

Minutes of 467th Meeting (Volume-II) of NRC held on 24th & 25th June 2026

The 467th Meeting of the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) was held on 24th & 25th June 2026 in Hybrid mode at NCTE Office, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of the Chairperson of NRC Committee. - Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats from the academic session 2009-2010 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/PB-604/162nd Meeting/2010/25369-75 dated 09.07.2010 followed by Revised Recognition order for B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two units from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/PB-604/2015/108004-008 dated 30.05.2015.

		- As per the decision of NRC taken in its 281st meeting held on 20th & 21st February 2018, First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.03.2018. The institution has not submitted the reply of First SCN. - As per the decision of NRC taken in its 324th meeting held on 22nd December 2020, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 01.02.2021. The institution has submitted a reply thereto on 24.03.2021. - The matter was considered by NRC in its 410th Meeting held on 04th & 05th September 2023 and the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course be withdrawn. Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 22.09.2023. - The institution filed an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 against the Withdrawal Order of NRC and the Appellate Authority vide its order dated 14.05.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: - <i>"After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order passed by the concerned Regional Committee, the records available on file, the documents placed on record, and the submissions made by the appellant institution the appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 22.09.2023 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration strictly in accordance with the directions specified hereinabove.</i> - The institution has submitted compliance of the Appeal Order dated 14.05.2026. In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic units of 50 students each. Further, the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on the following grounds: - - The institution has not submitted fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority. - The institution has not submitted non-encumbrance certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority. - The institution has not uploaded the Building Safety Certificate citing that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/ Standards, for offering the teacher training course, issued by Competent Government Authority. - Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority has not been submitted. - The institution is required to submit the Blueprint of approved Building Plan duly signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall and other infrastructural facilities along with approval letter issued by Competent Government Authority, as per Norms & Standards as envisaged in the NCTE Regulations 2014. Building Plan should also clearly indicate the area earmarked for its existing and the proposed courses.

- Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of one-year duration with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2014-2015 vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-4221/225th Meeting/2014/ 73578-584 dated 04.03.2014.
- As per information / documents available in the regulatory file of the institution, it was found that the institution has not submitted the requisite affidavit to adhere with the NCTE Regulations 2014, therefore, the revised recognition order was not issued to the institution.

Decision of NRC

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted the following: -

- ❖ The Visiting Team Report of the institution was considered by the Committee and the Committee noted that the institution is deficient on the following grounds: -

- Land area and built-up area mentioned in the affidavit do not match with the land documents.
- The institution has not presented the Khasra Number of the land where the institution is located.
- Certified copy of registered land documents alongwith scheduled of the property and plan of open space are not presented to the VT members.
- Mutation Certificate dated 06.10.2025 has not been present to the VT members.
- Certificate of the land use has not been presented to the VT members.
- The institution has not presented the latest Non-encumbrance to the VT members.
- The Building Plan is not approved by the Competent Government Authority. As per norms, the building plan has to be approved by Development Authority / Municipal Authority / Zila Panchayat (rural).
- Whether the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/Standards, to run the teacher training course, is not available with the institution.
- Whether safeguard against fire hazard has been provided in all parts of the building is not provided to the VT members.
- Facilities are not provided for Ramp and Lift, in the institution.

Hence, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice post VT be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- ❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 451st Meeting (Volume-I) held on 19th, 20th & 21st November 2025, the application of the institution was refused on the following grounds:
 - The institution has not uploaded the copy of the revised recognition order.
 - Building Safety Certificate uploaded is issued by the Architect and not by the Competent Government Authority.
 - Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Tehsildar is uploaded. However, the period of search is not mentioned therein.
 - The institution has uploaded the copy of the building plan, however, the same is not approved by the Competent Government Authority.
- ❖ Against the Order of refusal issued by NRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before NCTE (HQ) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 06.04.2026 remanded the case back to NRC directing as under:

"After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order passed by the concerned Regional Committee, the records available on file, the documents placed on record, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, decided to set aside the impugned order dated 27.11.2025 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) with a direction to reassess the eligibility of the appellant institution for recognition under the ITEP programme with the directions specified hereinabove. The NRC shall take a reasoned and speaking decision after considering all documents and subsequent submissions of the appellant, including compliance with the deficiencies cited in the impugned order. The appellant institution is also directed to forward the documents submitted in appeal to the NRC within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.

- The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 06.04.2026.
- In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -
 - The institution has not uploaded the copy of the revised recognition order.
 - Building Safety Certificate uploaded is issued by the Architect and not by the Competent Government Authority. The institution is required to submit the Building Safety Certificate citing that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building

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		Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/ Standards, for offering the teacher training course, issued by Competent Government Authority. - Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Tehsildar is uploaded. The appellant institution shall submit the requisite documents within fifteen (15) days, whereupon the Regional Committee shall proceed in

- The institution has submitted compliance of the Appeal Order dated 16.06.2026.

In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic units of 50 students each.

Further, the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on the following grounds: -

- The institution has not submitted point wise reply to the Show Cause Notice dated 23.06.2023 issued by NRC.
- The institution is not a multi-disciplinary institution as defined under clause 2(ca) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time.
- The institution is required to submit the certified copy of Registered Land Documents issued by the Competent Revenue Authority.
- The Non-Encumbrance Certificate submitted is issued in 2003. Latest NEC is not submitted.
- The institution has simply submitted the computerized building plan. Plot / Khasra No. / Khata No are not mentioned in the Building Plan. The building plan is not approved by any Government Engineer. It is simply signed by a registered Architect. The institution is required to submit the Blueprint of approved Building Plan duly signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall and other infrastructural facilities along with approval letter issued by Competent Government Authority, as per Norms & Standards as envisaged in the NCTE Regulations 2014. Building Plan should also clearly indicate the area earmarked for its existing and the proposed courses.
- The Building Completion Certificate is not in the prescribed format of NRC. The same is also not issued by any Government Engineer. It is signed by Registered Architect. The institution is required to submit a Building Completion Certificate signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority in the prescribed format.
- The institution has not submitted a Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Revenue Authority to use the land for educational purposes.
- The site plan showing that the Plot Nos./Khasra Nos. are contiguous in nature with demarcated land area for offering miscellaneous courses, duly approved by the Competent Government Authority is not submitted.
- The institution has not submitted the certificate that the institution's campus, building, furniture etc. is barrier free/Accessible for PWDs issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The institution has not uploaded the Building Safety Certificate citing that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/ Standards, for offering the teacher training course, issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit the latest/ valid Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
