The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee noted the following: -

- ❖ Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2016-2017 vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-3376/249th Meeting 2015/140794-99 dated 24.02.2016.
- ❖ The institution subsequently failed to comply with the regulatory requirements of NCTE. Accordingly, two show cause notices were issued to the said TEI in view of non-compliance, the recognition to offer the B.Ed. course was withdrawn. The matter was taken up in Appeal Committee, wherein the case was remanded back to NRC for reconsideration. Meanwhile, the petitioner approached the Hon'ble Court seeking intervention against the withdrawal of recognition.
- ❖ In compliance of directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 22/08/2025 in W.P. (C) 12049/2025 and after due consideration it was resolved to pass an order of restoration in favour of the petitioner institutions for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 and for allowing the said institution to participate in the ongoing counselling for the academic session 2025-2026.
- ❖ The matter was considered by NRC in its 446th Meeting held on 19th August 2025 and the Committee decided to issue an order of restoration of recognition in favor of petitioner institution for B.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 100 students and also to issue a show cause notice.
- ❖ Accordingly, restoration order was issued to the institution on 01.09.2025 and also issued a show cause notice on the following grounds: -
 - The institute submitted approval of faculty issued by the CCS University in 2015. The institute is required to submit the latest approval.
 - Administrative and professional staff have not been appointed as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
 - The institute did not submit bank statements duly certified the bank in respect of Account of college and all individual faculty and other staff for last 3 months as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 showing disbursement of salary through bank account.

- ❖ NRC office is in receipt of a letter No. 2026/JJR/104 dated 20.05.2026 from the Director, SIASTE regarding NCTE approval notional shifting of students of SIASTE Gurugram and SIASTE Kurukshetra, operating from their respective DIETs.
- ❖ The State Government has requested NCTE that in order to resolve the matter on a one-time special basis, the State Government, on the recommendations of the committee constituted for this purpose, has approved the notional shifting of 537 students of the B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. four-year programme belonging to the 2021-25, 2022-26, 2023-27 and 2024-28 batches of these two institutes to NCTE-recognised institutes affiliated with different State Universities of Haryana, subject to ratification by NCTE. The detailed student-wise proposed allotment of institutes has also been provided by the State Government.
- ❖ The State Government has requested NCTE to ratify the aforementioned proposal of the State Government in the interest of the students who have passed out from / are presently studying in these institutes.
- ❖ The aforesaid matter was listed for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana on 22.05.2025, wherein the Hon'ble Court, vide order dated 22.05.2026 directed as follows:

"the NCTE shall examine the recommendations made by the Committee sympathetically as its decision is likely to affect the fate of large number of students who are not at fault. Moreover, while taking such decision, the NCTE shall take into consideration Regulation 12 of the NCTE Regulations."

- The matter is listed for next hearing on 22.07.2026.
- ❖ The Committee also noted that all the institutions where the State Government has proposed the notional shifting of students, are recognized by NRC.
- ❖ The Committee further noted that the proposal received from the State Government was forwarded to the NCTE (HQ) with a request for ratification of the notional shifting of students of SIASTE, Gurugram and SIASTE, Kurukshetra.
- ❖ NCTE (HQ) has informed that there is no violation of NCTE Regulations to consider the recommendation of committee constituted by the Govt. of Haryana and forwarded by the SIASTE with regard to notional shifting of students of SIASTE to the vacant seats in NCTE recognised institutions. 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❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 464th Meeting (Volume-2) held on 11th & 12th May 2026, First SCN After Order of Appellate Authority was issued to the institution on 10.06.2025. The institution has uploaded a reply of First SCN on 15.06.2025. The Committee considered the reply and found the following: -

- The institution has stated that as per Shortlisting Criteria for processing of application for ITEP received for the academic session 2026-27, points were to be awarded to institutions accredited with NAAC. However, in case of this institution, points for NAAC certificate were not calculated.
- The institution has been awarded NAAC Grade B++ (CGPA 2.86) on 22.07.2025 which was valid up to 31.12.2030. The institution has further stated that this was not considered earlier in the impugned assessment by NRC. The institution has now become eligible for processing of its application for ITEP as it must be awarded 6 points for NAAC accreditation, and 4 points on account of being multidisciplinary institution.
- However, the Committee noted that as per Public Notice dated 06.05.2025/ 27.05.2025 issued by NCTE(HQ), the last date for submission of application for ITEP during the academic year 2026-2027 was 31.05.2025 and this institution was awarded NAAC B++ accreditation only on 22.07.2025 i.e. after the last date of submission of application for ITEP for the academic session 2026-27. Hence, the points on account of this NAAC certificate cannot be taken into account. As such, the said institution is not eligible for processing of its application for ITEP for the academic session 2026-27.
- The Committee is of the view that the Appellate Authority has not taken into consideration this aspect while remanding back the application of the institution to NRC for further processing.

Hence, the Committee decided that the matter be referred back to the Appellate Authority with request to review its decision as the aforesaid institution was not eligible for shortlisting of its application for ITEP in terms of the Public Notice dated 06.05.2025/ 27.05.2025 issued by NCTE(HQ) as it has been awarded NAAC B++ accreditation only on 22.07.2025 i.e. after the last date of submission of application for ITEP for the academic session 2026-27.

Letter be sent to the Appellate Authority accordingly.

On receipt of the reply from the Appellate Authority, the matter be placed again before the NRC for further decision on the application of the institution.
