- The institution submitted an application on 28.01.2008(as per the writ petition) seeking recognition for the B.Ed. course under the self-finance scheme before the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), NCTE. The matter was considered by NRC in its 135th Meeting held on 22–23 December 2008 and adjourned meeting held on 29–30 December 2008, wherein the application was rejected on the ground that the land documents were based on a private lease, which was not permissible under the NCTE Regulations dated 10.12.2007.
- The rejection decision was subsequently noted in the 143rd Meeting of NRC held on 27–29 June 2009, wherein the appeal preferred by the institution against the rejection order dated 06.01.2009 was also rejected vide Appeal Order dated 11.06.2009.
- Subsequently, following the decision taken by the General Body of NCTE in its 55th Meeting held on 14.07.2022 regarding return of pending applications along with processing fee, the institution submitted representations dated 08.09.2022 and 12.04.2023 seeking refund of the processing fee and FDRs amounting to Rs. 5 lakh and Rs. 3 lakh.
- The institution thereafter filed Writ Petition No. 28611 of 2023 before the Hon'ble High Court, wherein the Court vide order dated 11.10.2023 directed NRC to consider the institution's application and pass a reasoned order on or before 31.12.2023 after granting opportunity of hearing. The Court further directed that in case there existed no legal impediment, the deposited amount be refunded within the stipulated period.
- The institution alleged that no action was taken within the prescribed time, the institution filed Contempt Application (Civil) No. 1066 of 2024 before the Hon'ble High Court. The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 22.02.2024 granted six weeks' further time to comply with the earlier writ directions. In compliance thereof, the matter was considered by NRC in its 420th Meeting held on 01–02 April 2024.

It was further decided to communicate a No Objection to the concerned college, noting that the Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) is not held in the joint name of the Regional Director and, therefore, no impediment exists in communicating the same. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Decision of NRC</u> <p>The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The institution submitted an online application seeking recognition for the two-year B.Ed. programme under Sections 14/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, and the hard copy of the application was received in the NRC office on 25.06.2015. The matter was considered by NRC in its 243rd meeting held from 28th to 30th September 2015, wherein it was observed that the institution had failed to submit a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the affiliating body for the B.Ed. course. Consequently, a Show Cause Notice was issued on 09.11.2015. After considering the institution's reply received on 04.12.2015, the NRC in its 253rd meeting held from 30th May to 03rd June 2016 rejected the application and refused recognition under Section 14/15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 on the ground of non-submission of the required NOC. Accordingly, a refusal order dated 09.06.2016 was issued to the institution. Aggrieved by the refusal, the institution filed W.P. (C) No. 17382 of 2021 before the Hon'ble High Court, which vide order dated 28.09.2021 directed the institution to submit a fresh online application for affiliation before the affiliating university and further directed that upon grant of NOC by the affiliating body, NCTE should take a

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decision regarding recognition in accordance with law before commencement of the new academic session.

- Pursuant thereto, the matter was reconsidered by NRC in its 361st meeting held in January 2022, wherein a Show Cause Notice was again issued on 01.02.2022. After receipt of the institution's reply, the matter was further considered in the 365th meeting held in March 2022, leading to issuance of a Final Show Cause Notice on 25.03.2022. Subsequently, the institution initiated contempt proceedings before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad in Contempt Application (Civil) No. 5346 of 2022 alleging non-compliance of the Court's directions.
- During the pendency of the contempt proceedings, the matter was repeatedly examined by NRC. In its 376th and emergent 377th meetings held in September 2022, NRC observed that the institution had submitted only a conditional NOC, which did not satisfy the requirements of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, and therefore directed the institution to furnish an unconditional NOC along with a reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.
- The Hon'ble High Court, however, observed in its order dated 12.10.2022 that NCTE appeared to be circumventing the earlier writ directions and granted a final opportunity to comply with the order. Thereafter, NRC in its 383rd meeting held on 31st October and 1st November 2022 decided to file an appeal/LPA against the order dated 28.09.2021 in view of the policy decision taken by the NCTE General Body in its 55th meeting dated 14.07.2022, whereby all pending applications for teacher education programmes, other than diploma level courses, were directed not to be processed further in light of NEP 2020 and to be returned along with processing fees.
- Subsequently, in light of further proceedings before the Hon'ble High Court and considering the General Body decision, NRC in its 395th meeting held on 02nd and 03rd March 2023 resolved to return the institution's application along with the processing fee and further decided not to pursue the proposed LPA. Accordingly, vide communication dated 22.03.2023, the original file and processing fee were ordered to be returned to the institution. Thereafter, the Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 24.05.2023 disposed of the contempt petition observing that the writ directions stood complied with since the authority had taken a decision on the institution's application.
- The Court, however, directed refund of the processing fee within ten days, failing which interest at the rate of 8% per annum would accrue. Since the institution had deposited the fee through demand draft and had not furnished bank details, the Accounts Section of NCTE could not process the refund. Consequently, NRC in its 429th meeting held on 25.10.2024 directed issuance of communication seeking bank account details from the institution for refund of the processing fee along with applicable interest.
- Thereafter, the institution filed W.P. (C) No. 28069 of 2024 before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad challenging the order dated 22.03.2023 and seeking reconsideration and grant of recognition for the B.Ed. course. The Hon'ble High Court vide judgment dated 18.02.2025 allowed the writ petition, observing that the impugned order lacked independent application of mind and reasons and had been passed contrary to the earlier order in W.P. (C) No. 17382 of 2021. Accordingly, the order dated

Decision of NRC

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:-

- As per the decision taken by NRC in its 411th meeting held on 15.09.2023, four institutions namely Mahaveer Institute of Technology, Shri Mahaveer Girls Degree College, MIT Business School and MIET College of Education were merged and established as Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan Department of Education, Mahaveer University, Meerut *inter alia* offering D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual of 300 students.
- Accordingly, NRC issued an Order dated 12.10.2023 whereby the merger was allowed and the examination of the courses B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed., B.A.B.Ed. & B.El.Ed. courses were to be conducted as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the Gazette Notification No. 233/79-L-I-2023-2K-8-2023 Lucknow dated 27/06/2023 published for establishment of this University.
- Now, the University vide its letter dated 26.12.2025 has requested the Northern Regional Committee to change the affiliating & examining body for offering its D.El.Ed. course as the Mahaveer University, Meerut from the existing one i.e. SCERT, Lucknow.

In view of the above, the matter was discussed at length and the Committee unanimously decided that the University may get the No Objection Certificate from the SCERT, Nishat Ganj, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh and submit the same to the office of NRC for further consideration of the matter.

Letter be issued accordingly.
