Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

In this case, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi disposed of the case vide order dated 17.12.2025 in W.P.(C) 19172/2025 with following directions:-

"1. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the Respondents to consider its representation and update/correct/rectify the details and documents of the Institution as shown/available in the list of recognised institutions maintained by Respondent No.2 on its website qua Petitioner's PTC (D.EL.Ed) course.

2. Issue notice.

3. Mr. Mohinder J.S. Rupal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents and, on instructions, submits that the representation dated 22.08.2025 will be decided within a period of three weeks from today and necessary steps will be taken in accordance with law.

4. Submission made by Mr. Rupal is taken on record. The decision will be taken within three weeks as assured. Needless to state that, if any, further formalities are required to be complied with by the Petitioner due intimation shall be sent so that necessary steps can be taken by the Petitioner. In case of any surviving or further grievance, Petitioner will be at liberty to take recourse to legal remedies.

5. Writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms."

In light of directions passed by Hon'ble Court, representation dated 22.08.2025 of the institution along with related records of institution were examined and Committee noted that the institution was granted recognition for P.T.C. Course of two years duration with annual intake of 50 vide order dated 07.11.2003 followed by permission was granted for P.T.C. Course with two years duration with annual additional intake of 50 vide order dated 13.05.2005, second additional intake of 50 vide order dated 10.01.2008 and third additional intake of 50 vide order dated 15.01.2008, thus total intake 200 (four units).

(1) In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In pursuance of directions passed vide Order dated 17.12.2025 by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the status of recognition for P.T.C. Course of the institution be updated on NCTE website uploading all recognition/permission orders issued to the concerned institution.

(2) Further, the Committee decided that the institution be asked to submit compliance on the following documents supported with an affidavit certified by the management of institution:

- (i) The institution is required to submit documents in respect of its land and building located in its existing premises wherein recognition was granted by NCTE for P.T.C. course certified by the management of institution.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit certified copy of Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit certified copy of Site Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit the latest list of teaching staff in prescribed format for the recognized period of P.T.C. course in original countersigned by the Affiliating /Examining Body as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Gujarat verifiable on its official portal.
- (vi) The institution is required to submit certified Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (vii) The institution is required to submit certified latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (viii) The institution is required to submit certified Mutation Certificate and certified land documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (ix) The institution is required to submit latest certified Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for recognized course being conducted in the premises.
- (x) The institution is required to submit certified Land Use Certificate mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (xi) The institution is required to submit Form 'A' in original issued by Bank Manager of the concerned bank along with copies of valid FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Fund in joint operation mode in reference to Clause 10 (1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- (xii) Downloaded copies related to updating and maintaining of institutional website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (xiii) Certified documents related with status of affiliation in respect of P.T.C. course in respect of institution issued by affiliating body.

- (xiv) The institution is required to upload information of all programme/courses run by institution in the campus and the institution is required to upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.
- (xv) The institution is required to submit the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff certified by the management of institution.

Show Cause Notice under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to comply fulfilment regarding deficiencies pointed above supported with an affidavit within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. On receipt of reply from the institution, the same be placed before the WRC.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- i. This institution viz. Idial Institute of Education (Run by Guru Aanchal Sansthan) is recognised by WRC for D.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2009-2010 at, Khasra No.232, Posti Khana, Fort Road, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh vide Order No.WRC/5-6/109th/2008/45436 dated 22/27.10.2008.
- ii. The institution submitted application for shifting of premises vide letter dated 29.07.2016 received in WRC NCTE on 03.08.2016.
- iii. As per the decision taken by WRC in its 260th Meeting held on 13th to 15th October, 2016, the Visiting Team for shifting of premises of the institution was constituted.
- iv. The Visiting Team Report was considered by WRC in its 283rd meeting held on 14th to 15th November 2017 and accordingly, SCN dated 17.11.2017 was issued to the institution. The reply to SCN submitted vide letter dated 19.04.2018 received on 20.04.2018 was considered by WRC in its 297th meeting held on 13th to 14th September, 2018 and accordingly, letter was issued to the institution dated 19.09.2018 to comply certain documents mentioned therein.
- v. In response, the institution submitted reply vide letters dated 28.11.2018, 02.01.2024 and 14.06.2024 alongwith copy of FDRs Rs. 2+2 Lakhs.
- vi. The institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 13.11.2025 in the context of court order dated 23.12.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.
- vii. The Committee noted that the institution filed a Writ Petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, and the Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) 19562/2025 passed Order dated 23.12.2025 with the following decision:

"1. These writ petitions are filed on behalf of the Petitioners under 226 of the Constitution of India for a direction to Respondent No. 2/Western Regional

Committee ('WRC') to consider and decide the pending applications of the Petitioners for shifting their premises in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsels for the Petitioners submit that Petitioner in W.P.(C) 19560/2025 had preferred an application for shifting the premises on 08.05.2019 but the same is pending consideration till date. Similar grievance is made in W.P.(C) 19562/2025 with respect to application dated 02.12.2013.

3. Issue notice.

4. Mr. Mohinder J.S. Rupal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents and on instructions, fairly submits that WRC shall decide the pending applications within two months from today since an inspection will be required to be conducted before the decision is taken.

5. Accordingly, these writ petitions are disposed of directing WRC to decide the pending applications dated 08.05.2019 and 02.12.2013 within two months from today, in accordance with law. Needless to state, it will be open to WRC to conduct inspection of the new premises if so required. The decisions will be communicated to the Petitioners within one week from the date the decisions are taken and it will be open to the Petitioners to take recourse to legal remedies in case of any grievance."

The Committee decided that the institution is required to submit the following documents supported with an affidavit by the management within 15 days for consideration of Committee so as to take further decision on its application for shifting of premises:-

- i. **The list of teaching staff duly approved by competent authority of concerned Affiliating Body.**
- ii. **The FDRs of Rs.12.00 lakh towards Endowment Fund (7.00 lakh) and Reserve Fund (5.00 lakh) in joint operation mode between the institution/society and Regional Director of WRC(NCTE) together with Authorization letter Form 'A' in original issued by the concerned bank.**

The institution be informed accordingly.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is recognised by WRC for B.Ed. course of one year duration vide orders dated 16.10.1998, 29.09.2000, 10.03.2006 followed by revised order dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).
The institution is recognized by WRC for M.Ed. course of one year duration vide orders dated 29.07.2008, 12.01.2011 followed by revised order dated 16.10.2015 for M.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 50 students (one unit).

- ii. Recognition for B.Ed. course was withdrawn vide withdrawal order dated 21.06.2016.
- iii. Restoration order dated 07.09.2018 for B.Ed. course was issued to the institution.
- iv. The application for shifting of premises of B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses dated 08.05.2019 was submitted by the institution received in WRC, NCTE on 14.05.2019.
- v. Matter was considered by WRC in its 314th Meeting, wherein the Committee observed that this is a case of RPRO and Shifting of Premises for B.Ed. & M.Ed. Programme. Recognition was granted on 29.09.2000 and 29.07.2008. Revised Recognition Order was issued on 31.05.2015 with certain conditions. The institution has not submitted the compliance of the Revised Recognition Order. Accordingly, SCN dated 06.08.2020 was issued to the institution.
- vi. Reply submitted in response to SCN received in WRC office on 31.08.2020 was considered by WRC in its 322nd meeting and as per decision of the Committee, recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed course was withdrawn from the academic session 2021-2022 vide Withdrawal Order dated 17.12.2020.
- vii. The institution filed writ petition W.P. 4623/2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh and Order dated 09.03.2021 was passed by Hon'ble Court to consider the appeal preferred by the institution within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the appeal.
- viii. Appeal preferred by institution against the withdrawal order was remanded back vide Appellate Authority Order dated 31.01.2025 with a direction to revisit the case in totality and also to check that the institution fulfil all the criteria of norms & standards for the land & building where the recognition was granted by the WRC as per applicable rules & regulations and decision shall be taken accordingly. Appellant institution is required to forward the documents submitted in Appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of appeal committee.
- ix. In compliance to decision of the Appellate Authority, letters dated 08.02.2025 and 17.02.2025 were submitted by the institution received on 18.02.2025 & 06.03.2025 respectively.
- x. Matter was considered by WRC in its 425th meeting held on 29th-30th May, 2025, accordingly SCN u/S 17(1) pointing out certain deficiencies was issued vide letter dated 05.07.2025.
- xi. Institution has filed writ petition W.P.(C) 10343/2025 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and order dated 21.07.2025 was passed by Hon'ble Court. Accordingly, matter was considered by WRC in its 431st meeting held on 28th-31st July, 2025 and in pursuance of order dated 21.07.2025, as decided by Committee, Restoration Order dated 07.08.2025 for B.Ed. course was issued to the institution.
- xii. As also decided by the Committee in its 431st meeting, the reply of the show cause notice dated 05.07.2025 pointing out deficiencies mentioned therein issued to the institution has not been received. Therefore, this matter shall be taken up again in the next meeting.
- xiii. In reference to restoration order, TEI has submitted a representation vide letter Ref. No. KMV/B.Ed./1821/A dated 13.08.2025 received on 21.08.2025 in the context of grant of permission for shifting of premises specifying the appellate authority order dated 31.01.2025.
- xiv. In response to SCN dated 05.07.2025, reply submitted by the institution vide letter Ref. No. KMV/1822/WRC/14825 dated 14.08.2025 received on 21.08.2025 enclosing certain documents.
- xv. Reply of SCN submitted by institution vide letter dated 13.08.2025 received on 21.08.2025
- xvi. The institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 19560/2025 seeking relief in respect of its application submitted for shifting of premises and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 23.12.2025.

xvii. The Committee noted that the institution filed a Writ Petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, and the Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) 19560/2025 passed Order dated 23.12.2025 with the following decision:

"1. These writ petitions are filed on behalf of the Petitioners under 226 of the Constitution of India for a direction to Respondent No. 2/Western Regional Committee ('WRC') to consider and decide the pending applications of the Petitioners for shifting their premises in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsels for the Petitioners submit that Petitioner in W.P.(C) 19560/2025 had preferred an application for shifting the premises on 08.05.2019 but the same is pending consideration till date. Similar grievance is made in W.P.(C) 19562/2025 with respect to application dated 02.12.2013.

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Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is recognised by WRC for B.Ed. course of two years duration vide order dated 31.01.2017 with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2017-2018.

- ii. The institution is recognized by WRC for D.El.Ed. course of two years duration vide order dated 30.01.2017 with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 each).
- iii. The application for shifting of premises of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses dated 08.11.2020 was submitted by the institution received in WRC, NCTE on 11.11.2020.
- iv. Matter was decided in 329th meeting of WRC held on 17th-19th February, 2021 to constitute Visiting Team for shifting of premises.
- v. Inspection was conducted on 21.03.2021 & 22.03.2021, VT report was received on 23.03.2021.
- vi. Matter was considered in 336th meeting of WRC held on 24th-25th March, 2021, accordingly SCN dated 15.04.2021 was issued to the institution for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.
- vii. Reply of SCN submitted by the institution vide letter dated 05.04.2022 received on 18.04.2022 was considered in 400th meeting of WRC held on 13th February, 2024, accordingly Final SCN dated 28.02.2024 was issued to the institution for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.
- viii. Reply of Final SCN submitted by institution vide letter dated 12.03.2024 received on 15.04.2024 was considered in 408th meeting of WRC held on 12th-14th November, 2024, wherein Committee decided to submit approved building plan and building completion in prescribed proforma within 21 days. On the basis of uploaded minutes on website, institution submitted vide letter dated 06.12.2024 received on 11.12.2024 along with certain documents.
- ix. Matter was considered by WRC in its 413th meeting held on 27th-29th January, 2025. The Committee decided that one more processing fee of Rs.1.5 lakh + 18% GST is required to submit by the institution for further action on its shifting of premises application.
- x. Reply submitted by institution vide E.mail dated 05.05.2025 stating that it has already depositing processing fee Rs.1.5 lakh toward shifting application of composite course B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. followed by letter dated 13.11.2025 received on 20.11.2025.
- xi. Letters of complaint dated 22.09.2025, 30.09.2025 against the institution received on 01.12.2025 and 07.11.2025 from Madhyamik Shiksha Mandal, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal along with copy of its previous letter dated 29.10.2025 recommending for withdrawal of recognition for D.El.Ed. course on the grounds of submission of forged documents diversion document and forged Building Completion Certificate.
- xii. Another letter of complaint date 14.05.2025 along with affidavit dated 04.05.2025 against the institution was received for taking action in respect of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses.
- xiii. The institution vide its letter dated 27.12.2025 received on 29.12.2025 followed by E.mail dated 21.01.2026 enclosed a copy of court order dated 23.12.2025 in W.P.(C) 19577/2025 titled Prashi Shiksha Mahavidyalaya vs. NCTE & Anr passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi as filed by the institution in connection with consideration of its application for shifting of premises.
- xiv. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)19577/2025 passed Order dated 23.12.2025 with the following directions:-
 1. *"This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-
(a) quash the decision taken by the Respondent No.2 in its 413th meeting held on 27-29.01.2025, whereby it has sought "one more processing fee", from the petitioner, in*

addition to one already submitted by it, for processing of its application seeking shifting of premises; and

(b) direct the respondent no.2 to consider & decide the pending application of the petitioner institution submitted for shifting of its premises, from existing, to new; expeditiously & preferably within two weeks' time."

2. *Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that Petitioner preferred an application for shifting the premises on 07.11.2020 but the same is pending consideration till date. It is further urged that decision taken by Western Regional Committee ('WRC') in its 413th meeting held on 27-29.01.2025 be quashed being illegal, whereby additional processing fee has been sought from the Petitioner.*

3. *Issue notice.*

4. *Mr. Mohinder J.S. Rupal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents and submits that the pending application for shifting of premises will be decided within two months from today after carrying out inspection of the premises where shifting is proposed. He, however, takes objection to the submission that double processing fee is being charged and submits that Petitioner is under a misconception that B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. are integrated courses.*

5. *In light of the submissions made by the parties and without going into the merits, this writ petition is disposed of directing WRC to decide the pending application dated 07.11.2020 within two months from today, in accordance with law. Needless to state, it will be open to WRC to conduct inspection of the new premises, if so required. The decision will be communicated to the Petitioner within one week from the date the decision is taken. Insofar as the issue of processing fee is concerned, a reasoned decision will be taken by WRC within four weeks from today and communicated to the Petitioner. Needless to state if aggrieved, Petitioner may take recourse to legal remedies on both aspects."*

Further, the Committee noted that the Special Task Force, Government of Madhya Pradesh is conducting an investigation against the institution for submission of forged document to obtain the recognition and affiliation for conducting teacher education programmes. The Committee also noted that the office of Madhyamik Shiksha Mandal, Bhopal vide their letter dated 22.09.2025 has informed that STF Gwalior Branch has registered an FIR vide No. 07/2024 under Section 420, 468,471 and 120B of IPC, which is under investigation.

In light of the above facts, the Committee decided that the direction of Hon'ble Court may be apprised to the Special Task Force, Gwalior and Madhyamik Shiksha Mandal, Bhopal to obtain the status of investigation for compliance of direction of the Hon'ble Court.
