❖ Refusal Order for shifting of premises was issued to the institution on 11.08.2025.

❖ The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 against the refusal order of NRC dated 11/08/2025 and the Appellate Authority vide its order No89-448/E-386092/2025 Appeal/14th Meeting, 2025/APPLNRC202515384/E-88895/134236 dated 15/12/2025 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: -

After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 11.08.2025 and remand back the case to NRC with a direction to carefully re-examine the matter, verify the authenticity and relevance of all documents submitted, and pass a reasoned order strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, and Regulations. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the NRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the NRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

❖ The institution has not uploaded any document in compliance with Appeal Order dated 15.12.2025.

❖ In view of the above, the Committee decided to issue SCN to the institution on the following grounds: -

- NOC for change of affiliating body from Guru Nanak Dev University to the Maharaja Bhupinder Singh Sports University is not submitted.
- The institution has not submitted a certified copy of the registered land documents where the institution intends to shift its premises.
- The institution has not submitted a certified copy of Mutation Certificate.

• Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.03.2025. The institution had submitted the reply on 20.03.2025 received in NRC office on 24.04.2025.

• NRC also noted that the institution was issued Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 on 20.02.2026 the in the RPRO matter in its 451st meeting held on 19th & 20th November 2025 on the following grounds:-

❖ The lease deed is not certified by the Registering Authority.



❖ The institution has not submitted reply of Final SCN. The matter was considered in NRC in its 405th meeting held on 24 July 2023 and the Committee observed the following:-

• The institution has not submitted point wise reply to the Show Cause Notice pointed out by NRC.

• The institution is not a multi-disciplinary institution as defined under clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulation, 2014.

• Certified copy of registered land documents not submitted.

• The Non-Encumbrance Certificate submitted is issued in 2003. Latest NEC not submitted.

• The institution has simply submitted the computerized building plan. Plot / Khasra / Khata No not mentioned in the Building Plan. The building plan is not approved by any Government Engineer, as desired by NRC. It is simply signed by REgd Architect.

• The Building Completion Certificate is not in the prescribed format of NRC. The same is also not issued by any Government Engineer. It is simply signed by Registered Architect.

• The institution has not submitted the Change of Land use issued by the Competent Authority.

• The institution has not submitted the Site Plan issued by the Competent Authority.

• The institution has not submitted the Building Disabled Friendly Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

• The institution has not submitted the Building Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

• Fire Safety Certificate issued by Competent authority of the State Government not submitted.

• The institution has submitted the FDRs from Kangra Central Co-operative Bank, which is not acceptable as per NCTE Regulations.

• The institution has shown only seven teaching staff, as against requirement of 1+15 for two units of B.Ed course.

• None of the staff is approved by the affiliating body.

• The website of the institution is not updated as per clause 7 (14) and 8 (14) of NCTE Regulations 2014.

❖ NRC in its 405th meeting held on 24.07.2023 decided that recognition granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course be withdrawn under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2024-2025 vide order dated NCTE-Regl 015/3803/2021-Regulation Section (HP)-NRC/222967-222974 dated 14th August 2023.

❖ The institution preferred a statutory appeal on 12.10.2023 before the NCTE (HQ) against the withdrawal Order dated 14.08.2023 issued by NRC.

❖ The institution has also filed a W.P. (C) No. 19623/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi raising grievance that the statutory appeal against the Withdrawal Order dated 14.08.2023 is pending for consideration before the Appellate Authority of NCTE, and the principal grievance raised by the petitioners is for non-disposal of the said appeal.

❖ The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 24.12.2025 has disposed of the writ petition with the directions that the Respondents /NRC shall inform the petitioner about the documents required, which the petitioner will submit thereafter. The respondents/NRC shall then reconsider the appeal dated 12.10.2023 after giving the petitioner a personal hearing and pass a reasoned order within six weeks. If aggrieved, the petitioner may take appropriate legal remedies as per law.

❖ In compliance of the order dated 24.12.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) No. 19623/2025, the Committee decided to give the institution an opportunity of personal hearing before NRC strictly as per the Order passed by the Hon'ble Court.

❖ The authorised representative (s) of the institution appeared in person before NRC on 28.01.2026 to present their case and submitted certain documents to take the same on record.

❖ The Committee decided that the institution is still deficient in terms of their documentation for grant of recognition, however, the said documents may be forwarded to the Appellate Authority for necessary action on the pending appeal of the institution.

Action be taken accordingly.

Course with an annual intake of 50 students of two-year duration from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1117/2015/11329-75 dated **16.06.2015**

❖ Recognition of the institution was withdrawn by NRC vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/UP-1117 dated 29.05.2025.

❖ The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 13.01.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for M.Ed. course of two-year duration. ❖ The institution has submitted an application for shifting of premises vide letter dated 25.04.2022. The Committee considered the said application in its 445th Meeting held on 18th to 20th August 2025 and decided to issue show cause notice to the institution on the grounds mentioned therein.

❖ Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 25.11.2025.

❖ The institution has submitted the reply vide letter dated 05.12.2025. The Committee considered the reply and found the same deficient on the following grounds:

- The institution has submitted a land allotment letter issued by the Delhi Development Authority for land allotment; however, the said land is allotted for a Senior Secondary School instead for establishment of the District Institute of Education and Training.
- The institution has not submitted a copy of Blueprint of Building Plan duly approved by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area and total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms etc. along with approval letter issued by the Competent Government Authority. Building plan submitted by the institution is approved by the Executive Engineer-I, Education (M) Div. (E/NE), PWD, New Delhi-110002, however, the name of institution, name of course, total land area and built-up area are written thereon by hand and the Building is proposed for the Dilshad Garden School Project instead of the District Institute of Education and Training.
- The institution has not submitted certified copy of a site plan with demarcated land area for offering various course(s), if any.
- The institution has not submitted the Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.

- The institution has submitted a Building Completion Certificate issued by the Executive Engineer Edu. (M) E & N.E. PWD, Delhi Government for total land area as 3721 Sqm. & total built-up area as 4621 Sqm. However, the said Building Completion Certificate is not in prescribed format.
- The institution has submitted a list of faculty comprising of 1+10=11 faculty members issued/ approved by the State Council of Education Research & Training (Govt. of NCT of Delhi).
