Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the Committee observed as under:

- The institution is recognized for D.El.Ed. (P.T.C.) course with annual intake of 50 students vide order dated 28.10.2006/28.02.2007 in a rented premises.
- Show Cause Notice dated 12.01.2012 is issued to the institution with direction to shift to its new own premises within three years in compliance to provisions of NCTE Regulations.
- The institution has informed vide letter dated 25.01.2012 that it has shifted to own building in the year 2009, which has been constructed in the year 2007. As the institution on its own has shifted to new location without prior approval of WRC, same is not acceptable.
- Letter seeking clarification to comply deficiencies is issued dated 18.12.2012.
- Application for shifting of premises along with documents is submitted on 25.12.2012 without requisite fee and related complete documents.
- For non-receipt of requisite documents for shifting, its application for shifting is rejected and recognition for D.El.Ed. (P.T.C.) course is withdrawn vide order dated 10.08.2013.
- Appeal filed against withdrawal order is confirmed vide Appellate Authority order dated 13.01.2014.
- Being aggrieved, institution has filed writ petition SCA No.3040 of 2014 before the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat. The petition is allowed by Hon'ble Court, which passed Oral Judgement dated 12.03.2015 mentioning that the impugned orders dated 10.08.2013 and 13.01.2014 are quashed and set aside and the proceedings are remanded back at the stage of show cause notice dated 12.01.2012. It is also directed by the Hon'ble Court that after paying amount of inspection fees within seven days from the date of intimation by the Council, the Committee of the Council shall consider the aspect of inspecting the new building that has been constructed by the petitioner while dealing with the show cause notice and after hearing the petitioner, shall pass a fresh order as provided under Section

17 of the Act stating the reasons and the Committee shall also communicate the said order to the petitioner at the known address. The Council shall take an appropriate decision on merits. It is also mentioned in the court order “*The learned advocates appearing for the parties have submitted that in light of the impugned orders, the institute of the petitioner trust is not imparting any education in PTC course and hence, till the best decision is taken by the respondent authorities, as observed in this judgment, the same position shall continue.*”

- ix. Remaining inspection fees is submitted vide letter dated 01.05.2015, and amount deposited in NCTE Accounts dated 07.05.2015.
- x. Show Cause Notice dated 21.05.2015 is issued to the institution to comply deficiencies mentioned therein.
- xi. In reference to admission process of PTC course scheduled in the month of September, 2025, status sought vide letter dated 10.09.2025 by Directorate of Primary Education, Govt. of Gujarat, matter is considered in 443rd WRC meeting held on 18th-20th December, 2025, accordingly, Show Cause Notice under Clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 is issued to the institution dated 03.03.2026 giving 15 days time to submit reply/ supporting documents by the management of the institution.
- xii. Reply of SCN is submitted vide letter dated 11.03.2026 by the institution.
- xiii. The institution requested vide letter dated 21.07.2026 to update its recognition status on NCTE website.
- xiv. Being aggrieved, the petitioner institution filed another writ petition W.P.(C) 11593/2026 & CM APPL. 53642/2026 titled ‘RIDDHI EDUCATION TRUST vs. NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION & ANR.’ before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi in connection with issuance of order of restoration of recognition for D.El.Ed.(PTC) course with intake of 50 seats (one basic unit) and remove the withdrawal order dated 10.08.2013 from official website of respondent and Hon’ble Court disposed the petition, and passed order dated 13.08.2026, the operative part of court order is as under:-

“...9. In view of the above, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the present petition by directing the respondent No. 2 to issue an order of restoration of recognition in respect of D.El.Ed (PTC) course with intake of 50 seats (one basic unit) within a period of one week from today, which will govern the rights and contentions of the parties, until and unless fresh withdrawal order is passed by the respondent No. 2.

10. The petitioner shall be permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students for the academic session 2026-27 and also subsequently, till the time a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it.

11. The status of petitioner as recognized institution shall also be reflected on the official website of respondents alongwith an order of restoration of recognition and shall also be communicated by WRC to petitioner’s affiliating body as well as to concerned department of the State Government of Gujarat within one week.

12. The withdrawal order dated 10.08.2013 with the remark “withdrawn” as being reflected presently on the website of respondent shall be removed forthwith.

13. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.”

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In pursuance of directions passed vide order dated 13.08.2026 by Hon’ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for D.El.Ed.(P.T.C.) course with annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) in respect of institution viz. Riddhi Education Trust, Himatnagar Riddhi P.T.C. College, Gaddhada, 13, Motibaug Society, Motipura, Himmatnagar, Dist. Sabarkantha, Gujarat- 383001 be restored w.e.f. 13.08.2026 i.e. date of issuance of Court Order in W.P.(C) 11593/2026 & CM APPL. 53642/2026 till the fresh withdrawal order is passed against the institution. Copy of restoration order be endorsed to all others concerned. A copy of restoration order shall be uploaded on the NCTE website by displaying the correct status of the institution.

Further, the Committee observed the institution is still deficient for compliance of the following in consonance with provisions contained in NCTE Act, Norms and Regulations, 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time:

- i. Land related affidavit is not submitted in prescribed format and Registered land documents is not submitted by the institution.
- ii. Another shifting application dated 11.03.2026 for shifting of premises is submitted mentioning proposed shifting address:- Plot No. 3, 2J & 4 Riddhi Education Campus, Motipura, Himarnagar.
- iii. Affidavit regarding decision of the management for shifting of premises is not submitted.
- iv. NOC issued by State Govt. of Gujarat regarding proposed shifting of premises is not submitted.
- v. Submitted Building Plan is not approved by competent Govt. authority and wherein the name of the course and with the measurements of the Multipurpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms and other amenities etc. are not reflected.
- vi. Latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances is not submitted.
- vii. Submitted copy of site plan for S. no. 14/2 & Plot no. 3 & 2J, Ta. Motipura, Himmatnagar, Dist.Sabarkantha, Gujarat approved by Maitri Engineer, Motipura, Himatnagar which is Not verified by competent Govt. authority.
- viii. Disabled friendly certificate issued by competent Govt. authority is not submitted.
- ix. Submitted Building Completion Certificate is not in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) and not issued by the Competent Government Authority mentioning all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- x. Photocopy of faculty list comprising (01 Principal + 08 Lecturers) certified by the management is submitted which is not in NCTE prescribed proforma and not approved by the affiliating body. The latest approved faculty list in original in NCTE prescribed proforma countersigned by affiliating body along with copy of letter granting approval of each faculty by the concerned affiliating body is required to submit by the institution.
- xi. FDRs towards Endowment Fund of Rs. 5 Lakh and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 Lakh as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 is not maintained. Form “A” in original issued by concerned Bank Manager with office seal is not submitted.

- xii. Website of the institution (<https://riddhiedu.org>) is not maintained and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i) 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. Clear and legible downloaded copies covering relevant information uploaded on institutional website are not submitted.

In view of the above, Committee decided as under:-

Final Show Cause Notice under Clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 be issued to the institution to submit reply supported with requisite certified documents along with affidavit by the management of institution within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. Reply submitted by the institution be placed for consideration of WRC.
