III. अध्यक्ष की अनुमति से, श्रीमती रश्मि शुक्ला एवं श्री विजय राणा, क्षेत्रीय निदेशक व संयोजक, पश्चिमी क्षेत्रीय समिति ने समिति के समक्ष कार्यसूची प्रस्तुत की। प्रत्येक कार्यसूची पर मदवार निर्णय निम्नानुसार है:-

Decision of WRC: The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, and the Committee observed as under: - The committee noted that RK B.ED. College, Ram Nagar, Rawate Compound, Tembepada Road, Bhandup (W), Mumbai-78, Maharashtra was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. of one year duration for 100 intakes vide order dated. 29.01.2008. Thereafter, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations 2014, Revised Recognition order was issued to institution for two units (100 intake) on 06.10.2015. - The Show Cause Notice issued to the institution vide No. WRC/APW03737/123434/MH/2016/ 180607-608 dated 21.02.2017 for compliance of the conditions mentioned in the Revised Order. - The institution has not submitted the requisite documents mentioned in the Show Cause Notice Therefore, Withdrawal Order vide No. WRC/APW03737/ 123434/ 311th/2019/206761-206767 was issued to the institution on 11.10.2019. - Against the above decision of WRC, the institution has submitted Court Order passed by Delhi High Court dated 24.01.2020 W.P.(C) 13922/2019 & CM APPL. 55790/2019, wherein the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has directed as under:- <i>"(6) Accordingly, the impugned order dated 11.10.2019 passed by the WRC is set aside.</i> <i>(7) The petitioner is granted two weeks to file a reply to the SCN upon a copy of the same being supplied to it by the respondents. The respondents will furnish a copy of the SCN dated 21.02.2017 within one week of receipt of a copy of the order passed today.</i> <i>(8) The WRC will reconsider the matter after giving due opportunity of hearing to the authorized representative of the petitioner.</i> <i>(9) The WRC will pass, thereafter, a speaking order; a copy of which will be furnished to the petitioner."</i> - Accordingly, as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court, the institution was requested to attend the personal hearing on 22.07.2020, however it did not attend the same. The institution was again requested to be present on 10.09.2020 for personal hearing through virtual mode, however, it did not attend the same. - Thereafter final show cause notice was issued to institution on 05.03.2025 for the deficiencies observed by WRC. The institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 25.05.2025 which was considered by the WRC in its 427th meeting held on 12th- 13th June 2025 and as per the decision of WRC, show cause notice to the institution for the deficiencies was issued on 23.07.2025. - The reply submitted by the institution was considered by WRC 462nd meeting held on 03rd to 4th June 2026 and the committee noted the following deficiencies. - The list of teaching staff submitted by the institution is neither approved by the affiliating body and nor in the NCTE prescribed format available on official website of WRC. - The affidavits on Rs.10 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of individual teaching faculty are not submitted by the institution.			

- iii. The institution has not submitted the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Govt Authority.
 - iv. The institution has submitted stability report dated 13.01.2024 issued by Private Chartered Engineer instead of Building Safety Certificate. The institution has not submitted Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
 - v. The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Maharashtra verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Maharashtra.
 - vi. The institution has not submitted Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Competent Government Authority.
8. In view of the above, the WRC decided that the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed course be withdrawn u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the date of issue of order. As per the decision of WRC, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 16.06.2026.
 9. The institution preferred an appeal before the Appellate Authority and the Appellate Authority passed an Order dated 27.07.2026 wherein the Appellate Authority has set aside the impugned order dated 16.06.2026 and remanded back the matter to the Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration and re-examination in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), subject to the directions contained herein.
 10. The Appellate authority has also directed the institution to forward the documents submitted in appeal to the WRC within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order. The institution vide letter dated 31/07/2026 submitted the Appeal Order dated 27/07/2026. However, the institution has not submitted the documents presented by it before Appeal Committee as mentioned in the Appeal Order.
 11. The institution has also filed a writ petition W.P.(C) 11129/2026 & CM APPL. 51502/2026 SIDDHIVINAYAK SHIKSHAN PRASARK MANDAL'S R.K. B.ED. COLLEGE dated 06.08.2026. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 06.08.2026, has been pleased to pass the following directions:

"7. The WRC is directed to issue an order of restoration of recognition within a period of 2 days from today, which will govern the rights and contentions of the parties, unless fresh withdrawal order is passed by the WRC.

8. The petitioner will be permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students from the academic session 2026-27 onwards, till the time a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it.

9. The status of petitioner as a recognized institution will also be reflected on the official website of respondents/NCTE and will be communicated by the NCTE to petitioner's affiliating body as well as to the concerned department of the State Government forthwith.

10. The petition is disposed of in the above terms."

In view of the above, the WRC after through deliberation decided the following :-

- 1. In accordance with the decision of Appellate Authority and directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 06.08.2026, the recognition for the B.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 100 students.**

2. The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance.
3. Show Cause Notice (after Appeal) be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity to submit the documents submitted in Appeal within 15 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice, so as to enable WRC to take decision in the matter.
