The 468th Meeting of the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) was held on 22nd & 23rd July 2026 in Hybrid mode at NCTE Office, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of the Chairperson of NRC Committee. - ❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 449th Meeting (Volume-II) held on 13th & 14th October 2025, the application of the institution was refused on the following grounds:
- ❖ *The institution has stated that the approved and selected faculty by the university concerned was mentioned in the format for which interview held on 9-7-25. Approval process of selected faculty will be started after 2 months of the interview. As such, the list of faculty selected by the institution is not duly approved by the affiliating University. The institution was required to submit stream-wise & stage-wise list of*

faculty in the format duly approved by the affiliating university. The number of faculty and qualifications shall be as per the Regulation 5 of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Amendment Regulations 2021 notified in the Gazette of India on 26.10.2021.

- ❖ Against the Order of refusal issued by NRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before NCTE (HQ) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 08.07.2026 remanded the case back to NRC directing as under:

"After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order dated 28.10.2025 passed by the Northern Regional Committee, the records available on file, the additional documents submitted pursuant to the order dated 29.05.2026 of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No.18065 of 2026 (O&M), and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, sets aside the impugned order dated 28.10.2025 and remands the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration subject to the directions contained hereinabove and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law, uninfluenced by any observations contained in the earlier appellate order. It is clarified that this remand shall not create any equity, presumption or vested right in favour of the appellant institution, and the Regional Committee shall independently determine compliance with all statutory and regulatory requirements before taking an appropriate decision. The appellant institution shall submit the requisite documents within fifteen (15) days, whereupon the Regional Committee shall proceed in accordance with law and pass a reasoned and speaking order within a reasonable timeframe."

- The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 08.07.2026.
- In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -
 - ❖ The institution is required to submit stream-wise & stage-wise list of faculty in the format duly approved by the affiliating university. The number of faculty and qualifications shall be as per the Regulation 5 of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Amendment Regulations 2021 notified in the Gazette of India on 26.10.2021.
- Apart from the above, the institution is also required to upload the document as per directions passed by the Appellate Authority.

Hence, the Committee decided that First Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice.

- ❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its **466th Meeting held on 2nd June 2026, First SCN After Order of Appellate Authority** was issued to the Institution on **18.06.2026**. The institution has uploaded a reply of **First SCN After Order of Appellate Authority** on **03.07.2026**.
- ❖ The Committee noted that the institution has complied with all the requirements as laid down in NCTE Regulations 2014 and Norms & Standards for ITEP for grant of recognition of two units of B.A. B.Ed. (Secondary) course.

Hence, the Committee decided that recognition under sub-regulation 7(16) of NCTE Regulations 2014 be granted to the institution for transition of its existing B.A. B.Ed. course to Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for additional one unit of B.A. B.Ed. (Secondary) course.

Note: Transition to one basic unit of existing B.A. B.Ed. course to ITEP was already allowed by NRC vide Order No. NCTE/NRC/2526202402281864/PUNJAB/2024/Recognition Order dated 29/10/2025.

The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- ❖ As per the decision of NRC taken in its 455th Meeting (Volume-II) held on 12th January 2026, the application of the institution was refused on the following grounds:
 - The institution has applied for transition of its existing B.A. B.Ed. Secondary course into ITEP whereas it has been offering B.Com. course only and not the B.A. course. Hence, the institution is required to prove that it is a multidisciplinary institution in relevant subjects as per sub-regulation 2(ca) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended vide Gazette Notification dated 26.10.2021.
 - The institution itself admitted that it has applied to CCS University, Meerut for affiliation of new B.A. and B.Sc. programme(s).
 - The institution is required to furnish a copy of the affiliation order for these course(s). in this regard the institution stated that the institution has been offering the B.A. B.Ed. programme since 2019. Therefore, we already possess the required multidisciplinary infrastructure, including classrooms, laboratories,

library resources, and qualified faculty in all relevant subjects of Humanities and Social Sciences, as mandated under Sub-Regulation 2(ca) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended on 26.10.2021).

- The institution is presently running the B.Com. course, the multidisciplinary requirement is already met through the long-standing B.A. B.Ed. programme and approved faculty strength in the relevant disciplines. To further strengthen and expand our multidisciplinary profile, the institution has applied to CCS University for affiliation of new B.A. and B.Sc. programmes. A copy of the application submitted to CCSU is enclosed again. We are confident that the affiliation will be granted before the commencement of the next academic session.
- In view of the existing B.A. B.Ed. programme (since 2019) and the ongoing process for additional B.A./B.Sc. courses, the institution already meets the definition of a multidisciplinary institution as per NCTE norms. We are also conducting B.Sc. (Biotech) Course successfully from 2003. In 2019, CCSU and NCTE granted approval to only five colleges to run the B.A.-B.Ed. course, which reflects the premium quality of infrastructure and academic facilities of our college. If approval for conversion of B.A.-B.Ed. to ITEP is not granted, a large number of students will be adversely affected and may lose the opportunity to pursue the integrated teacher education programme.
- The institution has uploaded the Building Plan; however, the break-up of the built-up area is not mentioned thereon for the teacher education programme/s being offered & proposed to be offered by the institution. In this regard the institution stated that it is respectfully submitted that the institution has already uploaded the approved building plan indicating the total built-up area of the campus as well as the building proposed for the Teacher Education Programme. Further, the detailed break up of built-up area is clearly shown in the layout map which has been uploaded and attached again with letter of Architect clearly mention the Total built-up area and built-up area of the building for the proposed Teacher Education Programme for ready reference.

- ❖ Against the Order of refusal issued by NRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before NCTE (HQ) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 16.06.2026 remanded the case back to NRC directing as under:

"After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the records available on file, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of its appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, hereby sets aside the impugned order dated 24.01.2026 and remands the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) for fresh consideration and factual re-examination, strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 (as amended), and the NCTE MDI Guidelines dated 15.05.2025, subject to the directions contained hereinabove. The appellant institution shall submit the requisite documents within fifteen (15) days, whereupon the Regional Committee shall proceed in accordance with law and pass a reasoned and speaking order within a reasonable timeframe."

- The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 16.06.2026.

In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -

- The institution is required to prove that it is a multidisciplinary institution in relevant subjects as per sub-regulation 2(ca) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended vide Gazette Notification dated 26.10.2021. **Sub-regulation 2 (ca) of NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time notified on 22.10.2021, provides the following definition of Multidisciplinary institution: -**

"(ca) "multidisciplinary institution" means a duly recognised higher education institution involving several different subjects of study/ combining or involving more than one discipline. Multidisciplinary universities and colleges will aim to establish education departments, which besides carrying out cutting edge research in various aspects of education, will also run Integrated Teacher Education Programme, in collaboration with other departments or field of liberal arts or humanities or social sciences or commerce or mathematics, as the case may be, at the time of applying for recognition of Integrated Teacher Education Programme."

- The institution itself admitted that it has applied to CCS University, Meerut for affiliation of new B.A. and B.Sc. programme(s). The institution is required to furnish a copy of the affiliation order for these course(s).
- The institution is required to upload a Certificate as well as *Nazri Naksha* of the land signed by the Patwari or an officer of equivalent rank/level in the concerned State, duly countersigned by the Competent Revenue Authority (At least the level of Tehsildar or equivalent Officer) indicating that all the Khasra Nos. of land on which the institution is established, are adjacent to each other.
- The institution is also required to upload geotagged photographs of the land signed by the Patwari or an officer of equivalent rank/level in the concerned State, duly countersigned by the Competent Revenue Authority (At least of the level of Tehsildar).
- The institution is also required to upload geotagged photographs of the building of the institution signed by the Patwari or an officer of equivalent rank/level in the concerned State, duly countersigned by the Competent Revenue Authority (At least of the level of Tehsildar).
- The institution has not submitted the No Objection Certificate for offering the proposed course(s) issued by the affiliating body.
- The institution is required to upload an affidavit on Rs. 100/- of stamp paper regarding land and built-up area.
- The institution is required to upload the latest certified registered land documents issued by the Revenue Department. The institution is also required to earmark land and built-up area for Liberal & Education separately.
- The institution is required to upload a copy of Mutation Certificate issued by the Competent Revenue Authority.
- The institution is required to upload a copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Revenue Authority to use the land for educational purposes.
- The institution is required to submit the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (not older more than 3 months) issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.

- The institution is required to create new infrastructure for the courses applied for. Accordingly, it shall upload the approved Blueprint of the Building Plan, duly signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority, at least of the level of Executive Engineer of the State Public Works Department (PWD) or an officer of equivalent rank/level in the concerned State. The Building Plan shall clearly indicate the name of the course(s), name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area, dimensions of the Multi-purpose Hall, and details of other infrastructural facilities, along with the approval letter issued by the Competent Government Authority, in accordance with the Norms and Standards prescribed under the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The Building Plan should also clearly demarcate the area earmarked for the existing course(s) and the proposed course(s).
- The institution has not uploaded the Building Safety Certificate citing that the building of the institution has been constructed as per National Building Code and the same is fully safe and structurally sound having load bearing capacity as per the Code/ Standards, for offering the teacher training course, issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit the latest/ valid Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution has not uploaded the certificate that the institution's campus, building, furniture etc. is barrier free/Accessible for PWDs issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit a Building Completion Certificate signed/approved by the Competent Government Authority in the prescribed format.
- The institution is required to submit an affidavit on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper duly notarized clearly indicating the land and built-area available with it in the following format:

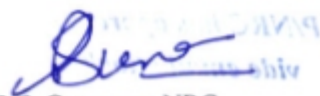

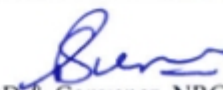
