Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of University for the 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme ITEP programme B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), for the session 2027-28 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the University were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- Since applicant University is state public university established by the Government of Rajasthan the following documents are required to be uploaded/ submitted:-
(a) The document in respect to the programme applied for is fully funded by the State Government concerned.
(b) In case, the application for the recognition of the proposed programme is on self-finance based, the document in respect to the programme applied for is on self-finance basis the institute is required to upload statutory resolution passed by the executive body of the university alongwith NOC duly issued by respective State Government Concerned.
(c) In case the applied programme is not covered under expenses born by public fund the application fee is to be remitted to NCTE. (As per the provision of NCTE Rules, 1997)
