❖ The Visiting Team Report of the institution was considered by the Committee and accordingly, the institution has been found deficient on the following grounds: -

- The ICT lab of the institution is not well-equipped.
- The psychology lab and library do not have adequate seating capacity, as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- Library for the proposed course should be separated from the Central library.

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- The psychology lab has very old testing materials; hence, it needs to be renovated.
- Language lab is not available in the institution.
- Playground of the institution is not in conditions to play outdoor games.
- There is no provision of lift in the institution, as such, the institution's campus, building, furniture etc. is not barrier free/accessible for PWDs.
- The Building Plan of the institution is deficient. The institution is required to upload the copy of Blueprint of Building Plan duly approved by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area and total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms etc. along with approval letter issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- There are no toilets on upper floors for persons abled differently.
- Construction (as seen during virtual visit) of Ramp should be as per Norms. The minimum width should be 0.90 m and the maximum recommended slope 1:20.
- Computer lab of the institution has 25 computers only which are of obsolete configuration. The lab is also without proper furniture; the tables and chairs are not meant for computer operation.
- Common rooms for boys and girls are very tiny and need basic facilities and proper maintenance.

Hence, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 7 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice failing which the application of the institution seeking grant of recognition for the proposed programme shall be liable for refusal without providing any further opportunity to the institution.





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The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:

- The institution has applied for eight units of ITEP; however, the number of classrooms is not sufficient as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- The library and reading rooms are not up to the mark as per NCTE regulations 2014 and Norms & Standards of ITEP.
- The institution has not submitted the Building Plan duly approved by the Competent Government Authority with demarcation of the building the proposed ITEP out of the total built-up area of 7532.23 sq. mt.
- Also, the Multipurpose Hall is not clearly depicted on the Building Plan.
- Facilities available in the various laboratories are grossly inadequate to offer eight units of the ITEP.

❖ Apart from the above, the Committee observed that the institution has earlier applied for 2 units of ITEP with application number **2526202405112783** for the academic session 2025-2026 which is also at the stage of reply of Letter of Intent. The institution has submitted the reply thereof which is also considered at Sl. No. 11 of these minutes.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that this application be closed in view of the deficiencies mentioned above and the application be filed.

Hence, the Committee decided to reject/refuse the application for B.A. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit), Foundational (1 unit), Preparatory (2 unit), B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit), Middle (1 unit), Preparatory (1 unit) B.Sc. B.Ed. Secondary (2 unit), B.Com. B.Ed. Secondary (1 unit) of the institution on the grounds mentioned above under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act 1993.



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- ❖ The recognition of the aforesaid institution was rejected/refused by NRC vide order dated 22/08/2025 on the grounds mentioned therein.
- ❖ The institution filed an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 against the refusal order of NRC and the Appellate Authority vide its order dated 10.11.2025 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: -
 - *After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record, and oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Appeal Committee decided to set aside the impugned order dated 22.08.2025 and remand the matter to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) with a direction to reassess the eligibility of the appellant institution for recognition under the ITEP programme. The NRC shall specifically evaluate whether the institution meets the requisite shortlisting criteria and qualifies as a bona fide multidisciplinary institution. This review must ensure full compliance with the relevant regulatory provisions, legal requirements, academic and assessment standards, and institutional prerequisites necessary for implementation of the ITEP programme. The NRC shall take a reasoned and speaking decision after considering all documents and subsequent submissions of the appellant, including compliance with the deficiencies cited in the impugned order. The appellant institution is also directed to forward the documents submitted in appeal to the WRC within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.*
- ❖ The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 10.11.2025.






