Decision of NRC

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted that the application of the institution is found to be deficient on the following grounds: -

- The institution, in their application, has mentioned that the institution is a Multidisciplinary institution. The institution has applied for "B.Sc. B.Ed.- Secondary" programme under ITEP. The institution is offering "B.Tech. & M. Tech." (Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Electrical Engineering etc.) and has uploaded

		approval letter dt. 08.08.2025 from All India Council for Technical Education. As per application, the type of institution is mentioned as "Deemed University (Government)". In this regard, the Sub-regulation 2 (ca) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time notified on 22.10.2021, provides the following definition of Multidisciplinary institution: - <i>"(ca) "multidisciplinary institution" means a duly recognised higher education institution involving several different subjects of study/ combining or involving more than one discipline. Multidisciplinary universities and colleges will aim to establish education departments, which besides carrying out cutting edge research in various aspects of education, will also run Integrated Teacher Education Programme, in collaboration with other departments or field of liberal arts or humanities or social sciences or commerce or mathematics, as the case may be, at the time of applying for recognition of Integrated Teacher Education Programme."</i> Thus, the Committee noted that the institution does not fulfil any of the shortlisting criteria for processing of the application for ITEP as given in the Public Notice dated 07.05.2026 issued by NCTE. ❖ In view of the above, the institution is not eligible for further processing of its application. In case, the institution may establish itself as an eligible institution as per Public Notice dated 07.05.2026, it is also found to be deficient on the following grounds: - - The institution has not submitted the processing fee, mentioning itself as a Government institution/University. However, the institution has not uploaded any proof in this regard. It is required to upload an affidavit on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper, duly notarized, undertaking whether the proposed course will be funded by the Government or will be offered on a self-financed basis. - The institution has uploaded a Certificate of "Not-For-Profit Certificate" issued by Dean (Administration & Finance) of the institution i.e. National Institute of Technical Teacher Training & Research. However, the certificate issued by Competent Government Authority is not uploaded. - The institution has uploaded Form No. 10AD (Order for registration) in place of Exemption Certificate (12A). - The institution has not submitted the No Objection Certificate for offering the proposed course issued by the affiliating body. - The institution has uploaded a copy of land documents for land allotted by the Govt. of India on 25.04.1979 for Educational Purposes for a total area of 15 Acres, however, Khasra No. is not mentioned therein. - The institution has not uploaded an Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper in prescribed format in respect of land and built-up area. - The institution has not uploaded mutation certificate of land issued by Revenue Department. However, the institution has uploaded a copy of land documents in place of Mutation Certificate.	

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	- The institution has not uploaded Land Use certificate issued by Competent Government Authority. However, the institution has uploaded a copy of land documents in place of Land Use certificate. - The institution has not uploaded Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority. However, the institution has uploaded copy of land documents in place of Non-Encumbrance Certificate. - The institution has not uploaded the Building Plan approved by the Competent Government Authority. The institution has uploaded a copy of a certificate issued by a Private Architect with details of Block wise carpet area. The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted that the application of the institution is found to be deficient on the following grounds: -

- The institution claimed itself eligible for processing of its application for ITEP under category (iii) of the Public Notice dated 07.05.2026 i.e. UGC recognized University offering undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral Degree Programme shall be eligible. The institution is required to submit a proof of its claim of eligibility under the said category.
- The institution has not submitted the processing fee, mentioning itself as a Government institution/University. However, the institution has not uploaded any proof in this regard. It is required to upload an affidavit on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper, duly notarized, undertaking whether the proposed course will be funded by the Government or will be offered on a self-financed basis.
- The institution has not submitted the No Objection Certificate for offering the proposed course issued by the affiliating body.
- The University is offering several undergraduate/ postgraduate courses i.e. B.A., B.Sc., B.Tech., B.Arch., M.Sc., M.A., MBA & MCA (Dual degree). However, the University has not uploaded the proof of offering the programmes/ approval letter of the Government concerned.
- The university is offering M.Ed. programme recognized by NRC vide Order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-407/2009/6447 dated 21.07.2009 under the name & style of **University School of Education, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University at Kashmiri Gate, Delhi-110403**. However, Revised Recognition Order has not been uploaded. The university has applied for B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary) under ITEP in the name and style as **Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University at Sector-16 C, Dwarka, Southwest Delhi-110078**. Both, the name and address of the institution do not match.
- The university is also recognized by NRC, NCTE vide Order No. NCTE/NRC/2425202305171577/DELHI/2023/Recognition Order dated 10/01/2024 under the name and style as **Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University at Dwarka, Golf Link Road, Southwest Delhi, Delhi-110078** for conducting B.A. B.Ed. (Secondary)-one unit.
- Details of parent organization are not filled by the University. The university has mentioned as "NOT -APPLICABLE".
- The University has not uploaded an Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper in prescribed format in respect of land and built-up area.
- The University has not uploaded the Mutation Certificate issued by the Revenue Department.
- The University has not uploaded the Land Use Certificate issued by the Revenue Department/ Competent Government Authority Concerned. However, the University has uploaded a copy of land documents.
- The University has not uploaded the non-encumbrance certificate issued by the Revenue Department/ Competent Government Authority Concerned. However, the University has uploaded a copy of land documents.
- The University has not uploaded the Building Plan approved by Competent Government Authority. The institution is required to submit the Blueprint of approved Building Plan duly signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority indicating the name of the course, name

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted that the application of the institution is found to be deficient on the following grounds: -

- As per Regulation 8 (1) of the NCTE Regulations 2014 subsequently amended on 26.10.2021 and 04.05.2022, the institution shall offer the ITEP in multi-disciplinary environment. Further, clause 1.5 of the Norms and Standards for Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) (Appendix-

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15) of the NCTE Regulations 2014 *inter alia* provides that the ITEP shall be in multi and inter disciplinary academic environment.

- As per information filled up by the institution in online application form, the institution is offering teacher education programme(s) only and not multi-disciplinary programme(s) which is a pre-requisite for ITEP.
- Further, the institution in its online application has mentioned that it is graded with NAAC B++ whereas as per the document uploaded, it is observed that the institution is graded with NAAC B and the validity period of the same has also lapsed on 18.01.2021.
- Since, the institution is neither a multidisciplinary institution nor fulfilling the shortlisting criteria, hence, it is not eligible for offering ITEP and thus the institution is required to submit proof for its eligibility as per the Public Notice.
- The institution is required to submit an affidavit on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper duly notarized clearly indicating the land and built-area available with it in the following format:

- The institution has mentioned that it is a Multidisciplinary Institution, however, in the relevant column of the application form, the institution has not mentioned name of any course being offered by it and it has mentioned there as "No".
- In this regard, the Sub-regulation 2 (ca) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time notified on 22.10.2021, provides the following definition of Multidisciplinary institution:

“(ca) “multidisciplinary institution” means a duly recognised higher education institution involving several different subjects of study/ combining or involving more than one discipline. Multidisciplinary universities and colleges will aim to establish

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted that the application of the institution is found to be deficient on the following grounds: -

- The institution has mentioned that it is a Multidisciplinary Institution, however, the institution has not uploaded any documentary proof in this regard.
- In this regard, the Sub-regulation 2 (ca) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time notified on 22.10.2021, provides the following definition of Multidisciplinary institution:

“(ca) “multidisciplinary institution” means a duly recognised higher education institution involving several different subjects of study/ combining or involving more than one discipline. Multidisciplinary universities and colleges will aim to establish education departments, which besides carrying out cutting edge research in various aspects of education, will also run Integrated Teacher Education Programme, in collaboration with other departments or field of liberal arts or humanities or social sciences or commerce or mathematics, as the case may be, at the time of applying for recognition of Integrated Teacher Education Programme.”

- Thus, the Committee noted that the institution does not fulfil the eligibility for processing of its application for the proposed course as given in the Public Notice dated 07.05.2026 issued by NCTE.
- ❖ In view of the above, the institution is not eligible for further processing of its application. In case, the institution may establish itself as an eligible institution as per Public Notice dated 07.05.2026, it is also found to be deficient on the following grounds: -
