- Director, School of Education, IGNOU vide letter dated 06/09/2024 informed the NRC that the IGNOU is not going to offer ITEP in face-to-face for the academic session 2024-25 and requested to remove the name of IGNOU immediately from the list of participating universities / institutions for offering the said course.
- Further, the Vice Chancellor, Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) vide email dated 12.09.2025 has requested continuation of recognition accorded to it for offering Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP).
- The said letter was considered by the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee decided that the IGNOU is permitted to continue the ITEP. Also, the Committee decided to issue the Show Cause Notice to IGNOU to provide the provision of the IGNOU Act which permits it to offer the courses in face-to-face mode.
- Accordingly, as per the decision of NRC, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.11.2025.
- Director(I/c), IGNOU vide letter dated 03.12.2025 replied the SCN which has been considered by the NRC and the same has been found satisfactory.

Hence, the Committee decided that no action is required to be taken, and the status quo of the institution be maintained as recognized for offering B.A. B.Ed.- Secondary (2 units), B.Sc. B.Ed.- Secondary (2 units), & B.Com. B.Ed.- Secondary (2 units).

Decision of NRC

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:

1. The Committee noted that Malviya Smriti Academy was granted recognition by NRC-NCTE for conducting the D.El.Ed. course with an intake of 50 students vide order dated 18.12.2012.
2. The Committee further noted that the recognition was withdrawn by NRC vide order dated 15.09.2022 on the ground that the institution had requested closure of the course.
3. It was placed on record that the institution preferred a statutory appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, which was allowed by the Appellate Authority on 19.12.2023, and the matter was remanded to NRC for fresh consideration.
4. In compliance with the appellate directions, NRC cancelled the earlier withdrawal order and restored the recognition vide order dated 09.02.2024. On the same date, a first Show Cause Notice (SCN) was issued to the institution.
5. The Committee noted that no reply to the first SCN dated 09.02.2024 was received from the institution. The matter was placed before the NRC in its 420th Meeting held on 01st and 02nd April 2024.
6. After examination of the original file, relevant documents, and the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOPs, and guidelines, the Committee decided that a final Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution, granting 15 days' time to submit its reply prior to withdrawal of recognition.
7. Accordingly, a final Show Cause Notice dated 09.05.2024 was issued. However, no reply was received from the institution within the stipulated period.
8. In view of the non-submission of reply, NRC issued an order withdrawing recognition on 26.03.2025.
9. The Committee noted that the institution filed W.P.(C) No. 18707/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi challenging the withdrawal order and non-consideration of their reply to the final SCN. The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 09.12.2025 quashed the withdrawal order dated 26.03.2025 on the limited ground that the reply of the petitioner was not considered and permitted NRC to take a fresh decision after considering the reply, if any, and after providing hearing, if required.
