**Decision of WRC:**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. As per the decision of WRC, Final Show Cause Notice (SCN) was issued to the institution vide letter No. F.No.NCTE/WRC/2627202510013554/MADHYA PRADESH/2025/SCN dated 06/02/2026 with a request to upload its reply along with all requisite supporting documents within 07 days from the date of issue of the Final Show Cause Notice (SCN), on the following points. The institution has not uploaded any representation/ reply to the Final Show Cause Notice, hence, the deficiencies observed in the Final Show Cause Notice still persists.
  - a. The Institution has not uploaded the category of Institution in the institution details.
  - b. The Institution has not uploaded the Authorization letter on the stamp paper as per admissible Government rate.
  - c. The institution has not uploaded the NOC of affiliating body vide letter No.F/AFFILIATION/2025/561 dated 30/05/2025 as mentioned in the portal.
  - d. Till this date, the website of the institution is not functional. The website is required to be functional and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the website as per NCTE norms and regulations.
  - e. The institution has not uploaded the complete details of Society/Trust/Members with Aadhar and PAN number issued by the Competent Government Authority.
  - f. The Institution has not uploaded information of all programme/courses run by institution in the campus and the institution is required to upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.
  - g. The institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
  - h. The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and land area issued by Competent Government Authority.
  - i. As per the land details Column, land area mentioned by the institution is 7850 sq.mts. and built-up area 3647sq.mts. whereas in the CLU land area is 4180.637 sq.mts. The land area is mismatch.
  - j. The institution has not uploaded Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
  - k. The institution has not uploaded Affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper in prescribed format regarding land documents. The institution is required to upload certified land document with mentioning Khasra No.7/7,7/8 and 10/2 issued by the Competent Government Authority.
  - l. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the

- total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- m. The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
  - n. The institution has not uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.
  - o. The institution has not uploaded geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilets indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
  - p. The institution has not uploaded the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmes duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
  - q. The institution has not uploaded geotag photos with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3 and playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
  - r. The institution has not uploaded latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) mentioning all Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
  - s. The institution has expressed its intention to become a multidisciplinary institution through collaboration, as stipulated in the NCTE Guidelines for transforming NCTE recognized stand-alone teacher education institutions into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
  - t. For confirming the institution's eligible for transition into ITEP course as it is Collaboration institution is required to upload the affiliation order of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with intake capacity as a MultiDisciplinary Institution.
  - u. The proposal for collaboration between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. The institution is required to upload the approval of the University.
  - v. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence confirming that 'Aditya College of Tech. Science and Education' and 'MPS Shiksha Mahavidhyalaya', are situated within the radius of 10 Kilometers, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
  - w. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Madhya Pradesh justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
  - x. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for collaboration are affiliated with the same university. The institution is required to upload the same.
  - y. The institution is not running multi-disciplinary courses in the field of liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, commerce or mathematics as per Regulation No.NCTEReg1011/80/2018-MS(Regulation)-HQ dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Reg1012/7/2025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 related with extension of timeline to existing recognized teacher education institutions for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to ITEP before the start of academic session 2026-27. The institution does not fall in the category of multidisciplinary institution.

**In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

**Decision of WRC:**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. As per the decision of WRC, Final Show Cause Notice (SCN) was issued to the institution vide letter No. F.No. NCTE/WRC/2627202509202994/RAJASTHAN/2025/SCN dated 03/02/2026 with a request to upload its reply along with all requisite supporting documents within 07 days from the date of issue of the Final Show Cause Notice (SCN), on the following points. The institution has not uploaded any representation/ reply to the Final Show Cause Notice, hence, the deficiencies observed in the Final Show Cause Notice still persists.
  - a. Since TEI has uploaded the softcopy of the letter forwarded to Commissioner, Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Rajasthan, it is mandatory to upload the approval as per Clause 4.2.1 of guidelines of NCTE.
  - b. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
  - c. The institution has not uploaded documentary evidence that both institutions proposed for Merger are affiliated with the same university, as required under Clause 4.2(ii) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
  - d. The institution has not uploaded the 'Fresh certificate of merger' issued by the Registrar of Societies as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions. The institution is required to upload the same. TEI is required to upload the duly valid documents of merger of institutions.
  - e. TEI is required to upload all such documents of merger of the institutions.
  - f. The Institution is required to upload the category of Institution in the institution details through online portal.
  - g. The website www.suyash.ac.in of the institution is not functional. The website is required to be functional and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - h. The Institution is required to upload the Authorization letter on the stamp paper as per admissible government rate.
  - i. The institution is required to upload the NOC of affiliating body vide letter no.1869 dated 30/06/2023 as mentioned in the portal. The institution is required to clarify the same why they uploaded the old NOC.
  - j. The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
  - k. In lieu of exemption certificate 12A, copy of acknowledgement receipt dated 02.03.2024 of Income Tax Form 10A submitting application for registration or provisional registration or intimation or approval or provisional approval is uploaded by the institution. The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
  - l. In the column of Society/Trust/Company members information, the institution has filled information of Chairman/president/Secretary and treasurer with PAN & Aadhar no. only. It is required to mention all Society members with PAN & Aadhar No. The institution has not provided the details of students admitted to the ongoing programmes, and the required supporting documents have not been uploaded. The institution is required to

- upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University.
- m. The institution claimed that both programmes run in same campus. The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. 80x3=240, B.Sc.60x3= 180, BCA 40x3=120. The sufficiency of land area and built-up area for the above courses with of multidisciplinary courses and intake for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), course cannot be ascertained.
  - n. The institution is required to upload the Land related affidavit as per details filled in the online application portal.
  - o. The institution is required to upload Mutation (Jamabandi) Certificate mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
  - p. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority
  - q. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
  - r. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes
  - s. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmes duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff
  - t. The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
  - u. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx). The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
  - v. The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3 and playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
  - w. The institution is required to submit the demarcated site plan duly approved by the competent authority of the state government earmarking the land & built-up area for ITEP course and other courses/ school being run in the premises.
  - x. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.

**In view of the above, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for transition of existing B.A. B.Ed / B.Sc. B.Ed into ITEP be refused u/s 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

**Decision of WRC:**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- ii. The institution has not uploaded a certificate to the effect that the proposal for collaboration between the institutions has been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- iii. The website is required to be maintained and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time.
- iv. Khasra no.70, 71 mentioned in the portal, whereas in the recognition order dated 27.07.2016 for B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. course, plot no.NA is mentioned.
- v. Authorization letter on the stamp paper as per admissible government rate showing name of the authorized person as per portal is not uploaded.
- vi. Letter of NOC vide No.8376 dated 25.04.2017 issued by Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati University as per portal is not uploaded.
- vii. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- viii. The institution has not uploaded the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- ix. The Institution is required to upload information of all programme/courses run by institution in the campus and the institution is required to upload year-wise the admitted students list in respect of all running programme(s) countersigned by Affiliating University
- x. For confirming the institution's eligible for transition into ITEP course as it is Collaboration institution is required to upload the affiliation order of liberal arts, science and commerce all programmes run by them with approved intake capacity and present intake capacity as a Multi-Disciplinary Institution.
- xi. In the column of Society/Trust/Company members information, the institution has filled information of Chairman/president/Secretary with PAN, without Aadhar no. and without mentioning the validity of their membership. The institution is required to upload the complete details of all Society/Trust/Members with Aadhar and PAN number issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- xii. The institution is required to should provide proof that all khasara number i.e. Kh. No 70,71 are a single plot, upload a proof issued by government competent authority. The institution is required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government showing that the building is situated on a single plot.
- xiii. In the Land Details Built Up area mentioned in the Affidavit (in sq m) is 6507. If the institution is running various teacher education programme/ courses in the same campus/premises i.e. Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree 4 units, Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) 1 unit. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for the above courses with of and intake for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), Middle (2 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), Middle (2 unit), course cannot be ascertained
- xiv. Certified registered land document (sale deed) in respect Khasra no.70 (Area 2 bishwa) and 71 (Area 6 bigha) dated 31.07.2003 is uploaded without land affidavit showing total land area, total built up area, possession of land, owner of land etc. permission to use land for educational purpose etc. in NCTE prescribed proforma. required to upload the same.
- xv. In respect of Mutation certificate, a copy Jamabandi (Khatoni) for land khasra no.70 and 71 (Total Area 1.80 Hectare) certified by Patwari dated 29.09.2003 is uploaded. required to upload the same.
- xvi. CLU in respect of land khasra no.70, 71 for educational purpose issued by competent authority is not uploaded. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.

- xvii. NEC issued by competent authority in respect of land khasra no.70, 71 is not uploaded. required to upload the same
- xviii. Total land area and total built up area earmarked for each running teacher education programme in the campus is not reflected in the uploaded building plan. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government (with date) mentioning the name and correct address of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- xix. In the address, 'Pathanon ka Badh' is mentioned which is not reflected in the recognition order for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course.
- xx. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate pertaining to the institution applied for transition to ITEP Programme issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx).
- xxi. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xxii. Information regarding availability of lift and electricity as a part of basic criteria for the institution's campus, building, furniture etc barrier free/Accessible is not uploaded.
- xxiii. BCC certified by Assistant Engineer, Didwana is without date. Name of teacher education course with total land area and total built up area earmarked for teacher education programme is not reflected in the BCC. Second floor area is mentioned in BCC, which is not found reflected in the building plan. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- xxiv. Electricity connection no. is not reflected in BCC.
- xxv. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmed duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff
- xxvi. As per uploaded building plan, only basement floor, ground floor, first floor built up area of building is mentioned, however in the portal, in addition, second floor constructed area (11500 sq.mts.) mentioned. The institution is required to clarify this discrepancy.
- xxvii. The institution is required to upload geotag photos of institution's building with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3 and playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
- xxviii. The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph

**Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution u/s 14 (3) (b)/ 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 7 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.**

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and

documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee decided as under:

- i. The institution has not uploaded the Mutation Certificate issued by the Competent Revenue Authority.

- ii. Journals and encyclopaedias are also not available in sufficient numbers, limiting access to updated knowledge, research materials, and comprehensive reference sources.
- iii. In the Library, the number of book titles and total books is insufficient for the Teacher Education Programme, which affects academic reference and study resources for students and faculty.
- iv. The Language Laboratory is currently not available in the institution, which limits opportunities for students to develop essential communication and language skills.
- v. Faculty Room for Teaching staff is not provided with writing tables, just chairs are provided
- vi. Common Room not provided.
- vii. The Language Laboratory is currently not available in the institution, which limits opportunities for students to develop essential communication and language skills.
- viii. The Multipurpose Hall has very limited seating capacity, which is insufficient for conducting seminars, workshops, and large academic gatherings effectively.
- ix. The Ramp facility is inadequate, as it lacks proper railings and has a very short and steep pathway, making it unsafe and unsuitable for students with disabilities.
- x. The Toilet facilities are not disability-friendly. There are no support/holding bars installed, and the entrance has a small barrier, which restricts easy access for differently-abled students.
- xi. Staff recruitment eligibility criteria and salary structure must strictly adhere to NCTE and UGC norms to maintain academic standards and institutional credibility.
- xii. All laboratories should be made fully functional with adequate equipment and regular maintenance to ensure effective practical learning.

The institution is required to upload latest Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government (with date) mentioning the name and correct address of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
- xxii. The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xxiii. The institution is required to upload the list of teaching staff of all Education Faculty Programmed duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body. The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff
- xxiv. On verification of information filled from online portal, the Plot Area mentioned in the Fire Safety certificate bearing no.47642 is 4900 sq.mts, whereas the land area mentioned in the application form is 8000 sq.mts. Both land area mismatch.
- xxv. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate pertaining to the institution applied for transition to ITEP Programme issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL [https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track\\_application.aspx](https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx).
- xxvi. Information regarding availability of electricity as a part of basic criteria for the institution's campus, building, furniture etc barrier free/Accessible is not mentioned in the portal.
- xxvii. As per filled information in the portal, Building Completion Certificate being land KHASRA NO 1370 CHANDRESAL POST ARJUNPURA has been approved by Sarpanch, Ladpura, Kota dated 20.05.2008. The institution has not uploaded the BCC as per information provided. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) with details filled therein issued by the Competent Government Authority mentioning course wise earmarked total land area and total built up area, name of the course, being run in the premises.

- xviii. The institution is required to upload geotag photos with different angles of Lift, Ramp, Electricity, Safe Drinking Water and Accessible Toilet indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
- xxix. The institution is required to upload geotag photos of institution's building with different angles of front view, rear view, multipurpose hall, library, lab 1, lab 2, lab 3 and playground indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.

**Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution u/s 14 (3) (b)/ 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 7 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Reply to Final Show Cause Notice, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by government competent authority.
- ii. Institution has uploaded Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) dated 15.02.2024 and dated 03.02.2025. The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- iii. As per Building Completion Certificate issued by the Assistant Engineer, Jhunjhunu dated 23.05.2025 wherein the institution has uploaded BCC point no. 16 "total land area earmarked for teacher training programme for B.A. B.Ed. B.Sc. B.Ed. is 2500 sq. mtr. it is not sufficient as per NCTE Norms and Regulation and also not earmarked for each course being run in the premises and total land and built-up area is not mention uploaded Building Completion Certificate.
- iv. The institution is required to upload documentary evidence confirming that all the multidisciplinary and teacher education programs are conducted in a single campus and in the same premises.
- v. The institution is required to upload the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- vi. The self-declaration of the institution regarding efficiency of the Society/Trust/Company members information is not endorsed by the Competent Authority of the State Govt. The institution is required to upload the Society/Trust/Company members information, the institution has filled information of Chairman/president/Secretary and treasurer with PAN & Aadhar No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- vii. As per the institution has uploaded Building plan wherein the Column of mentioned in the Building plan total land area 8301.65 sq. mtr. total land area 7684.21. The institution has mentioned Land area 121400 sq.mts. and built-up area 7684.21 sq.mts. whereas in the Building Plan Column land area is 8301.65 sq.mts. Both the land area is mismatch. The institution is required to clarify the same.
- viii. As per the building plan and BCC uploaded, The institution has earmarked part of the same building for ITEP course and Degree college. The same is not as per clause 6.1(b) of NCTE Regulation 2021, which clearly specifies "*The institution shall earmark 3000 sqm of well demarcated land for the initial intake of fifty students and 2000 sqm shall be the demarcated built up area .....*"
- ix. *The uploaded building plan is not proper.* The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area. But earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.

- x. Regarding SCN Point No. 5, the institution has uploaded Fire Safety Certificate bearing no. LSG/MANDAWA/FIRENOC/2025-26/52554 dated 02.06.2025 in the name of "RAMADEVI MAHILA P.G. MAHAVIDYALAYA" approved by issued by Fire Safety Officer, Nagar Palika-Mandawa valid up to 01.06.2027 and stated that "According to SCN the uploaded fire safety certificate is issued for built up area of academic block which is 6170 square meters whereas the total land area is 121400 square meters. so the built-up area only (6170) equipped with fire instruments.
- xi. The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. intake 240x3=720, B.Sc. intake 300x3=900, BCA intake 40x3=120, B.Com intake 60x3=180, M.A. intake 360x2=720, M.Com. intake 80x2=160, M.Sc. intake 200x2=400 combined intake of 3200. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 3200 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 100 x4=400 intake for B.A.B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) course cannot be ascertained since the institution has mentioned the total built-up area 7684.21 sq.mts. out of which the entire built-up area is earmarked for the teacher education programme as per the BCC is uploaded by it. No built area is earmarked for teacher education,
- xii. The website of the institution has not been compliance as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 of para 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) as amended from time to time. The institution is required to update the website as per NCTE regulations.
- xiii. The list of teachers has been approved by the University vide Academy-Staff/2016/1635 dated 17/03/2018. But NCTE has recognised the applicant college as per NCTE 288<sup>th</sup> meeting 2018 recognition letter order 97393 dated 23 September 2018. The recognition list of teachers is before NCTE recognized the applicant college.
- xiv. The institution has not uploaded the list of teaching staff duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE and teaching staff should be as per NCTE norms.
- xv. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- xvi. The uploaded documents are not proper. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-II of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- xvii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xviii. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms. furniture in the multipurpose hall is inadequate.
- xix. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the college does not have adequate playgrounds and sports facility.
- xx. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.

**Therefore, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution u/s 14 (3) (b)/ 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 7 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.**

- ii. The proposal for 'merger' between the institutions has not been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.2.2 of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into multidisciplinary higher education institutions.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- iv. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.
- v. The website has not to be functional and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- vi. As per the building plan and BCC uploaded, The institution has earmarked part of the same building for ITEP course and Yogeshwar College. The same is not as per clause 6.1(b) of NCTE Regulation 2021, which clearly specifies "*The institution shall earmark 3000 sqm of well demarcated land for the initial intake of fifty students and 2000 sqm shall be the demarcated built up area .....*"
- vii. As the institution is running the Yogeshwar College in the same campus, the institution has not submitted the demarcated site plan duly demarcating the land area for the existing College course and the proposed ITEP course. The institution is required to demarcate the land and built up area as per the Guidelines issued by the Government of Rajasthan for (निजी महाविद्यालय नीति) available on <https://hte.rajasthan.gov.in/dept/dce/uploads/doc/NOCpolicy202122.pdf>
- viii. The uploaded upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) is not in the prescribed format of Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- ix. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- x. The institution has uploaded the list of teaching staff duly approved and countersigned by its affiliating body the nomenclatural of Teaching staff is Lecturer in the prescribed format of NCTE. The nomenclatural of teaching staff is not as per NCTE regulation 2014 and as amended till date.
- xi. The geotagged photographs uploaded show that the seating capacity of Library reading room is not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
- xii. Computer labs and ICT related facilities are not visible in the uploaded geotagged photographs.
- xiii. The uploaded geotagged photographs show that furniture is not available in the multi-purpose hall, and the Multipurpose Hall is not as per NCTE norms.

**Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

In terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the online application of institution for transition from B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. The institution has not uploaded the certificate issued by the Government of Rajasthan justifying the requirement for a teacher education programme in the area, as required under Clause 4.3(i) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions. The institution is required to upload the same.
- ii. The institution has not uploaded a certificate to the effect that the proposal for collaboration between the institutions has been approved by their affiliating university, as required under Clause 4.3(a) of the NCTE Guidelines for transforming into Multidisciplinary Institutions.
- iii. The institution has not uploaded the Land Use Certificate (CLU) as per Rajasthan Urban Areas (Permission for use of Agricultural Land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and Allotment) Rules, 2012 in Form-11 of Rule 7(1) while mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- iv. The institution has not uploaded Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- v. The institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- vi. Even till the time of this scrutiny, the website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- vii. The institution is required to upload the Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Government competent authority.
- viii. The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) mentioning all Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- ix. The institution has not uploaded the building plan which mentions the names of all the courses run in the same premises of the institute, Khasra/Plot/Survey number and total land area and total built up area reserved for each course run in the locality and demarcated land and built up area for teacher education programs including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- x. The institution is required to upload Certified land document with mentioning all Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority. The institution has required upload Affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper in prescribed format regarding land documents.
- xi. The uploaded list of teaching staff duly countersigned by its affiliating body is not in the prescribed format of NCTE and not as per NCTE regulation 2014 and amendment time by time.
- xii. It cannot be ascertained from the bank statement uploaded by the institution that salary is being paid as per the Central/State Government pay scale.
- xiii. The institution has uploaded Form No 10 AC. The institution has not uploaded the Exemption Certificate (Form 12A) issued by the Income Tax Department or issued by government competent authority.

**Hence, the WRC decided that the application submitted by the institution for Transition to ITEP course be refused under Section 14 (3) (b) / 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.**

#### **Decision of WRC:**

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

1. That the Committee considered the whole matter in its 431<sup>st</sup> meeting i.e. fresh representation dated 20.04.2025 together with copy of previous letters/representations dated 03.09.2024 followed by reminder/representation dated 07.02.2025 and 20.04.2025 submitted by the institution enclosing copies of court order with request to restore recognition for B.Ed. course.
2. That the Committee after examination of all documents including court orders and representation/reminder dated 07.02.2025 has already noted that institution is still deficient on the grounds of Withdrawal Orders issued dated 20.03.2012 related to land and building as per provisions of NCTE Act, Norms and Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. Therefore, the Committee decided that withdrawal order dated 20.03.2012 shall remain unchanged, which shall be communicated to institution and all concerned. Accordingly, withdrawal order dated 11.08.2025 has been issued to the institution/society and all other concerned.
3. Both orders of withdrawal issued/dispatched by speed post in the institution address and society address have been returned undelivered with postal remarks dated 18.08.2025 "Left". The order of withdrawal dated 11.08.2025 has been uploaded on NCTE website showing its de-recognition status.
4. The Committee has already considered all the representations of institution including reminder/representation dated 07.02.2025 in its 431<sup>st</sup> meeting and examined the matter elaborately.
5. The institution has again approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) 1368/2026 titled 'Shri R J PATEL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & ANR versus NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION & ANR'. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 02.02.2026 passed the following directions:

*"...2. Mr. Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, restricts his prayer in the present case to a direction to the respondents to decide the comprehensive representation dated 07.02.2025 expeditiously.*

*3. For the said reasons, issue notice.*

*4. Ms. Malhotra, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that the averments made in the petition are denied.*

*5. Since the petitioners are only seeking decision on the representation, it is directed that the respondents shall hear the petitioners and dispose of the representation expeditiously and in any case not later than 8 weeks from today.*

*6. The petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms."*

**As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, WRC again considered the whole matter in detail, with fresh representation dated 05.02.2026 received on 10.02.2026 and representation dated 07.02.2025 along with representation dated 20.04.2025, the Committee decided that the institution is still deficient on the grounds of Withdrawal Orders issued dated 20.03.2012 related to land and building as per provisions of NCTE Act, Norms and Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, hence, withdrawal order dated 20.03.2012 shall remain unchanged, which shall be communicated again to the institution and all concerned.**

**Decision of WRC:**

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee further observed the decision taken by WRC in its 412th meeting held on 13th January 2025 in reference to Order dated 04.02.2022 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.16082/2019 by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur Bench, which is as under:

*"On consideration upon the submissions advanced by both the sides, this Court is of the view that the impugned orders dated 08.02.2018 and 16.04.2019 are required to be set aside, as the same were passed in violation of principles of natural justice and further directions are issued for consideration*

*of the application of the respondents for recognition in the integrated course for the successive years in question as per the merits of their case and in accordance with law within a period of 45 days.”*

*2. Thereafter, petitioner filed the contempt petition S.B. civil contempt petition no. 635/2022 in which he prayed before the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jaipur bench for compliance of the order dated 04.02.2022 which is listed for hearing on 15th January 2025.*

*3. The WRC noted the facts of the matter as under:*

- i. That earlier this matter was decided by NRC in its 280th meeting held on 6th to 7th February 2018 by rejecting the application vide NRC Refusal Order dated 08.02.2018 which was subsequently confirmed by the Appeal Committee while disposing the appeal filed by the petitioner institution vide Appeal Order dated 16.04.2019.*
- ii. Further, NCTE vide notification dated 22.10.2021 omitted the B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed. Course (Appendix 13 of the NCTE Regulations 2014) from the list of approved pre-service teacher education programmes.*
- iii. The Council in 54th General Body (GB) meeting held on 27.04.2022 decided that all the applications pending before the regional committees for B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed. Course shall not be processed further.*
- iv. Thereafter, the Council in its 55th GB meeting held on 14th July 2022, has decided to return all those applications which are not in line with NEP 2020 irrespective of any course.*
- v. In compliance to the above policy decision of GB, the WRC in its 392nd meeting held on 22nd August 2023 has decided as under:-*

*“In light of decision taken by the Council in its 55th General Body meeting held on 14.07.2022, WRC considered the matter in detail and decides that all the applications pending at any stage be returned to the institutions.”*

*4. Accordingly, in keeping the above position in view it is evident that the application of the petitioner institution was not a pending application on 04/02/2022 (Date of the Court Order). The institution has exercised the available remedy under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 by filing appeal against the decision of the WRC which has been rejected by the Appeal Committee while confirming the order of NRC. Further, the Norms & Standards for B.A B.Ed. or B.Sc. B.Ed. course Appendix-13 has already been omitted as per the policy decision of the GB. Therefore, the application of the petitioner which was already been disposed cannot be treated as pending as on date on the part of WRC. Therefore, the WRC cannot consider the application of the petitioner at this stage. However, the petitioner may apply afresh as and when the applications are invited by the NCTE.”*

Above decision of Committee taken in 412th meeting was communicated vide letter dated 11.02.2025 to the society as well as institution as per address mentioned in its application.

**Further, the Committee in its 450<sup>th</sup> meeting noted that the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur Bench in the contempt case titled Tagore T.t. College vs. Mr. Prof. Dinesh Prasad Saklani passed order dated 04.02.2026 in S.B. Civil Contempt Petition No.635/2022 with following directions:-**

**“प्रार्थना पत्र आई.ए 1/2022 में वर्णित कारणों को दृष्टिगत रखते हुए. दस्तावेज रिकॉर्ड पर लिए जाते हैं।**

**प्रत्यर्थी द्वारा प्रस्तुत मिनिट्स दिनांक 13.01.2025 इस न्यायालय द्वारा पारित आदेश दिनांक 04.02.2022 की सारभूत पालना नहीं मानी जा सकती है। इस संदर्भ में इस न्यायालय द्वारा आक्षेपित आदेश दिनांक 04.02.2022 पक्षकारों की उपस्थिति में और प्रत्यर्थी अधिवक्तों की उपस्थिति में पारित किया गया था और उसमें प्रत्यर्थी द्वारा प्रार्थी के आवेदन को पुनः विचार करने की सहमति प्रदान की गई थी। इसी परिप्रेक्ष्य में आक्षेपित आदेश के पैरा 8 में निम्नलिखित आदेश पारित किया गया था-**

मिनिट्स दिनांक 13.01.2025 उक्त आदेश की पालना नहीं कही जा सकती है, अपितु ऐसा प्रकट होता है कि प्रार्थी की पूर्व में प्रस्तुत याचिका को कंसीडर नहीं किया गया है उनका यह आक्षेप है कि पुनः नये सिरे से आवेदन प्रस्तुत करे जबकि न्यायालय के आदेश में इस प्रकार का कोई आदेश नहीं है कि प्रार्थी पुनः नवीन आवेदन प्रस्तुत करेगा तभी प्रत्यर्थी विचार करेगा।

अतः ऐसी स्थिति में न्यायालय द्वारा पारित उक्त आदेश की पालना करने हेतु न्यायहित में एक अवसर प्रदान किया जाता है।

प्रकरण दो सप्ताह उपरांत सूचीबद्ध हो।"

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

Application be filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur Bench to recall the Court Order dated 04.02.2022 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.16082/2019 Titled "Tagore T.T. College vs. Northern Regional Committee, NCTE".

**Decision of WRC:**

On careful perusal of the original file of the institution, along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, directions of the Hon'ble Court and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee decided as under:

- i. The Committee noted that recognition granted to the institution "Yash Shikshan and, Gramin Vikas Smiti" 40, Shikshak Colony Choupati, Badnawar, Dhar-454660, Madhya Pradesh for B.Ed. programme academic session 2005-2006 annual intake of 100 students vide order No. WRC/2-32/223322/75/2005/5737 dated 21.07.2005. Subsequently vide Order No. WRC/5-6/APW01171/223322/75/2007/C-15213-15219 dated 04.05.2007. Thereafter, Revised Recognition Order No. WRC/APW01771/223322/2015 /142813-69 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. programme from the academic session 2015-2016, two years duration with annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).
- ii. It is also noted that the recognition for M.Ed. course is granted to the institution namely "Yash College of Education, 40, Shikshak Colony, Badi Chopati, Badnawar, Dhar-454660, Madhya Pradesh for M.Ed. programme), vide order No. WRC/5-6/100th /2008/30567 dated 15.03.2008.
- iii. Further the recognition granted for D.El.Ed. course to "Yash College of Education, vide order No. WRC/NCTE/APP2578/222215/256TH /D.El.Ed./MP/2016/171274 dated 27.07.2016.
- iv. The institution has submitted request letter dated 09.09.2025 & 06.01.2026 regarding change the name of institution from Yash Shikshan Sansthan and Gramin Vikas Smiti to Yash College of Education.

v. The institution filed a Writ Petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 1395/2026 vide Order dated 03.02.2026 has passed the following decision: -

1. *This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:*

- *Direct the Respondent to decide the Representations made by the Petitioner Society to incorporate the name of its Yash College of Education, in the formal recognition orders issued to it, by the Respondent No.2 itself; which otherwise, were required to be issued in the name of "Yash College of Education" only, in place of the name of the Petitioner Society herein; and/or..."*
- *It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner society seeks decision on its representation regarding the correction in the name of the college, which is being maintained by the petitioner society.*
- *Ms. Malhotra, learned counsel for the respondents, states that the respondents have recognized the name as given by the petitioner and there is no mistake/error on part of the respondents.*
- *However, dehors the same, she states that the representation of the petitioner will be decided appropriately and expeditiously.*
- *Taking her statement on record and binding the respondents to the said statement, the petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.*
- *In case the petitioner is aggrieved, the petitioner shall be at liberty to take appropriate actions in accordance with law."*

**The Committee noted the above facts as per the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations in the light of the direction of the Hon'ble court and decided that petitioner institution is required to submit the following requisite documents within 30 days for consideration of its request for change of name:-**

- i. Duly notarized Resolution of the society regarding change of the name of the institution.**
- ii. Approval of the state government regarding change of the name of the institution.**
- iii. NOC from the Affiliating Body regarding change of the name of the institution.**
- iv. An Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper by authorized representative of the management regarding change of the name of the institution.**
