Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the Committee observed as under:

- The institution is recognized for B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 01.07.2005.
- Revised order dated 10.05.2015 is issued for B.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 200 students (four basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- Show Cause Notice u/S 17 is issued dated 26.03.2018 for compliance of conditions of Revised Recognition order.
- Second show cause notice u/S is issued dated 07.11.2020 and reply has not been submitted by the institution.
- Matter of verified complaint against the institution was considered by WRC in its 426th meeting held on 3-5 June, 2025. As decided by Committee, final Show Cause Notice dated 23.07.2025 was issued for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.
- Reply of final Show Cause Notice was considered by WRC in its 438th (Part-II) Meeting held on 13th-16th October, 2025 and as decided by Committee, last final Show Cause Notice u/S 17 is issued dated 17.02.2026.
- Reply of last final SCN was considered by WRC in its 462nd Part-III meeting held on 3-4 June, 2026. As decided by Committee, recognition for B.Ed. course is withdrawn vide order dated 23.07.2026 on the grounds mentioned therein.
- Being aggrieved, the petitioner institution filed W.P.(C) 10827/2026 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Order dated 03.08.2026 passed by Hon'ble Court, the operative part of court order is as under:

"...6. Having considered the submissions of the parties, I am of the view that, in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, the controversy can be appropriately resolved by directing respondent No.2/Western Regional Committee ("WRC") to

reconsider the petitioner's case after taking into account both the replies dated 07.04.2026 and 20.05.2026 and thereafter pass a fresh, reasoned order in accordance with law.

7. Since a fresh decision has been directed to be taken, the impugned withdrawal order dated 23.07.2026 cannot be permitted to survive and is accordingly set aside, with all consequential benefits flowing in favour of the petitioner. This order is being passed in the peculiar facts of the present case without examining the merits of the rival contentions and only to ensure that the controversy is resolved expeditiously, particularly as the admission process is presently underway and the petitioner is a running educational institution.

8. In view of the aforesaid and as an interim arrangement pending fresh consideration by respondent No. 2, the petitioner shall continue to be treated as a recognised institution. Respondent No. 2 shall accordingly issue a restoration order in favour of the petitioner in respect of the B.Ed. course with an intake capacity of 200 seats, reflect the petitioner's status as a duly recognised institution on its official website, and communicate the same to the concerned State Authorities as well as the affiliating body. The aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of three days from today.

9. The aforesaid directions have been issued in the light of the principles enunciated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Vaishnav Institute of Technology (Supra).

10. In light of the above, the present petition stands disposed of."

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In pursuance of directions passed vide order dated 03.08.2026 by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 200 students (four basic units of 50 students each) in respect of institution viz. Tilak Teachers Training College (For Women), Vishvesariya Nagar, Triveni Nagar, Gopal Pura Bye Pass, Jaipur-302014, Rajasthan be restored. Copy of restoration order be endorsed to all others concerned. A copy of restoration order shall be uploaded on the NCTE website by displaying the correct status of the institution.

Further, the Committee observed the following:

As directed by Hon'ble Court, the representation dated 07.04.2026 already considered by WRC in its 462nd Part-III meeting held on 3-4 June, 2026 together with another representation dated 20.05.2026 of the institution are examined afresh in light of NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines issued from time to time. The institution is still deficient for compliance on the following:

- i. The institution is required to submit Building Plan mentioning Khasra no., total land area, total built up area approved by Govt. Architect/Engineer/Govt. competent authority earmarked for each course being run in the premises and demarcated land area and built-up

- area for all recognized teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes (if any), as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- ii. The institution is required to submit site plan showing contiguity of all plots used for various Teacher Education courses got recognition from NCTE and other courses, if any approved by competent Govt. authority.
 - iii. The institution is required to submit latest Building Completion Certificate in prescribed format of NCTE indicating details of total land area, total built up area earmarked for all recognized teacher education programmes with name of course vis-à-vis other courses running in the same campus certified by the competent Government Authority.
 - iv. The institution is required submit approved faculty list for D.El.Ed. in NCTE prescribed proforma countersigned by affiliating body.
 - v. Faculty list submitted comprising 01 Principal/HoD + 27 faculties (without mentioning course name), which is not duly approved/ countersigned by the concerned Affiliating University and not in the NCTE prescribed proforma, therein it is mentioned "File submitted to UOR for approval awaited (except Principal-Approved by UOR Approval No.शैक्षणिक दितीय/2015/763 dated 15.07.2015).
 - vi. The institution is required to submit approved faculty list for M.Ed. course countersigned by Affiliating University.
 - vii. As per letter of reply dated 07.04.2026 submitted by the institution, staff approval is under process and approval has been sought from the Affiliating University i.e. University of Rajasthan. Copy of complete document in this regard is required to submit by the institution.
 - viii. Being recognized, the website of the institution has not been maintained and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, Committee decided as under:-

Show Cause Notice under Clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply supported with requisite certified documents along with affidavit by the management of institution within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. Reply submitted by the institution be placed for consideration of WRC.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is recognized for B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 01.03.2007.

- ii. Revised order dated 31.05.2015 is issued for B.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- iii. For non-compliance of conditions mentioned in the revised recognition order, as per decision of WRC, Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) is issued dated 25.09.2017 followed by letters of communication dated 22.06.2018 and 05.02.2019.
- iv. Final show cause notice u/S 17(1) is issued dated 07.04.2021 and no reply is received from the institution.
- v. Matter was considered by WRC in its 415th meeting held on 10th to 12th March, 2025, wherein Committee decided that recognition for B.Ed. course be withdrawn on the following grounds:

"A letter of the university regarding staff profile of the appointed staff for B.Ed. course along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution has not replied Final Show Cause Notice dated 07.04.2021 so far. Meanwhile, the university namely Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University has sent approved faculty list vide letter No. Aca/Affi/5244/2024 dated 24.12.2024 which is deficient with the following:

- *All faculties are appointed on 28.05.2024 and faculties of Pedagogy/ies are without NET & Ph.D. qualification as prescribed by NCTE.*
- *Principal is not appointed.*
- *Faculties are appointed with conditionally approval of the countersigned by the Registrar of Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan, Gujarat, which is not as per Clause-5 of Appendix-4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014, together with provisions of Point No. 8 of GOI No. 237 dated 09.06.2017 and submitted staff list is not in the prescribed format of NCTE."*

- vi. Being aggrieved, the petitioner institution filed W.P. (C) 10043/2025 & CM APPL. 41764/2025 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Order dated 17.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble Court, the operative part of court order is as under:

*"...(8) In view of the above, it is directed that operation of the impugned decision taken by WRC in its 415th meeting whereby recognition of petitioner's institution was withdrawn, shall remain stayed during the pendency of petitioner's appeal before the Appellate Committee. Consequently, the respondent no.2/WRC is also directed to update its website reflecting that status of petitioner's institution as recognized institution.
(9) The petition alongwith pending application is disposed of in the above terms.
(10) Needless to say that all concerned authorities including affiliating University will take cognizance of updation of petitioner's status on the website of the NCTE pursuant to the instant order."*

- vii. In pursuance of Court order dated 17.07.2025, a Public Notice dated 08.08.2025 is displayed on website stating the status of institution as recognised for B.Ed. course during the pendency of the petitioner's appeal before the Appellate Committee.
- viii. Appeal preferred by the institution has been dismissed vide Appellate Authority order dated 22.04.2026, thereby no relief is granted to the appellant institution.
- ix. Being aggrieved the institution filed writ petition, the matter was listed on 19.08.2026. The e-mail dated 19.08.2026 received from standing counsel Shri Mohinder J S Rupal, the operative part of E.mail is as under:-

"The captioned matter was listed today for hearing.

...After hearing submissions from both sides, the Hon'ble Court has directed that the documents attached by the Petitioner - Institution in the writ petition shall be considered afresh by the WRC, and the WRC, after considering these, shall pass a reasoned order within a period of 7 days from today. Further, the Hon'ble Court has directed that the minutes of the 415th meeting dated 10th-12th March, 2025, and the Appeal Order dated 22.04.2026 are set aside, and in view of this, the WRC shall grant "consequential benefits" to which the Petitioner - Institution is entitled.

The matter stands disposed of with the above directions.

In view of the above, I request you to consider the documents attached in the writ petition and decide afresh the case of the Petitioner - Institution within the time prescribed by the Hon'ble Court. Please find attached the copy of the writ petition for your kind consideration and perusal."

The outcome of the hearing as under :-

"After hearing submissions from both sides, the Hon'ble Court has directed that the documents attached by the Petitioner - Institution in the writ petition shall be considered afresh by the WRC, and the WRC, after considering these, shall pass a reasoned order within a period of 7 days from today.

Further, the Hon'ble Court has directed that the minutes of the 415th meeting dated 10th-12th March, 2025, and the Appeal Order dated 22.04.2026 are set aside, and in view of this, the WRC shall grant "consequential benefits" to which the Petitioner - Institution is entitled.

The matter stands disposed of with the above directions.

In view of the above, I request you to consider the documents attached in the writ petition and decide afresh the case of the Petitioner - Institution within the time prescribed by the Hon'ble Court."

Further, on consideration of direction of Hon'ble Court as stated above, the Committee observed that the institution is deficient on the following grounds:

- i. The institution is required to submit its salary disbursement record and information sent to bank in respect of appointed faculties from the date of their appointment.
- ii. The institution has not appointed requisite qualified faculties as per NCTE norms and regulations as amended from time to time.
- iii. The institution is required to submit original staff profile/approved faculty list for the academic session 2026-2027 in prescribed proforma of NCTE countersigned by Affiliating University.
- iv. The institution is required to maintain and update its website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time and submit proof of its downloaded copies along with reply.

In view of the above, Committee decided as under:-

Show Cause Notice under Clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply supported with requisite certified documents along with affidavit by the management of institution within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. Reply submitted by the institution be placed for consideration of WRC.
