That the impugned action of the respondents in applying the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 retrospectively to the petitioner-institution is ultra-vires the Constitution and the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993. 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner-institution that a prima facie case appears to be made out in favour of the petitioner- institution, as is explicit from the perusal of the petition and the copies of the documents enclosed with the same as annexures thereto, that the balance of convenience also tilts towards the petitioner-institution, which is likely to suffer an irreparable loss in terms of the academic carrier of the students, in case the relief sought is not granted. 5.
