राष्ट्रीय अध्यापक शिक्षा परिषद की पश्चिमी क्षेत्रीय समिति (WRC) की 473 बैठक 01-03 सितंबर, 2026 को हाइब्रिड मोड से आयोजित की गई।

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III. अध्यक्ष की अनुमति से, श्रीमती रश्मि शुक्ला, क्षेत्रीय निदेशक व संयोजक, और विंग कमांडर विजय राणा, क्षेत्रीय निदेशक व संयोजक पश्चिमी क्षेत्रीय समिति ने समिति के समक्ष कार्यसूची प्रस्तुत की। प्रत्येक कार्यसूची पर मदवार निर्णय निम्नानुसार है:-

Decision of WRC:

This matter was considered by WRC in its 471st meeting held on 18th – 20th August 2026 and the Committee decided the matter in the light of the inputs provided by the NCTE panel counsel. Meanwhile the Court order is uploaded, wherein the Hon'ble court has directed as under:

"9. Accordingly, the WRC is directed to reconsider the case of the petitioner in view of the additional documents/ compliances filed by the petitioner. The needful shall be done by the respondents within 1 week days from today.

10. Since the matter is being remanded back to the WRC for reconsideration, the impugned orders are accordingly set aside.

11. As the impugned orders have been set aside, the consequential benefits including issuance of order of restoration (as per the judgment of Arihant College & Anr. v. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr., W.P. (C) 7260/2021) shall ensue to the benefit of the petitioner.

12. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms along with pending applications, if any."

Further, the file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the Committee observed as under:

- The institution is recognized for B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 01.03.2007.
- Revised order dated 31.05.2015 is issued for B.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- For non-compliance of conditions mentioned in the revised recognition order, as per decision of WRC, Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) is issued dated 25.09.2017 followed by letters of communication dated 22.06.2018 and 05.02.2019.

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- iv. Final show cause notice u/S 17(1) is issued dated 07.04.2021 and no reply is received from the institution.
- v. Matter was considered by WRC in its 415th meeting held on 10th to 12th March, 2025, wherein Committee decided that recognition for B.Ed. course be withdrawn on the following grounds:

"A letter of the university regarding staff profile of the appointed staff for B.Ed. course along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution has not replied Final Show Cause Notice dated 07.04.2021 so far. Meanwhile, the university namely Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University has sent approved faculty list vide letter No. Aca/Affi/5244/2024 dated 24.12.2024 which is deficient with the following:

- vi. *All faculties are appointed on 28.05.2024 and faculties of Pedagogy/ies are without NET & Ph.D. qualification as prescribed by NCTE.*
- vii. *Principal is not appointed.*
- viii. *Faculties are appointed with conditionally approval of the countersigned by the Registrar of Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan, Gujarat, which is not as per Clause-5 of Appendix-4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014, together with provisions of Point No. 8 of GOI No. 237 dated 09.06.2017 and submitted staff list is not in the prescribed format of NCTE."*
- ix. Being aggrieved, the petitioner institution filed W.P. (C) 10043/2025 & CM APPL. 41764/2025 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Order dated 17.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble Court, the operative part of court order is as under:

*"... (8) In view of the above, it is directed that operation of the impugned decision taken by WRC in its 415th meeting whereby recognition of petitioner's institution was withdrawn, shall remain stayed during the pendency of petitioner's appeal before the Appellate Committee. Consequently, the respondent no.2/WRC is also directed to update its website reflecting that status of petitioner's institution as recognized institution.
(9) The petition alongwith pending application is disposed of in the above terms.
(10) Needless to say that all concerned authorities including affiliating University will take cognizance of updation of petitioner's status on the website of the NCTE pursuant to the instant order."*
- x. In pursuance of Court order dated 17.07.2025, a Public Notice dated 08.08.2025 is displayed on website stating the status of institution as recognised for B.Ed. course during the pendency of the petitioner's appeal before the Appellate Committee.
- xi. Appeal preferred by the institution has been dismissed vide Appellate Authority order dated 22.04.2026, thereby no relief is granted to the appellant institution.

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- xii. Being aggrieved, the petitioner institution filed W.P.(C) 12002/2026 & CM APPL. 55696/2026 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Order dated 19.08.2026 passed by Hon'ble Court, as mentioned in para 1 above: -

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

The Committee decided that its decision in 471st meeting of WRC is required to be modified as per the above directions of the Hon'ble court.

In pursuance of directions passed vide order dated 19.08.2026 by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units of 50 students each) in respect of institution viz. Shri Dr. Ratilal Kanjibhai Patel and Shri Kantibhai Patel B.Ed. College, Khasra No – 84/2, Hadas, Danta, Near Shriram Cement Factory Quarters, Near Water Tank, District Banaskantha, Gujarat-385110, be restored. Copy of restoration order be endorsed to all others concerned. A copy of restoration order shall be uploaded on the NCTE website by displaying the correct status of the institution.

Further, on consideration of direction of Hon'ble Court as stated above, the Committee observed that the institution is deficient on the following grounds:

- The institution is required to submit its salary disbursement record and information sent to bank in respect of appointed faculties from the date of their appointment.
- The institution is required to submit original staff profile/approved faculty list for the academic session 2026-2027 in prescribed proforma of NCTE countersigned by Affiliating University.
- The institution is required to maintain and update its website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time and submit proof of its downloaded copies along with reply.

In view of the above, Committee decided as under: -

Show Cause Notice under Clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply supported with requisite certified documents along with affidavit by the management of institution within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. Reply submitted by the institution be placed for consideration of WRC.

<u>Decision of WRC:</u>			

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The matter was considered by the WRC in its 425th Meeting held on 29th to 30th May 2025, (APW02555/222122/D.El.Ed.), (APW04970/225058/M.Ed.) & (APW00623/223165/B.Ed.) wherein the Committee decided as under:

"The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time the Committee observed as under:

The WRC noted that the Appeal Committee vide its Order dated 04.10.2021 set aside WRC withdrawal order dated 18.12.2020. The WRC had issued the First Show Cause Notice dated 26.05.2022. No reply submitted by the institution to the First Show Cause Notice. The recognition of the institution was restored vide order dated 10.04.2024 and Final Show Cause Notice dated 12.04.2024 issued to the institution and reply submitted by the institution vide letter dated 23.04.2024 was found deficient on the following grounds:

- i. *The institution has submitted a copy of letter dated 07.10.2008, mentioning therein that it has shifted to its own premises from rental building. However, the letter dated 07.10.2008 along with the documents submitted thereto, are not available in the Physical and e-file of the institution.*
- ii. *As per letter dated 07.10.2008 of the Society of the institution, it informed that the society had shifted building of the institution into its own premises without the permission of WRC, NCTE.*
- iii. *As per record, D.Ed. and M.Ed. courses granted recognition in the name of T.D. D.Ed. College and B.Ed. course in the name of T.D. Education College at the same premises, address and location.*
- iv. *B.Ed. course of the institution shifted to new location/address/premises without the permission of WRC, NCTE.*
- v. *Inspection of the institution u/s-17 of NCTE Act, 1993 as amended from time to time was conducted between 15.04.2009 to 20.04.2009 for B.Ed. course. However, it has emerged from the inspection that the institution is conducting B.Ed. courses in the name of T.D. Education College at Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh and it is conducting D.Ed. (D.El.Ed.) and M.Ed. courses in the name of T.D. D.Ed. College at Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh. Further, it is noted that both the institutions are functioning from the same premises and at the same location/address.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that recognition granted to (a) T.D. Education College, Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh for B.Ed. course and (b) T.D. D.Ed. College for D.Ed. (D.El.Ed.) and M.Ed. courses be withdrawn u/S – 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned."

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC withdrawal order No. NCTE/CF-52357/APW00623/223165/B.Ed./425th/2025/7810-15 dated 14.10.2025.

The institution has filed court case vide W.P. No. 13859, 13948 & 13953 for B.Ed., M.Ed. & D.Ed. courses.

The Counsel for NCTE vide mail dated 31.08.2026 has informed the following: -

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"The captioned matters were listed today for hearing. We had sent two emails dated 09.04.2026, requesting for detailed instructions along with the relevant documents in order to enable us to file our counter affidavits in the present matters. However, till date, we have not received any communication/email from your end. Today, these matters were taken up for hearing and, as per the limited instructions received in this matter, we opposed and submitted that, in the present case, the Petitioner-College shifted its premises without seeking permission from the WRC and, therefore, the WRC was justified in withdrawing the recognition of the College. The Hon'ble Court, after examining the documents on record, observed that the WRC wrongly withdrew the recognition of the courses (B.Ed / D.El.Ed / M.Ed) which were running at "Chakghat" while examining the file of the College which was located in "Indira-Nagar". The Court further observed that the inspection conducted by the NCTE between 15.04.2009 to 20.04.2009 was wrongly made the basis for the withdrawal of recognition, as the institution was running its courses even after 2009 and the WRC raised no objection at that point of time. In view of the observations made by the Hon'ble Court, the Court was pleased to set aside the Minutes of the 425th meeting held on 29th-30th May, 2025 and has directed the WRC to restore the recognition of the Petitioner-College for the (B.Ed / D.El.Ed / M.Ed) with all consequential benefits. The Hon'ble Court has further directed that the recognised status of the Petitioner-College shall be communicated to the affiliating university and to the concerned department of the State Government within 1 week from today. The matter stands disposed of with the above directions. This is for your kind information and necessary action."

In view of the above, the WRC after through deliberation decided the following: -

- i. In accordance with the decision of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order in W.P. No. 13859, 13948 & 13953, the recognition for the B.Ed., M.Ed. and D.Ed. course is restored.
- ii. The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance.
- iii. The adherence of Norms and Standards for the B.Ed., M.Ed. and D.Ed. course is required to be ascertained by the WRC in its subsequent meetings.
