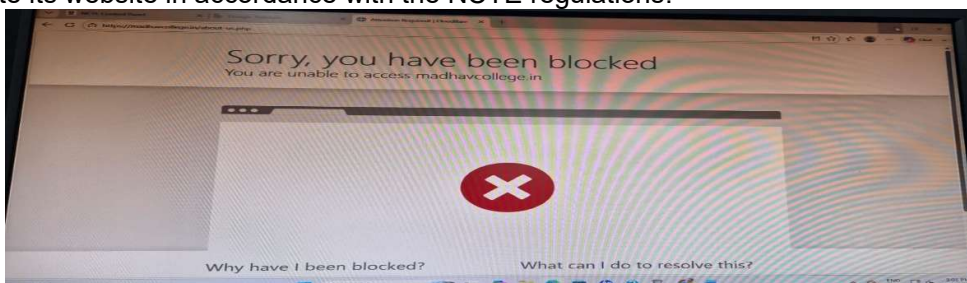

Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Remand Back Case from appellate authority- SCN After appellate authority-Reply of first SCN after appeal Order, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Even at the time of this scrutiny, the institution's website (<https://madhavcollege.in/about-us.php>) remains inaccessible. Consequently, it is impossible to determine whether the website has been duly updated and maintained in compliance with the provisions of Clauses 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14), and 10(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution is required to update its website in accordance with the NCTE regulations.



- ii. In its online application, the Riddhi Siddhi Sanstha cited Khasra number 3258/2125 and claimed ownership of the land, yet it attached documents pertaining to Khasra number 2436/2125, including a Deed of Gift dated May 11, 2015, as evidence. However, in its response to the appeal, the Sanstha submitted documents—specifically a Freehold Institutional Lease Deed (No. 21441, dated September 19, 2022)—relating to Khasra number 3258/2125. It is incumbent upon the Sanstha to clarify, with supporting evidence, which of these documents represents the actual land records. The institution is required to upload the legible land documents copy of all Khasara Numbers. The institution is required to upload the Land related affidavit as per details filled in the online application portal.
- iii. As stated in the land details, the institution possesses a land area of 5,000 sq. m., as mentioned in the affidavit. And the Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) 4511. This area is insufficient for the following courses: B.A. ($560 \times 3 = 1680$), B.Sc. ($360 \times 3 = 1080$), M.A. ($15 \times 2 = 30$), M.Sc. ($25 \times 2 = 50$), and the 4-year integrated degree course of B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. ($100 \times 4 = 400$). The total number of students is 3,240; therefore, a built-up area of 4,511 sq. m. is inadequate for 3,240 students.
- iv. In its online application, the organization had declared the building's construction area as 4,511 sq. m. However, the Building Completion Certificate indicates an area of 7,984.07 sq. m. for the structure spanning from the basement to the second floor. The organization needs to clarify the source of this substantial additional construction. Furthermore, the building plan uploaded by the organization is not an approved one; while the plan references Khasra No. 3258/2125 (with the old Khasra No. 2436/2125 in parentheses), the construction area is stated as 3,857.69 sq. m. Several questions arise regarding the actual extent of the construction, the correct Khasra number, and the nature of the title (i.e., whether it is held via a lease or a gift deed). It does not appear that the Appeal Committee considered these points while delivering its decision. The institution is required to upload Building Plan

v.	The organization has stated in its online application that it possesses a total land area of 5,000 sq. m. and a built-up area of 4,511 sq. m. However, while the organization holds a Fire NOC in the name of 'Riddhi Siddhi Sansthan', it covers a plot area of only 1,495 sq. m. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate of proper land issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx .		
vi.	The uploaded building safety certificate does not contain any mention of the institution's Khasra number, built up area or the address of the building or college . The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority		
vii.	The Institution is required to upload the Authorization letter on the stamp paper as per admissible government rate.		
viii.	The institution is required to upload the Noc of affiliating body no 8572 dated 26/06/2018 as mentioned in the portal.		
ix.	The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.		
x.	In the column of Society/Trust/Company members information, the institution has filled information of Chairman/president/Secretary and treasurer with PAN & Aadhar no. only, It is required to mentioned all Society members with PAN & Aadhar No.		
xi.	The Institution is required to upload information of all programme/courses run by institution in the campus and the institution is required to upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.

Additionally, to verify whether the institution pays its employees in accordance with UGC or State Government norms, the institution should also attach the salary account statements of its employees for the past one year.		
xvi.	The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph. The institution is required to submit information, supported by evidence, regarding the number of washrooms available for students (male and female) and staff (including those with disabilities), as well as the provision of common hand-washing areas equipped with taps.		
xvii.	The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3, the number of Classrooms are available for multidisciplinary programm and ITEP programme, other infrastructure facilities, playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.		

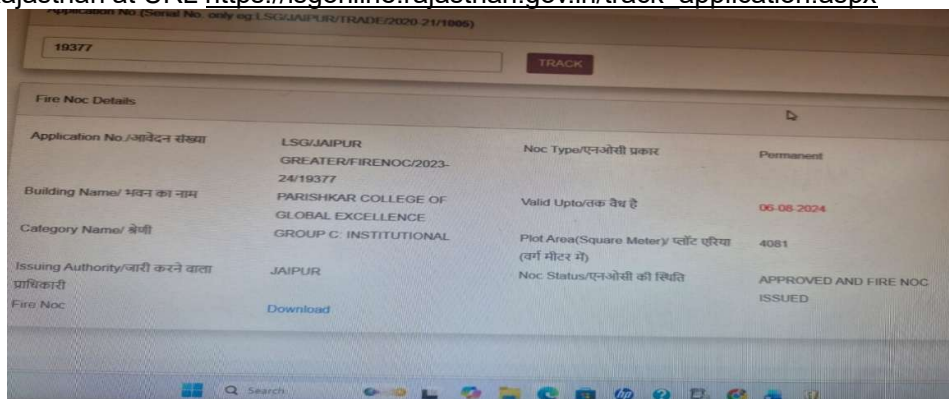

Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Remand Back Case from appellate authority- SCN After appellate authority-Reply of first SCN after appeal Order, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

As per directed by Appellant Authority, the appellant institution is required to deposit the prescribed processing fee in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 (as amended). ii. The institution is required to upload the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. iii. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for Merger are affiliated with the same university, as required under Clause 4.2(ii) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. iv. The proposal for ‘merger’ between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
