.03.2017. - The institution has not submitted reply of SCN dt 31.03.2017. - Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on. 13.02.2020 and the reply was received on 16.03.2020. The matter was considered in its 322nd Meeting of WRC held on 23rd – 24th November 2020 and the Committee decided that the recognition of B.Ed. programme of the institution be under WITHDRAWN. Accordingly, Withdrawal Order vide No. WRC/APW00809/123143/322nd/2020 was issued to the institution on. 11.12.2020. - The institution filed an Appeal against the Withdrawal Order dated 11.12.2020 the Appeal Committee vide Order dated 17.10.2025 set aside the WRC order dated 11.12.2020 and remanded back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration. The WRC noted that as per Section 18 of NCTE Act, the institution may prefer an appeal within 60 days from the date of receipt of withdrawal order. However, in the instant case, the institution has preferred an appeal to the appellate authority after a lapse of more than 5 years. In the First para of the appeal order, it is mentioned in the Grounds for Withdrawal as “The institution has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice” which is factually incorrect. The WRC further noted that the appeal committee vide appeal order dated 17.10.2025 has considered the matter on the grounds for non-submission of PAR for the year 2021-22 and 2022-2023 without going into the grounds of withdrawal order dated 11.12.2020. The WRC decided that the matter may be referred to appeal committee for reconsideration of its decision vide appeal order dated 17.10.2025 as per NCTE Regulations, Norms and Standards.

Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Directions of the Hon'ble Court, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under: The institution was issued Show Cause Notice on 15.5.2026 thereby providing an opportunity to submit its reply/response within 15 days of the receipt of SCN. The institution has not submitted its reply to the Show cause notice till date. - The website of the institution has not been compliance as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 of para 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the website as per NCTE regulations. - The institution is required to upload authorization letter on stamp paper as per admissible government rate - The institution has expressed its intention to become a multidisciplinary institution through collaboration, as stipulated in the NCTE Guidelines for transforming NCTE recognized stand-alone teacher education institutions into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. However, the institution has not uploaded any Memorandum of Collaboration (MoC). - The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. - The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for collaboration are affiliated with the same university. - The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. - The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence confirming that 'Sharma Modern Mahila Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya' and the institution to be collaborated with, are situated within the radius of 10 Kilometers. - The institution is required to upload the not-for-profit certificate issued by government competent authority - The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority - The institution has filled information of Chairman/president, Treasurer and Secretary with PAN & Aadhar no. only. It is required to mention PAN & Aadhar no. of all Society members. - The institution is required to should provide proof that all khasara number i.e. Kh. VT shall also check/ verify student list year-wise (I,II,III,IV), functional website uploaded with mandatory disclosure documents, Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Fire Safety Certificate with requisite approved Plot Area by Govt. authority and all Building & land related documents i.e. Certified Registered Land documents, Mutation Certificate, Land Use Certificate (CLU), Non-Encumbrance Certificate, check the approved Building Plan, approved Site Plan showing contiguity of plots, conform that the land reserved for each course run within the institution's premises and the demarcated construction area for teacher education programmes including multidisciplinary programmes should be mentioned;

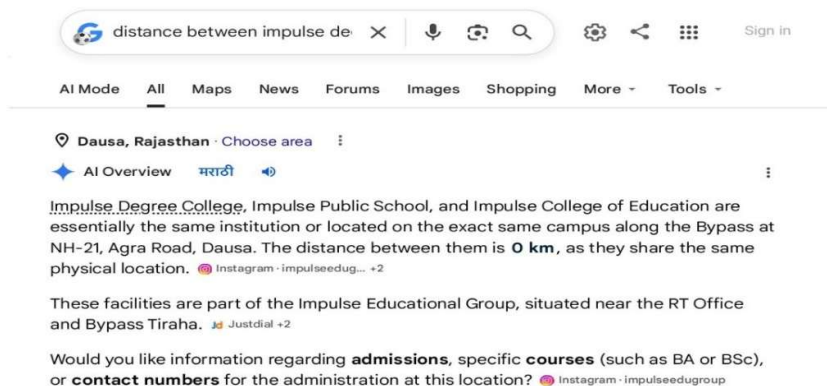

x.	The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
xi.	The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3, Activity cum resource centre, Health and Physical Education Room, Faculty rooms, Administrative Office Space, Common Room, Store Room, sports room and playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph
xii.	The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx .
xiii.	The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
xiv.	The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
xv.	The institution is required to upload the legible land documents copy of Khasara Numbers. 210/161,211/162 The institution is required to upload the Land related affidavit as per details filled in the online application portal
xvi.	The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Arese (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority
xvii.	The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
