The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two units from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-5154/233<sup>rd</sup> Meeting (VI)/90346-435 dated 03.03.2015.
- A complaint was received in NRC office on 06.10.2023 vide letter No. PMOPG/D/2023/0208542 dated 29.09.2023 from the Complaint Section-(HQ) against the aforesaid institution.
- As per the decision of NRC taken in its 414<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup> October 2023, First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 10.10.2023. The institution has not submitted the reply of First SCN.
- As per the decision of NRC taken in its 435<sup>th</sup> meeting (Vol-I) held on 03<sup>rd</sup> & 04<sup>th</sup> March 2025, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.04.2025. The institution has submitted a reply thereto on 11.04.2025.
- The matter was considered by NRC in its 442<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course be withdrawn. Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 31.07.2025.
- The institution filed an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 against the Withdrawal Order of NRC and the Appellate Authority vide its order dated 23.01.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: -

*After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 31.07.2025 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration strictly in accordance with the directions specified herein above.*

- The institution has submitted compliance of the Appeal Order dated 23.01.2026.

**In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic units of 50 students each.**

**Further, the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on the following grounds: -**

- The institution has submitted photocopy of land documents for Khasra No. 596 Min, Area-3020 Sqm and Khasra No. 597 & 594, Area-3020 Sqm. Total land 3020+2750= 5770 Sqm. As per the college website, the institution is offering B.A., B.Sc., B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. Course. Hence, 5770 Sqm land is not sufficient for offering all the aforesaid courses.
- The institution has submitted certificate of Land use for Khasra No. 597 and 594 only. No CLU in respect of Khasra No. 596 Min is submitted by the institution.
- The institution has submitted NEC dated 09.06.2025 in which Khasra Nos. are not mentioned.
- The institution has submitted BCC issued by Avar Abhiyanta Gramin Abhiyantra Vibhag. As per BCC, total land of the institution is 5770 Sqm, but as per Fire Safety Certificate total plot area is 8700 Sqm, which do not match with each other.
- The institution is required to submit the Blueprint of approved Building Plan duly signed/approved by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall and other infrastructural facilities along with approval letter issued by Competent Government Authority, as per Norms & Standards as envisaged in the NCTE Regulations 2014.
- The institution has submitted approval letter for 16 faculties issued by Prof. Rajendra Singh Rajju Bhaiya University, Allahabad for different year for B.Ed. Course and staff list for D.El.Ed. course signed by the Secretary, Examination Regulatory Authority,

Allahabad for 16 faculty, whereas the recognition for D.El.Ed. course was granted for one unit only. The institution is required to submit latest approval faculty list in prescribed format approved by affiliating University for B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. course.
