❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 461<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> March 2026, First SCN After Order of Appellate Authority was issued to the institution on 10.04.2026. The institution has uploaded a reply of First SCN on 22.04.2026. The Committee considered the reply and found the same deficient on the following grounds: -

- With regard to difference in address of the institution i.e. Roorkee Campus in the online application form and virtual inspection conducted at Saharanpur campus, the institution has made the following statement:

*The application was made on behalf of IIT Roorkee as an Institution. The IIT Roorkee has its main campus at Roorkee and two additional campuses at Saharanpur and Greater Noida. As explained to the virtual inspection team, all administrative, academic, and financial approvals are routed through the main campus at Roorkee. The address of the main campus was mentioned in the online application form for correspondence purposes only. However, in the main application form, all relevant details such as photographs of the institute building, details of building completion, approved building plans, and geographical location pertain exclusively to the Saharanpur Campus and were verified during the virtual inspection.*

- The aforesaid statement/explanation made by the institution is not acceptable as there is no provision in the NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time to propose the establishment of an institution at one place and to conduct inspection of the same at another location.

**Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.**

- The university has uploaded a Fire Safety Certificate valid up to 29.10.2028 issued by Sh. Surender Singh Mukhya, Agnishaman Adhikari. However, the same is not in favour of applicant institution i.e. College of Education, IIMT University.
- The university has uploaded the Building Plan duly approved by the Meerut Development Authority, however, the same is not properly readable.

**Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.**

❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 457<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> January 2026, First SCN after Order of Appellate Authority was issued to the institution on 10.02.2026. The institution has uploaded a reply of First SCN on 03.03.2026. The Committee considered the reply and found the same deficient on the following grounds: -

- The institution is required to upload the proof of being multidisciplinary since 1996 and other relevant documents to substantiate its claim of having obtained 10 points for shortlisting of its application for further processing as per Public Notice No. NCTE-Regl012/1/2025-Reg. Section-HQ dated 06.05.2025.
- The letter dated 10.03.1998 issued by office of Governor Secretariat for offering B.A. Course since the year 1996 is in the name of Rajiv Gandhi Degree College which is not the applicant institution. It has not uploaded an affiliation letter for offering B.A. course since 1996 in the name of the applicant institution.
- The university has not uploaded certified copy of registered land documents in respect of Khasra Nos. 395, 396Me, 380ME, 145, 526, 528, 529Me, 530, 533, 534, 545, 536, 551, 552, 553/1, 535, 531 issued by the Revenue Department. Only the copies of Khatauni were uploaded by the University.
- The university has uploaded a copy of building plan signed by Private Architect who is not the Competent Government Authority. Also, the land and built-up area for each course being offered in the premises of the university is not earmarked.
- The university has uploaded a Building Safety Certificate dated 24.05.2025 issued by M.K. Singh & Associates which is not the Competent Government Authority.
- The university has uploaded a Fire Safety Certificate dated 26.05.2025 valid up to 25.05.2028 issued by an individual namely Sh. Rajeev Kumar Pandey. However, the designation of the Officer & name of office by whom the said certificate was issued, is not mentioned thereon.
- The university has uploaded a certificate dated 24.05.2025 that the institution's campus, building, furniture etc is barrier free/Accessible issued by M.K. Singh & Associates which is not the Competent Government Authority.
- The university has not uploaded Building Completion Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority in prescribed format.

**Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.**

- ❖ As per the decision of NRC in its 461<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> March 2026, Final SCN after Order of Appellate Authority was issued to the institution on 10.04.2026. The institution has uploaded a reply to Final SCN on 25.04.2026. However, the same is still deficient on the following grounds:
  - The institution has uploaded Jamabandi for the year 2015-16 in regional language as well as notarized English version in the name of Akal Degree College, Gurudwara. However, it has not uploaded the certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority indicating that the title of land is vested in the name of the applicant institution/society/trust/company, as per the NCTE Regulations 2014.
  - The institution has not uploaded clear/legible copy of Building Plan duly approved by the Competent Government Authority.
  - The institution has uploaded two Building Completion Certificate (s) and the date of issue of the same is not mentioned thereon.
  - The institution itself admitted that while applying for online application of ITEP, they have written Khasra No. 219 and even during online Appeal it was typed 219 whereas, the correct Khasra Nos. are 38/2 (5-9), 10, (7-11), 35//18/2 (2-14)19(4-8)23/1(5-14)37//5(1-17)35//28(17-0), 38//1 (5-16) total 10.13 acre. However, this claim of the institution cannot be entertained as in various documents uploaded by it, the Khasra Number is mentioned as 219. Bona fide mistake may happen in one document only and not in all the documents uploaded by the institution.

**Hence, the Committee decided to reject/refuse the application for B.Sc. B.Ed.-Secondary (1 unit) & B.A. B.Ed.-Secondary (1 unit) of the institution on the grounds mentioned above under Section 14/15 (3)(b) of the NCTE Act 1993.**

- The Assistant Professor for Physical Education is not having M.P.Ed. degree, hence, he/she is not qualified as per the NCTE Regulations 2014.
- The institution has uploaded a list of faculty duly approved by the Deputy Registrar (Colleges), Punjab University stating that "(i) S No 1 to 4 are approved faculty taking Degree classes, 5 to 10 Newly appointed, yet to join. (ii) S No 1 to 5 approved faculty taking Degree classes, 6 to 10 Newly appointed, yet to join. (iii) Newly appointed (1-3) yet to join". Hence, the institution is required to appoint requisite number of faculty unconditionally and separate list for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) and B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) programmes duly approved by the affiliating University as per the NCTE Regulations 2014.

**Hence, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.**



- The connectivity of first and second floor is not friendly for persons abled differently due to unavailability of ramp and lift. The reply of the institution in this regard is not satisfactory at all.
- The institution does not have adequate faculty rooms and departmental library, as per Norms & Standards of ITEP. The reply of the institution in this regard is also not satisfactory.

❖ Against the Order of refusal issued by NRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before NCTE (HQ) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 22.04.2026 remanded the case back to NRC directing as under:

*After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order passed by the concerned Regional Committee, the records available on file, the documents placed on record, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, decided to set aside the impugned order dated 24.01.2026 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee for limited factual re-verification through conduct of an Online Visiting Team, subject to deposit of the prescribed processing fee and strict compliance with the directions contained herein. The appellant institution shall forward the relevant documents within fifteen (15) days, whereupon the Regional Committee shall proceed in accordance with law and pass a reasoned and speaking order within the stipulated timeframe.*

- ❖ The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 22.04.2026.
- ❖ In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -
  - As per online application, the institution has filled up the Gata No(s). as 5 & 7,9,10,11,12 & 13,31/1(old), 22,24,25,26 (new), whereas the non-encumbrance certificate was uploaded for Gata No. 27 only.

- The institution has not submitted the Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The connectivity of first and second floor is not friendly for persons abled differently due to unavailability of ramp and lift. The reply of the institution in this regard was not satisfactory at all.
- The institution does not have adequate faculty rooms and departmental library, as per Norms & Standards of ITEP.

❖ Apart from the above, the institution is also required to upload the document as per directions passed by the Appellate Authority.

- The institution has submitted a Certificate No. MTP/374 dated 03.06.2025 issued by the Municipal Town Planner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar stating that the classification of the building in the Name of "Khalsa College Charitable Society" which does not match with the Jamabandi. However, the records reveal that the Khalsa College Charitable Society is the sponsoring society of the institution.
- The institution has submitted a copy of Building Plan which is not approved by the Competent Government Authority. The institution is required to submit Blueprint of

- There are 5 qualified Lecturers only. Hence, the institution is required to appoint one more Lecturer as per NCTE norms.
- Hence, the institution is required to appoint the required number of faculty showing subject of teaching as per the NCTE Regulations 2014 in the prescribed format duly approved by the affiliating University exclusively for D.P.Ed course .

#### **For B.P.Ed. course**

- The institution has appointed one Associate Professor only; the institution is required to appoint one more Associate Professor as per NCTE norms.
- Further, the institution has appointed 4 Assistant Professors. Out of 4 Assistant Professors one Assistant Professor namely Mr. Gurpreet Arora has also been included in D.P.Ed course.

- ❖ In view of the above, Committee decided that Show Cause be issued to the institution on the following grounds: -
  - The institution is required to submit a certified copy of registered land documents showing the title of land in the name of the Sponsoring Trust.
  - The institution is requested to submit the status of affiliation issued by the Affiliating University since the date of recognition and present status .

**Hence, the Committee decided that First Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of First Show Cause Notice. The Committee also decided to ask the affiliating university to furnish the status of affiliation of the institution since the date of recognition and present status of the institution from NCTE to till date.**

The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- ❖ Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-10512708-2716 dated 09.06.2004 followed by revised recognition order for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2015-2016 vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1051/2015/103979-82 dated 25.05.2015.
- ❖ The institution has not submitted compliance of revised recognition order dated 25.05.2015.
- ❖ The institution vide letter dated 16.08.2018 has requested the Northern Regional Committee to change the name of the institution from “Integrated School of Education” to “Integrated Academy of Management and Technology.”
- ❖ As per the decision taken by the NRC in its 288<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018, Order regarding change of name was issued to the institution on 12.09.2018.
- ❖ The institution has submitted a letter dated 22.04.2024 received in NRC office on 27.04.2024 requesting to withdraw the recognition for offering B.Ed. course.

- ❖ As per the decision taken by NRC in its 422<sup>nd</sup> Meeting (Part-2) of NRC held on 06<sup>th</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> June 2024, the committee decided to seek the clarification from the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of issue of letter. Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 23.07.2024. The institution has not submitted any reply to a letter dated 23.07.2024.
- ❖ The institution has requested the affiliating University namely Chaudhary Charan Singh University Meerut to change the affiliation for B.Ed. course in the name of Integrated Academy of Management and Technology as the University has issued certificate to all the students in the name of Integrated School of Education. However, the University has not acceded to the request of the institution.
- ❖ Now the institution has submitted a representation dated 27.04.2026 with request to issuance of NCTE Certificate in the name of the Integrated School of Education only and to cancel the Order of NRC permitting the change of name of the institution as Integrated Academy of Management and Technology.

**In view of the above, the Committee considered the request of the institution and decided to withdraw the Order 12.09.2018 permitting the change of name of the institution as Integrated Academy of Management and Technology. The OTPRMS certificate to all the institutions be issued in the name of Integrated School of Education only.**

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2026-2027 vide Order No. NCTE/NRC/FR-2122-NRC-299074118/JAMMU AND KASHMIR/2021/Recognition Order dated 25.11.2025.
- Since, the institution had applied for two units, it preferred an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Appellate Authority against the recognition Order dated 25.11.2025.
- Appellate Authority vide its order dated 22.04.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: -

***After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order passed by the concerned Regional Committee, the records available on file, the documents placed on record, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, decided to remand the matter to the Northern Regional***

**Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration strictly in accordance with the directions specified hereinabove.**

- The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 22.04.2026.
- In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -
  - ❖ Institution is required to upload stream-wise & stage-wise list of faculty in format duly approved by the affiliating university. The number of faculty and qualifications were to be as per the Regulation 5 of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Amendment Regulations 2021 notified in the Gazette of India on 26.10.2021.
- Apart from the above, the institution is also required to upload the document as per directions passed by the Appellate Authority.

- ❖ The institution vide letter dated 12.05.2026 has requested the Northern Regional Committee to change the name of the institution from “**Shri Latoori Singh Sri Ram Degree College**” to “**Shri Latoori Singh Sri Ram Mahavidyalaya**”.

**In view of the above, the Committee considered the matter and decided that the name of the institution be changed from “Shri Latoori Singh Sri Ram Degree College” to “Shri Latoori Singh Sri Ram Mahavidyalaya” for offering its B.Ed. Course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students at Plot no. 599, Street No. 2, Village-Dhumari, P.O. The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The recognition was granted to the institution namely **Samay Ji H.A. Mahavidyalya, Plot No., Street No., Village-Jai Ram Pattey, Post office-Bheshhi, Tehsil/Taluka-Khalilabad, Town/City, District-Sant Kabir Nagar-272175, Uttar Pradesh** for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2012-2013 vide order no. F.NRC/NCTE/UP-2770/203<sup>rd</sup> Meeting/2012/29935-942 dated **24.08.2012**.
- After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has not consented to come under the Regulations 2014 and affidavit in this regard was also not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.Ed. two-year duration was not issued to the institution.
- The institution filed writ petition No- W.P.(C) 6081/2026 in the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and Hon'ble High Court passed an order dated 05.05.2026 on the following grounds:-

**CM APPL. 29953/2026**

Exemptions granted, subject to all just exceptions.  
The application is disposed of.

**W.P.(C) 6081/2026**

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:

*“(i) issue a writ of mandamus or any other suitable writ, order or direction the Respondents to issue revised recognition order for 100 Seats of B.Ed. course to the Petitioner institution under NCTE Regulations, 2014; and/or  
(ii) issue directions/order holding that the recognition granted to the petitioner for B.Ed. course continues to be in operation under the NCTE Act and the petitioner be treated as a recognized institution for all purposes and the respondents be directed to take all consequential steps including correcting the status of petitioner institution as a recognized institution on their 21 website and to inform the affiliating body and the Department of Higher Education Government of Uttar Pradesh enabling the petitioner to conduct the*

*B.Ed. Course as well as participate in counselling & admit students for the academic session 2026-27 and onwards....”*

2. *The facts are that the petitioner submitted documents in the prescribed proforma to NRC for compliance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 seeking revised recognition for 100 seats. The said representation is pending consideration be the respondent No.1.*
3. *My attention has been drawn to an Order dated 16.05.2025 in W.P. (C) 5765/2025 wherein in somewhat similar circumstances the coordinate bench allowed the petition directing the respondents to consider the request of the petitioner.*
4. *Accordingly, on the basis of parity, it is directed that the respondent shall decide the request of the petitioner institution for issuance of revised recognition of petitioner institution for 100 seats expeditiously and preferably within 8 weeks from today.*
5. *The petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.*

The petitioner institution had approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by filing Writ Petition (Civil) No. 6081/2026. It was observed by the Committee that the limited prayer made by the petitioner before the Hon'ble Court pertained to a direction for issuance of revised recognition for an intake of 100 seats in respect of the B.Ed. programme conducted by the institution.

The Committee also took note of the order dated 05.06.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the aforesaid writ petition, whereby the Hon'ble Court directed the respondent authority -NRC to consider and decide the request of the petitioner institution for issuance of revised recognition for 100 seats.

**In view of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Court, the Committee deliberated upon the matter in detail. After due consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case, as well as the directions contained in the order of the Hon'ble Court, the Committee resolved that the representation submitted by the institution be considered and processed strictly in accordance with the extant provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, and Regulations, 2014. The Committee further resolved that necessary action in the matter be taken expeditiously and the representation be decided within the stipulated time frame as directed by the Hon'ble Court. The file after thorough scrutiny of the representation submitted by the Institution may be submitted before the Committee for the further decision.**

29. **Al-Nabi Social & Educational Trust vs. NCTE & ors.**

The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted the following: -

1. The file of the institution, along with the relevant documents, provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOPs, and guidelines issued from time to time, was placed before the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for consideration in the matter titled *Al-Nabi Educational & Social Trust vs. NCTE & Anr.* [W.P.(C) No. 18685/2025] along with connected matters being W.P.(C) No. 3290/2026 (*Hitesh Sharma & Ors. vs. NCTE & Ors.*) and W.P.(C) No. 4548/2026 (*Vindeshwari Yadav & Ors. vs. NCTE & Ors.*).
2. The Committee noted that the institution namely *Delhi College of Education* was granted recognition by the NRC, NCTE vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-5428/233rd Meeting/2015/89680-685 dated 03.03.2015 for conducting the B.Ed. programme of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 students comprising two basic units of 50 students each.
3. The Committee further noted that a request dated 19.11.2015 had been received from the Chairman, Al-Nabi Educational & Social Trust seeking change of the institution's name from *Delhi College of Education (DCE)* to *Delhi Institute of Rural Development (DIRD)*.
4. The matter was considered by the NRC in its 246th Meeting held from 09.12.2015 to 12.12.2015, wherein it was observed that the request for change of name was required to be accompanied by: (i) approval of the affiliating University permitting such change of name; and (ii) documentary proof establishing that the land and building approved by NRC stood registered in the proposed new name of the institution.
5. It was accordingly decided that the request for change of name would be considered only upon fulfilment of the aforesaid requirements. Consequently, a communication dated 29.12.2015 was issued to the institution seeking compliance. However, as per the available records, no reply was received from the institution and no formal order approving the change of name was ever issued by the NRC.
6. The Committee also noted that the petitioner institution thereafter filed W.P.(C) No. 18685/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi seeking, inter alia, change of the institution's name from Delhi College of Education ,(hereinafter referred to as DCE) to Delhi institute of Rural Development (hereinafter referred to as DIRD), updation of the said name in NCTE records and OTPRMS portal, and issuance of OTPRMS certificates for students of academic sessions 2015–2016 to 2024–2025 in the name of DIRD.

7. The Hon'ble Court, vide order dated 15.04.2026, directed the petitioner to submit a fresh application for change of name and further directed NRC to process the same within three weeks from the date of submission of the application.
8. The Committee further took note of the connected matters namely W.P.(C) No. 3290/2026 and W.P.(C) No. 4548/2026, wherein the primary relief sought pertained to issuance of OTPRMS certificates in the name of DIRD. The Hon'ble Court observed that the said petitions were connected with the principal matter and had become infructuous in view of the directions already passed in W.P.(C) No. 18685/2025.
9. The Committee also considered the observations recorded by the Hon'ble Court in the matter of *Hitesh Sharma & Ors.*, wherein reliance had been placed upon the communication issued by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU).  
I
10. Initially, the Court order referred to a University notification dated 09.12.2024 indicating that DCE and DIRD were one and the same institution. Subsequently, vide e-mail dated 27.04.2026, the learned Standing Counsel clarified that the correct date of the University communication was 24.01.2025, as placed on record in Annexure P-14 of the main writ petition. The said communication categorically clarified that *Delhi College of Education* and *Delhi Institute of Rural Development* refer to the same institution.
11. The matter was thereafter examined in light of the pending request for change of name, the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court, the clarification furnished by GGSIPU vide communication dated 24.01.2025, and the larger academic and employment interests of students who had already completed the B.Ed. programme from the institution. The Committee observed that non-alignment of the institutional name in official records was resulting in difficulties in issuance of OTPRMS certificates and could adversely affect the employment prospects of the concerned students.
12. After detailed deliberations, the Committee noted that the notification dated 09.12.2024 issued by GGSIPU was required to be read harmoniously with the University communication dated 24.01.2025 addressed to NRC, wherein it had been expressly clarified that DCE and DIRD are one and the same institution. In view of the said clarification, and in order to safeguard the academic and employment interests of students, it was decided that OTPRMS certificates may be issued to eligible students in the name of *Delhi College of Education (DCE)*, as presently reflected in the records of NRC-NCTE, so as to provide necessary relief in the connected matters filed by *Hitesh Sharma & Ors.* and *Vindeshwari Yadav & Ors.*

13. The Committee further noted that paragraph 5 of the order dated 15.04.2026 directed that, upon submission of the application for change of name, the necessary changes be carried out with effect from the date of recognition of the institution. Upon due deliberation, the Committee observed that such retrospective implementation appeared to be inconsistent with the spirit and scheme of the NCTE Act, 1993 and the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, since a change of name of an institution could ordinarily operate prospectively.
14. Accordingly, the Committee decided to file an appropriate stay application/Civil Miscellaneous Application (CM) specifically with regard to paragraph 5 of the order dated 15.04.2026. The Committee further emphasized that all necessary steps must be undertaken on priority in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Court, while simultaneously safeguarding the interests of students and ensuring adherence to the statutory framework governing NCTE.
15. The Committee thereafter took note of the Minutes of the 463rd Meeting of NRC, Volume-II, wherein it was recorded that CM Application No. 30395/2026 had been filed in compliance with the decision taken in the emergent 463<sup>rd</sup> meeting before the Hon'ble High Court. The Hon'ble Court, vide order dated 06.05.2026, while issuing notice in the CM application, directed NRC to comply with the earlier order dated 15.04.2026 within the stipulated time and further directed NCTE to place its stand on record by filing an appropriate reply. The operative portion of the order dated 06.05.2026 is reproduced as below :

*"4. Issue notice to respondent no.3 through all modes including electronic on the petitioner taking steps within 2 weeks from today.*

*5. the issuance of notice in the application shall not come in way of order passed"*

Accordingly, upon consideration of the order dated 06.05.2026 and after detailed deliberations, the Committee decided that, in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court dated 15.04.2026, OTPRMS certificates shall be issued to the affected students in the name of "Delhi College of Education , Delhi Institute of Rural Development" until the formal change of name is carried out in the records of NRC-NCTE. Simultaneously, the application submitted by the institution for change of name shall be processed within the timeline prescribed by the Hon'ble Court. It was further decided that, upon formal approval and updation of the institutional name from *Delhi College of Education* to *Delhi Institute of Rural Development*, all future OTPRMS certificates shall thereafter be issued exclusively in the name of "Delhi Institute of Rural Development (DIRD)".

The Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
