Decision of WRC:

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

1. The online application was submitted on 05.03.2024 by institution (Bansur Mahavidhyalaya) pertains to year 2024 bearing Application No.2526202402061063 for consideration of transition from 4 years Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP programme for the academic session 2025-2026.
2. A reasonable opportunity u/S 14(3)(b)/15(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993 was given to the institution in the form of Show Cause Notice dated 05.01.2025 through online portal pointing out following deficiencies mentioned therein.
3. The reply of SCN was submitted on 25.01.2025 through online portal by the institution.
4. As per decision taken by the General Body of the Council in its 65th meeting, Public Notice vide F.No.NCTE-Regl012/18/2024-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 6th May, 2025 was issued by NCTE, extending timeline for transition of 4-year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. into ITEP before the start of the academic session 2026-2027 instead of academic session 2025-2026 and further allowed all the institutions recognized by NCTE under the omitted Appendix-13 of NCTE Regulations 2014 prior to its omission to enrol the students in B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. in the academic session 2025-2026.
5. Subsequently, following decisions have been taken by the General Body of the Council in its 67th GB meeting and circulated through Public Notice F.No.NCTE-Regl012/7/2025-Reg.Sec-HQ dated 12th September, 2025 in the matter of opening of online portal for transition applications giving final opportunity to the following category of institutions:
 - (i) The final opportunity be provided to all such TEIs including those institutions of which applications were refused/rejected by giving an opportunity to apply afresh online on NCTE Portal. Those institutions which have earlier submitted Transition in response to NCTE Public Notice dated 05.02.2024, may be exempted from making payment of processing fee, subject to specifying mentioned the registration number of the earlier application submitted.
 - (ii) The portal be opened as above and public notice be issued with direction to all recognized existing TEIs offering B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. course (Prior to omission of the Appendix-13) to apply afresh except the institution which have either been already

transited into ITEP or have been issued Letter of Intent (LOI) by the Regional Committee concerned.

(iii) The application of those institutions which do not fulfil the criteria of multidisciplinary institution shall be summarily rejected by the Regional Committee.

6. As per decision of the NCTE General Body, online transition application portal was again kept open by NCTE for the concerned institutions to submit application (2026-2027) through online mode from 15.09.2025 to 05.10.2025 (till 11:59 PM) as mentioned in NCTE public notice dated 12.09.2025. As per records, the institution (Bansur Mahavidhyalaya) has not submitted through online transition application portal (2026-2027) within the extended timeline fixed by NCTE.
7. The institution has already been permitted by NCTE to admit students in 4 years Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for the academic session 2025-2026.
8. While the online transition application portal has been open for the academic session 2026-2027, the decisions taken by WRC at any stage of online transition application applied pertaining to session 2025-2026 (except decision taken, if any in respect of applications for grant of Recognition/permission to ITEP as well as LOI cases of 2025-2026) are not considerable.
9. The institution has filed writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Hon'ble Court passed order dated 12.01.2026 in W.P.(C) 19683/2025, the operative part of Court order is as under:

"...5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, I am inclined to allow the petition and direct that the application dated 05.03.2024 be decided by the respondents expeditiously and in any case, on or before 31.01.2026. The application shall be decided on merits and after hearing the petitioner.

6. Needless to state that in case the decision is not in petitioner's favour, the petitioner will be entitled to challenge the same.

7. The petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms."

In view of the above, the Committee, after thorough examination and deliberation, decided that to challenge the order dated 12.01.2026 in W.P.(C) 19683/2025 titled Bansur Mahavidhyalaya & Anr. vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The decision of WRC shall accordingly be forwarded to the concerned Division/ Department of NCTE for further necessary action.

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

1. The online application was submitted on 04.10.2025 by institution (TAK SHIKSHA NIKETAN SAMITEE) pertains to year 2025 bearing Application No.2627202509243195 for consideration of transition from 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP programme for the academic session 2026-2027.

2. On initial scrutiny of application, it is observed that the institution does not fulfill the basic criteria to run the ITEP programme.
3. The Committee decided that the institution does not fulfil the basic criteria as per NCTE Public Notice vide No.NCTE-Reg1012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025. Hence, application has been rejected on the grounds of not eligible for processing as mentioned through online transition application portal vide Refusal order dated 14.11.2025.
4. The institution filed writ petition and the Hon'ble Court disposing the writ petition in W.P.(C) 18213/2025 has passed an order dated 01.12.2025, the operative part of the court order is as under:

“...7. There is no gainsaying that any order that visits a person or an entity with civil consequences must pass muster of compliance with principles of natural justice. Petitioner applied on 04.10.2025 for transition of its four years B.A. B.ED./B.SC. B.ED. course to Integrated Teacher Education Programme, pursuant to NCTE Public Notice dated 12.09.2025. The application was considered by the Regional Committee in its 439th Meeting held on 29th - 31st October, 2025, wherein a decision was taken to reject the application. Perusal of the refusal order dated 14.11.2025 does not indicate compliance of Proviso to sub-Section (3)(b) of Section 14 of NCTE Act. Clearly, the impugned order is in violation of the mandatory statutory provision and cannot be sustained on this short ground.

8. Accordingly, without going into the merits of the case, this writ petition is allowed to a limited extent of setting aside impugned order dated 14.11.2025 on the ground that it was passed without affording reasonable opportunity to the Petitioner to make a written representation. It will be open to the Respondents to issue a show cause notice to the Petitioner pointing out the deficiencies/objections, if any and calling upon the Petitioner to respond to the same. Petitioner shall submit a written representation/reply to the show cause notice within two weeks from the date of receipt and after considering the representation/reply, Respondents shall pass a fresh order, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks thereafter. In case the Petitioner is aggrieved by the decision, it will be at liberty to take recourse to legal remedies.

9. Writ petition stands disposed of making it clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.”

In view of the above, the Committee, after thorough examination and deliberation, decided that to challenge the order dated 01.12.2025 in W.P.(C) 18213/2025 titled Tak Shiksha Niketan T.T. College vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The decision of WRC shall accordingly be forwarded to the concerned Division/ Department of NCTE for further necessary action.
