- As per online application, the institution has filled up the Gata No(s). as 5 & 7,9,10,11,12 & 13,31/1(old), 22,24,25,26 (new), whereas the non-encumbrance certificate was uploaded for Gata No. 27 only.
- The institution has not submitted the Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The connectivity of first and second floor is not friendly for persons abled differently due to unavailability of ramp and lift. The reply of the institution in this regard is at all not satisfactory.
- The institution does not have adequate faculty rooms and departmental library, as per Norms & Standards of ITEP. The reply of the institution in this regard is also not satisfactory.

Hence, the Committee decided to reject/refuse the application for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) & B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) of the institution on the grounds mentioned above under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act 1993.



The institution has not submitted the Building Completion Certificate duly countersigned by the Competent Government Authority in prescribed format of NCTE. The BCC submitted by the institution is issued by a Private Engineer. The building is accessible for the differently abled persons only on the ground floor and not on the upper floors due to lack of lift or ramp connectivity. The institution, in their reply has admitted the same and further stated that the tender for this work has been issued, and the completion certificate will be submitted shortly upon completion of the work. The total built-up area of all blocks for all courses being offered by the Society is mentioned as 31264 sq. mtrs, however, the drawings of the institution do not reveal the floor-wise break-up of the earmarked built-up area for ITEP. Also, the submitted Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate are not issued by the Competent Government Authority. The institution has uploaded the Registration Certificate of the Society issued on 07.07.1951 which is quite old and the institution has not uploaded the Renewed Certificate of the Society.

- The institution has not submitted the certificate that the institution's campus, building, furniture etc. is barrier free/Accessible for PWDs issued by Competent Government Authority.
- The Building Completion Certificate submitted by the institution is not countersigned by the Competent Government Engineer.
